MINUTES (for approval) QC P25 INTERGOVERNMENTAL ADVISORY GROUP Wednesday, November 19, 2025, 3:00 P.M.

Appointed Members present: Steve Seiver, Steve Regenwether, Daren Hart, Troy Said, Paul Andorf, and Tracey Screechfield, all present via TEAMS.

Alternate Members present: Mark VanKlaveren and Mindy Myers, all present via TEAMS.

Others Present: Patsy Willits, all present via TEAMS.

Hart called the meeting to order at 3:03 P.M.

Roll call completed.

Regenwether made a motion to approve the Minutes from the July 23, 2025, P25 Advisory Group Meeting. Andorf seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion approved.

County Site and System Updates—Hart reported that all Illinois sites are going well. The QCIC fiber link to Iowa had repairs due to possible vandalism. Repairs, maintenance, and HVAC went out for bids that will be going to the Board. There were security issues with firewalls in September, and RACOM was notified. There was no exposure, and RACOM did a great job. The Silvis site continues to have lighting issues and will continue to be monitored.

Said reported that he consulted with the city engineer regarding the P25 group's concerns about the exposed orange cable on the I-74 bridge. The Metronet cable is in conduit from IL to IA, with the conduit being exposed to possible vandalism. He will revisit with the engineer and DOT. Hart will try to get pictures on the IL side and send them to Said.

Willits reported on the IA tower sites that all sites are going well. The Princeton site generator pad project was completed, and Lakewood did a phenomenal job.

Screechfield updated the group on the GPS project and that Scott County IT will be upgrading the firewall, which will move the project along.

Hart discussed the SOPs that need to be written/finished. Andorf volunteered to be on the SOP committee. Hart stated they will need someone from Fire, too. He stated that there should be minimal SOPs to write and would like this item to be completed before he retires. The group identified that Hart,

Screechfield, Andorf, and Said will make up the committee. All agreed. Hart will send out an invite for early January and bring it back to the January 28, 2026, meeting.

Screechfield discussed the Console Move/Monitor Project, tentatively scheduled to begin on December 1st.

Service Agreements Approval – City of Eldridge. Screechfield reported that the City of Eldridge has radios that EPD utilizes. The group discussed encryption, and any changes should be brought back to the group. Hart agreed that they didn't need approval or a vote.

Public Comment – None.

VanKlaveren reported that this would be his last P25 meeting. The group gave appreciation for his time on the P25 Intergovernmental Advisory Group.
