

**VILLAGE OF GLENCOE
ORDINANCE NO. 2026-XX-XXXX**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF
A SEWER CAMERA SYSTEM FROM ENVIROSIGHT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Glencoe is a home rule municipal corporation pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 ("*Illinois Constitution*"); and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution authorizes the Village to contract with individuals, associations, and corporations in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, The Public Works Department has identified the need to replace its 2015 Rover X Camera System ("*Current Equipment*") with a new sewer camera system for the purpose of maintaining the Village's sewer infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village has used the Current Equipment to televise Village sewer systems for 10 years and it has reached the end of its service life and is scheduled for replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Calendar Year 2026 Budget provides sufficient funds for the procurement of a sewer camera system to replace the Current Equipment; and

WHEREAS, Village staff recommends declaring the Current Equipment surplus property and authorizing its disposal; and

WHEREAS, Village staff procured preferred pricing through a Sourcewell contract; and

WHEREAS, EnviroSight, of Randolph, New Jersey ("*Vendor*"), provided Sourcewell contract pricing for the new 2026 Rover X Camera System ("*Replacement Equipment*") in the amount of \$133,710.52; and

WHEREAS, contracts for Government Joint Purchases/Purchasing Cooperatives pursuant to Section 5.F.4 of the Village's Purchasing Policy are a defined exception from the competitive bidding and professional service selection requirements under the Village's Purchasing Policy; and

WHEREAS, Village staff has determined that Sourcewell's purchasing policies and procedures comply with all state and local competitive purchasing requirements; and

WHEREAS, based on these factors, Village staff recommends procuring the Replacement Equipment from the Vendor in an amount not-to-exceed \$133,710.52; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Calendar Year 2026 Budget provides sufficient funds for the procurement of the Replacement Equipment in Capital Equipment/100-300-200-80205; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and the public to (i) authorize the purchase of the Replacement Equipment from the Vendor and (ii) declare the Current Equipment as surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: RECITALS. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in, and made a part of, this Ordinance by this reference as findings of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe.

SECTION TWO: APPROVAL. The procurement of the Replacement Equipment from the Vendor is hereby approved in an amount not-to-exceed \$133,710.52.

SECTION THREE: AUTHORIZATION. The Village Manager and Village Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and seal, on behalf of the Village, any documents required to complete the procurement of the Replacement Equipment from Vendor, all in a format acceptable to the Village Manager and Village Attorney.

SECTION FOUR: DISPOSAL OF CURRENT EQUIPMENT. Pursuant to ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe find that the Current Equipment now owned by the Village of Glencoe, are no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Glencoe, and the best interest of the Village of Glencoe will be best served by their disposal.

SECTION FIVE: MANNER OF DISPOSAL. Pursuant to ILCS 5/11-76-4 the Village Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of the Current Equipment by trade-in with Vendor for the amount of \$20,000.00.

SECTION SIX: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
