- Color copies or copies in a size other than letter or legal shall be reimbursed to actual costs.
- The cost to certify a record will be \$1.00.

Records may be furnished without charge or at a reduced charge, as determined by the Village, if the person requesting the document states the specific purpose for the request and indicates that a waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest. Waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest if the principal purpose of the request is to access and disseminate information regarding the health, safety and welfare or the legal rights of the general public and is not for the principal purpose of personal or commercial benefit.
