

**OFFICIAL MINUTES

SPECIAL MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 7, 2021**

**TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

A special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Holiday Lakes, Texas, was conducted on Tuesday, September 7, 2021, A. D., at 7:00 p.m. in the Holiday Lakes Municipal Building, within the corporate limits of said Town.

**INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** – Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze

**CALL TO ORDER** – Mayor Norman Schroeder called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**RECORD MEMBERS PRESENT AND ESTABLISH QUORUM** – Town Secretary Cindy Clark called roll and ascertained a quorum was present. Quorum included Mayor Norman C. Schroeder, Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze, Alderman Terry Mitchell, and Alderman Lorenzo Macias. Alderwoman Kay Young was absent.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** There were no public comments.

**ACTION ITEM: Action Item:** Public Hearing on Property Tax Increase. **THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 19.72 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000.00 HOME BY APXORIMATELY \$68.05.** Mayor Norman Schroeder opened the Public Hearing at 7:03 p.m. No Citizens appeared for the Public Hearing which Mayor Schroeder closed at 7:15 p.m. due to lack of public participation.

**Action Item:** Adopt Ordinance 2021-05 Setting Town of Holiday Lakes Budget for 2021-2022 fiscal year. **This Budget will raise more total property taxes than last year’s budget by \$30,100 or 19.72%, and of that amount, \$11,025 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.** After a brief discussion Alderman Terry Mitchell stated, “I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 1.088051, which is effectively a 19.72 percent increase in the tax rate. And Approve Ordinance 2021-05 Adopting the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget, “Whereas this Budget will raise more total property taxes than last year’s budget by \$30,100 or 19.72%, and of that amount, \$11,025 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year”. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze and carried on a Vote of 3 Ayes and 0 Nays. Aye Votes: Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze, Alderman Lorenzo Macias, and Alderman Terry Mitchell. Alderwoman Kay Young was absent, and Mayor Norman Schroeder was present not voting.

**Action Item:** Adopt Ordinance 2021-06 Levying Tax for the 2021-2022 FY Budget.

Whereas this Budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$30,100 or 19.72%, and of that amount, \$11,025 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year". The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze and carried on a Vote of 3 Ayes and 0 Nays. Aye Votes: Mayor Pro Tem Disa Schulze, Alderman Lorenzo Macias, and Alderman Terry Mitchell. Alderwoman Kay Young was absent, and Mayor Norman Schroeder was present not voting.

**ADJOURNMENT** – With no further business Mayor Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
