Minutes of the Twin Beach Opioid Abuse Awareness Committee Meeting

March 13, 2025

- Per survey responses, our top three priorities for outreach will be Mental Health, Suicide Prevention, and Opioid Awareness.
- Per survey responses, our top three internal priorities will be Branding, Media Presence, and Recruiting.
- Member Philomenia Gorenflo will facilitate the production of a new logo for the coalition.
- Member Philomenia Gorenflo will research a product that will allow the 2025 Glow Vigil participants biodegradable lanterns to send notes out into the Chesapeake Bay in honor of their loved ones.
