

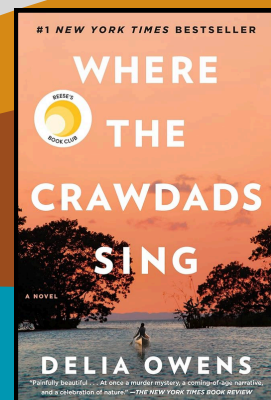

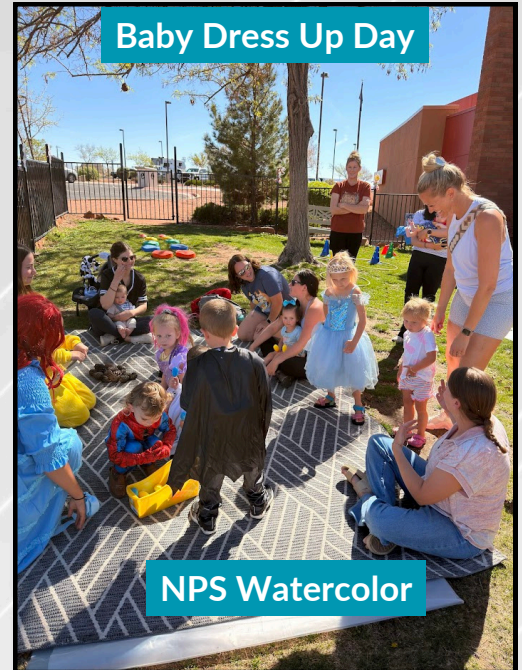

The Library participated in the 2026 Career Expo at Page Elementary School, where staff shared insights into careers in librarianship and the role of the library in the community. Through this event, our team engaged with 443 students, providing an opportunity to inspire and educate youth about future career paths.

3rd Annual Page Library Con

Page Library Con continues to grow as one of the library’s largest and most anticipated events, offering four hours of activities for all ages. Attendees had the opportunity to participate in a costume contest featuring four categories—children, teens, adults, and groups—explore 12 themed booths with games and activities, and enjoy vendors and free bounce houses. This year’s event drew an impressive attendance of 1,290 participants.

Geocaching

This year marked the 4th Annual Geocaching Event, where participants enjoyed a day of excitement, mystery, and discovery as they explored hidden gems and uncovered buried treasures. Attendees learned how to navigate the geocaching app and participated in a community scavenger hunt. The event drew 62 participants, with the farthest attendee who was from Michigan.

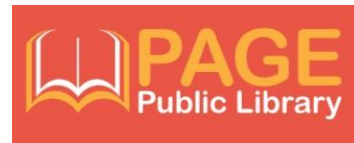
