#### New Business:

1. First Reading of Proposed Resolution 26-2026 authorizing the Mayor to execute a contract with Concord Road Equipment Mfg., Inc. for the purchase and installation of a Concord Minuteman Dump Body and Snow and Ice Control Equipment package in an amount not to exceed One Hundred and Ninety-One Thousand Dollars (\$191,000.00) pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act and declaring an emergency. (Mayor Chuck Brunello Jr. & Council as a Whole)
2. First Reading of Proposed Resolution 27-2026 authorizing the Mayor to execute a contract with Classic Ford for the purchase of a Ford F-350, 4x4 Pickup in an amount not to exceed Forty-Nine Thousand dollars (\$49,000.00) pursuant to the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act and declaring an emergency.
