Tim Stroshine called the meeting to order at 2:04 PM.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY 15, 2024

Mike Fincher moved to approve the minutes from the February 15, 2024 meeting. Donnie Shockley seconded, and the minutes were approved by unanimous voice vote.

II. TRAFFIC COUNTS

Aria Staiger reminded the attendees that sixty-five traffic counts are conducted each year, on a three-year cycle in the same locations. Armory Road has been a focus location for the past couple of years aside from the normal counts. About five weeks of counts have taken place so far this spring and another two weeks remain. More than the usual number of recounts will need to be done this year due to counters coming undone at various locations.

Tim Stroshine addressed the confusion of one of the count locations that was placed in an area that chip and seal work was being done. Donnie Shockley thought the counter should have been across the tracks on 900 North. He said the counter ended up in the town of Burrows on SR 25. Aria Staiger said the counter station will be relocated further away from town and counts will be taken again.

Tim Stroshine said other data can be collected with these counters including speed and vehicle classifications. If this type of data could be helpful for other work taking place in the county, he asked the attendees to reach out to him because this data is available from counts taken each year.

III. OTHER BUSINESS

A. 18-Month Letting List

Tim Stroshine referred to the eighteen-month letting list and noted the lack of projects occurring at this time. He said this is not uncommon because there are usually not many lettings throughout the summer. Two projects that were scheduled for September and October 2024 lettings have now been removed from the schedule, most likely due to financial concerns, and are showing revised project letting dates in 2029

and 2030. The small structure maintenance and repair project on SR 29, scheduled for an October 9, 2024, letting has been changed to December 11, 2024 letting. A full depth reclamation on SR 29 and a small structure maintenance and repair project on US 421 are both listed for a December 11, 2024 letting. Four new projects are shown on the letting list, one on US 421 and three on SR 75.
