MINUTES

The Marshall County Board of Supervisors met for the regular meeting according to the posted notices in the Courthouse, First Floor Meeting Room, 1 East Main Street, Marshalltown, Iowa, and online via ZOOM. Chair Jarret Heil called the meeting to order on January 14, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Present: Chair Jarret Heil, Vice Chair Carol Hibbs. Absent: Member Kevin Goodman. Hibbs moved to approve the agenda as amended, moving Item #7, Discussion and possible acceptance of the EMS Consultant Report, and Item #10, Discussion and possible action to approve previously discussed added services for the Jail/Sheriff's Office ARPA Emergency Exit Stairwell, to the January 28, 2026 Board of Supervisors meeting. The motion was seconded by Heil. Motion carried 2-0.

Following approval of the agenda, Chair Heil opened the meeting with a moment of silence in honor of the late Member Kevin Goodman. The Board observed the moment of silence, after which Chair Heil shared heartfelt words, noting that Goodman was a great friend and colleague and that he enjoyed working with him. Vice Chair Carol Hibbs stated that Goodman was a dedicated public servant who was always willing to learn, was proud of his family and the legacy they have in Marshall County, and extended her sincere sympathies to his family, noting that he will be greatly missed. Christian Goodman, Kevin Goodman's son, expressed his appreciation to local first responders, UnityPoint Health, the Sheriff's deputies, and emergency dispatchers for their assistance. He also thanked the residents of Marshall County for placing their trust in Goodman as a Board member and shared heartfelt words in remembrance of his father.

The Board of Supervisors Approves, effective on this date, the interagency transfer of an amount not to exceed \$58,546.00 in opioid settlement funds to Prairie Ridge Integrated Behavioral Healthcare to effectuate the opioid abuse abatement program identified in the Memorandum of Understanding.

This Resolution shall be in effect after approval and signature of the Board Chairperson as required by law.

Motion by Hibbs, second by Heil to approve and adopt Allocation/Interagency Transfer in Opioid Settlement Funds for Prairie Ridge Integrated Behavioral Healthcare, Memorandum of Understanding, and Resolution 2026-0008, and authorize Chair to Sign. Jordan Gaffney provided an update regarding Prairie Ridge, formerly known as SATUCI, noting that the program will serve as both a prevention tool and a resource to combat opioid use. He also reported that the county has received over \$600,000 in opioid settlement funds since 2022, emphasizing that these funds are not derived from taxpayer dollars. Kelly Grun, CEO of Prairie Ridge, joined the meeting via Zoom and provided an update, noting that the organization will be hiring two full-time individuals. Motion carried 2-0.




Public Forum.
