PUBLIC HEARING

1. **Resolution 2026-03-23-01** for consideration to affirm the Mayor’s letter of support for the Green Up Hotel Wilson grant project

2. **Resolution 2026-03-23-02** for consideration to appoint certain citizens as City of Clanton representatives to the Chilton County Airport Authority

Councilmember Awlahjaday Agee moved to adopt Resolution 2026-03-23-02 and Councilmember Don Driver seconded the motion.

There being no further discussion, the motion to adopt Resolution 2026-03-23-02 passed by a unanimous voice vote of those members of the council present and the mayor declared the same passed and adopted.

3. **Resolution 2026-03-23-03** for consideration to approve a lighting agreement with Alabama Power

Councilmember Don Driver moved to adopt Resolution 2026-03-23-03 and Councilmember Phillip Giles seconded the motion.

There being no further discussion, the motion to adopt Resolution 2026-03-23-02 passed by a unanimous voice vote of those members of the council present and the mayor declared the same passed and adopted.

1. **Ordinance No. 2026-03** for consideration to amend the City of Clanton Zoning Code of Ordinances (**First Reading**)

Mayor Price called on Councilmember Awlahjaday Agee to read a summary of Ordinance No. 2026-03. Councilmember Agee stated a copy of Ordinance No. 2026-03 is available for review at Clanton City Hall during normal business hours and would likely be considered at a future city council meeting.

Councilmember Agee moved that all rules which would prevent the immediate consideration of Ordinance No. 2026-03 be suspended and immediate consideration given. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Phillip Giles. The roll call vote on said motion was recorded by the City Clerk/Treasurer as follows:

Ordinance No. 2026-03 passed by a unanimous vote of those members of the council present and the mayor declared the same passed.


COUNCIL AND PUBLIC COMMENTS
