- Multiple 1 hour speed and agility training sessions

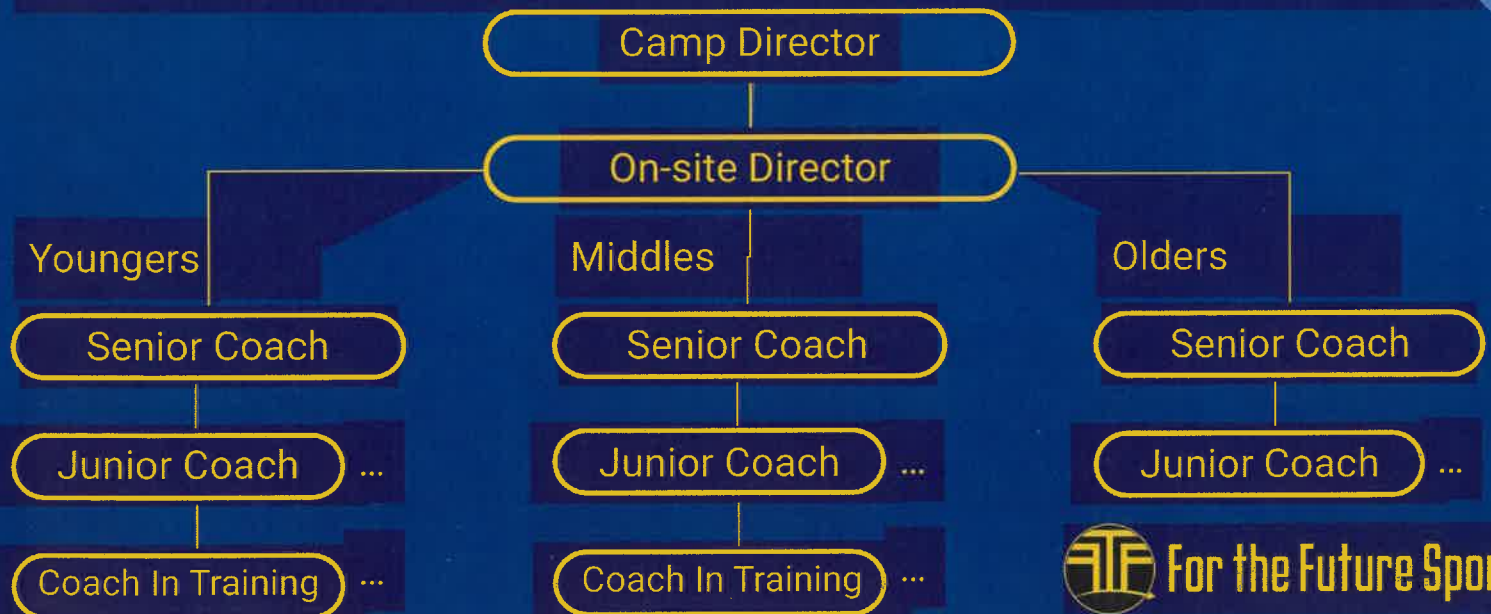


Partnership Vision

Safety and Compliance

- On-site director and Senior Coaches to be CPR and First Aid Certified
- Emergency action plan written for all locations camp will be held
- On-site first aid and AED at camp all locations
- All non-minor employees will be background checked
- Liability, accident, injury, and molestation and abuse insurance held
- All employees will be trained to use the AED and take concussion training
- Incident reports will be filled out for major events including but no limited to fights, bullying, abuse, and possible concussions.
- All athletes with a suspected concussion will have to have a medical professional fill out a return to play form to resume activities



Long-Term Vision

Our long-term vision is to expand our partnership into a comprehensive community sports initiative that includes after-school and PIR day programs, competitive leagues, skills clinics, and sporting events. Along with this we aim to give back to the community through free events and clinics as well as scholarships for youth and families currently going through adversity. We aim to evolve the programs to the community's needs, continually enhancing our offerings, and building better relationships within the community to create better tomorrow for the youth, families, and the community at large.
