

**Minutes of Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners Meeting
March 24, 2026**

The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, March 24, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. in the Government Center at Le Center, Minnesota. Board members present were John King, Danny O’Keefe, David Preisler, Steve Rohlfing and Dennis Tietz. Also present were Brent Christian, Joe Martin and Pam Herrmann.

King moved, Tietz seconded, motion carried unanimously to approve the agenda for the business of the day.

Sealcoats 16 miles & a couple county facility parking lots

Striping of South Half of County (south of 99 and CSAH 22) 140 miles

CR 117 Bridge Project in Le Sueur. Letting date set soon.

CSAH 46/47 in City of Cleveland Street Reconstruction– April 22 at 1:30 Bid Letting –City Open House on March 31.
