Resolution 72-2026 AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 56-2026 TO UPDATE AND AMEND THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESEX AND THE MIDDLESEX BOROUGH SCHOOL BOARD FOR CLASS III POLICE SERVICES PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 ET SEQ. AND N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.8

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2026, the Borough Council of the Borough of Middlesex approved, in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the students of the Middlesex Borough Board of Education, Resolution No. 56-2026 (attached hereto as Schedule A) to implement a Class III Officer program with the Middlesex Borough Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council now seeks to amend the agreement approved by Resolution No. 56-2026 as attached hereto as Schedule B.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Middlesex, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Borough Council does hereby amend Resolution No. 56-2026 to substitute the agreement attached hereto as Schedule B as the agreement to be executed between the parties.
