

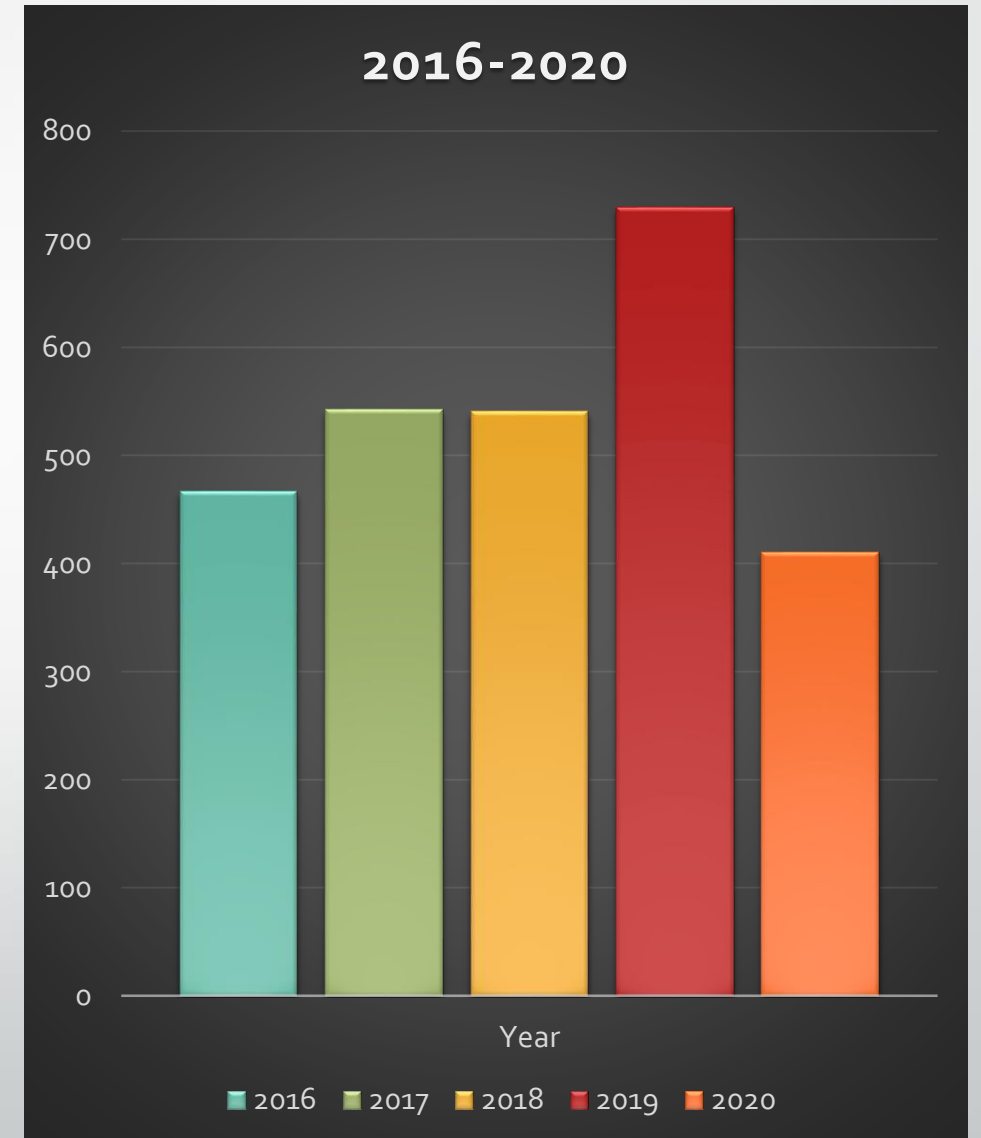

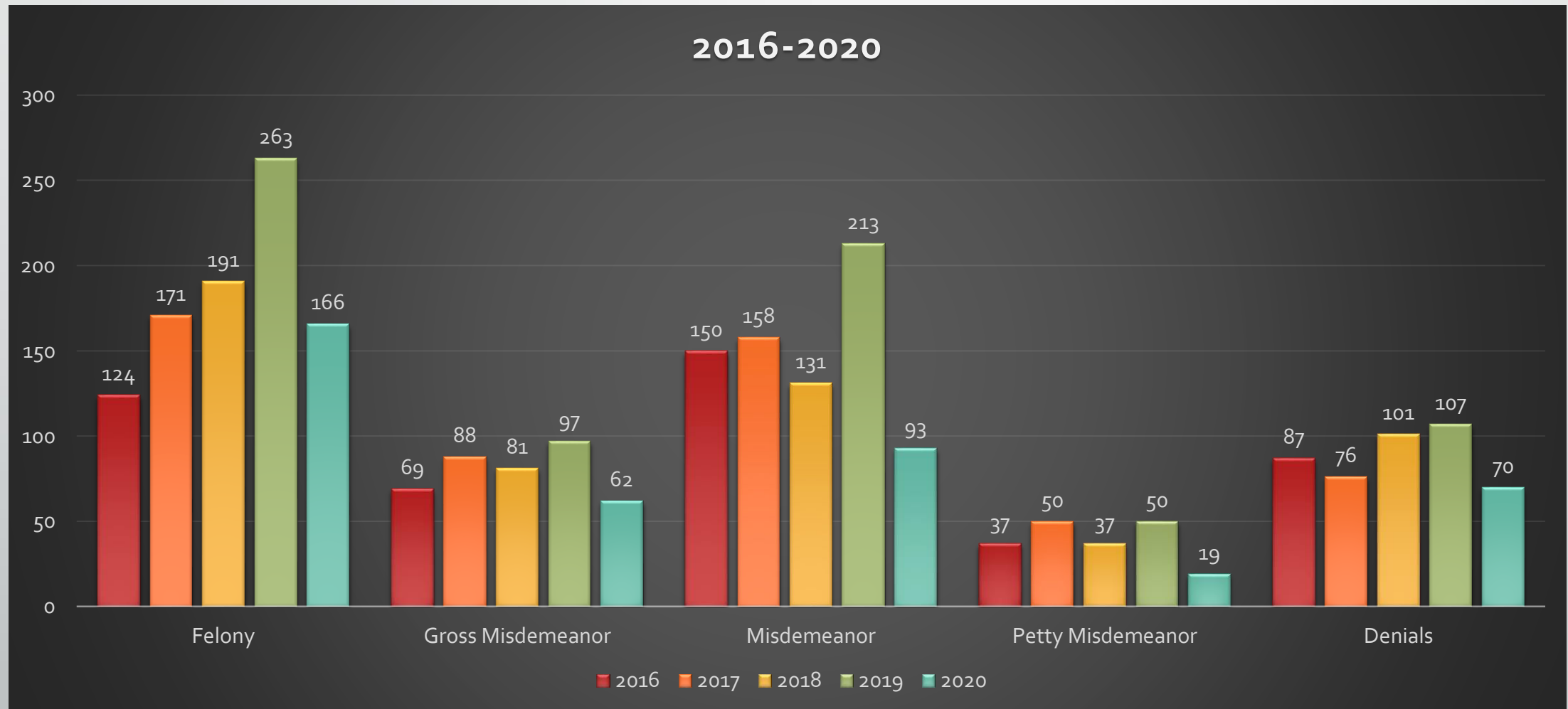

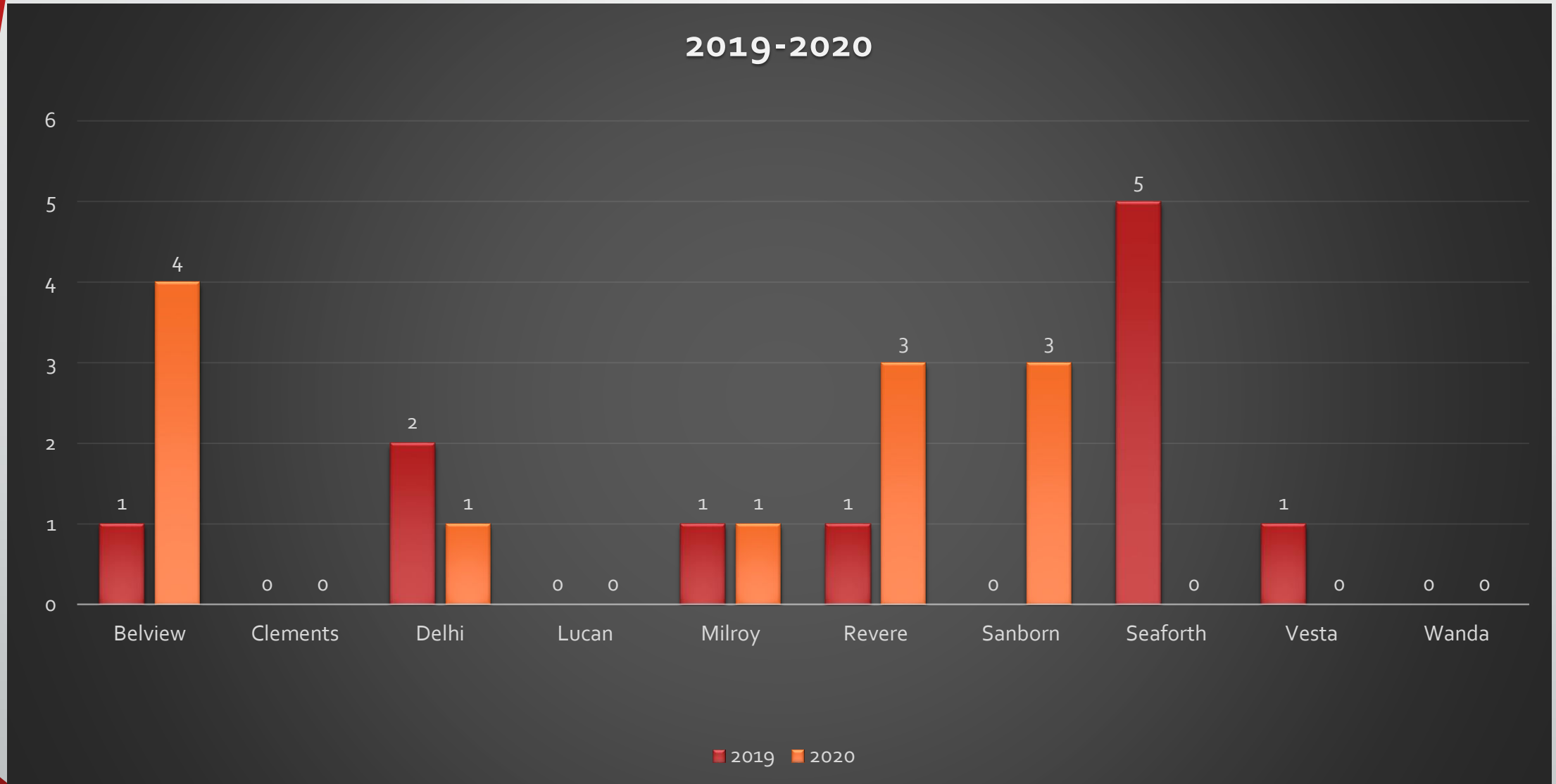
- 410 total cases reviewed

 - 2016 = 467



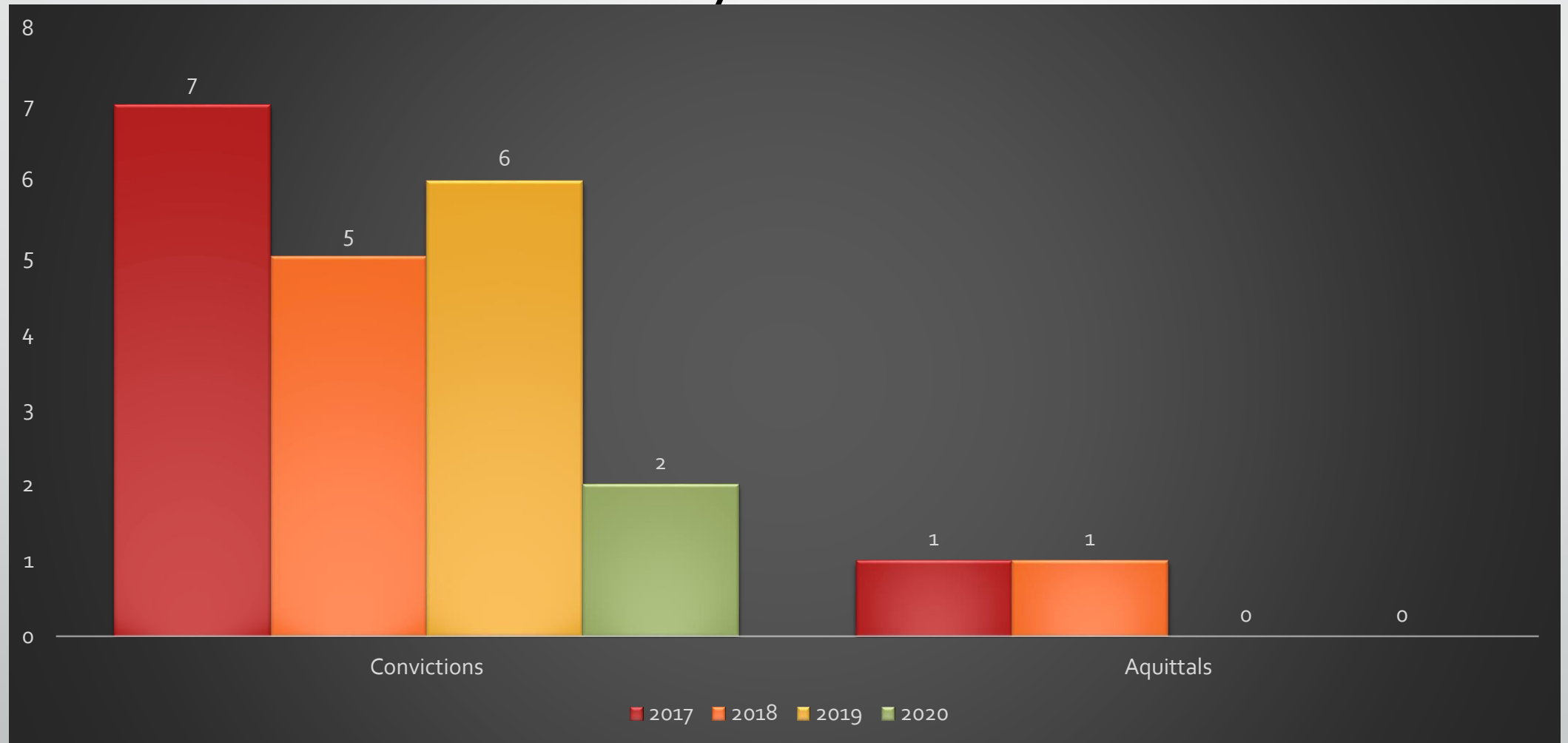
Adult Criminal Files



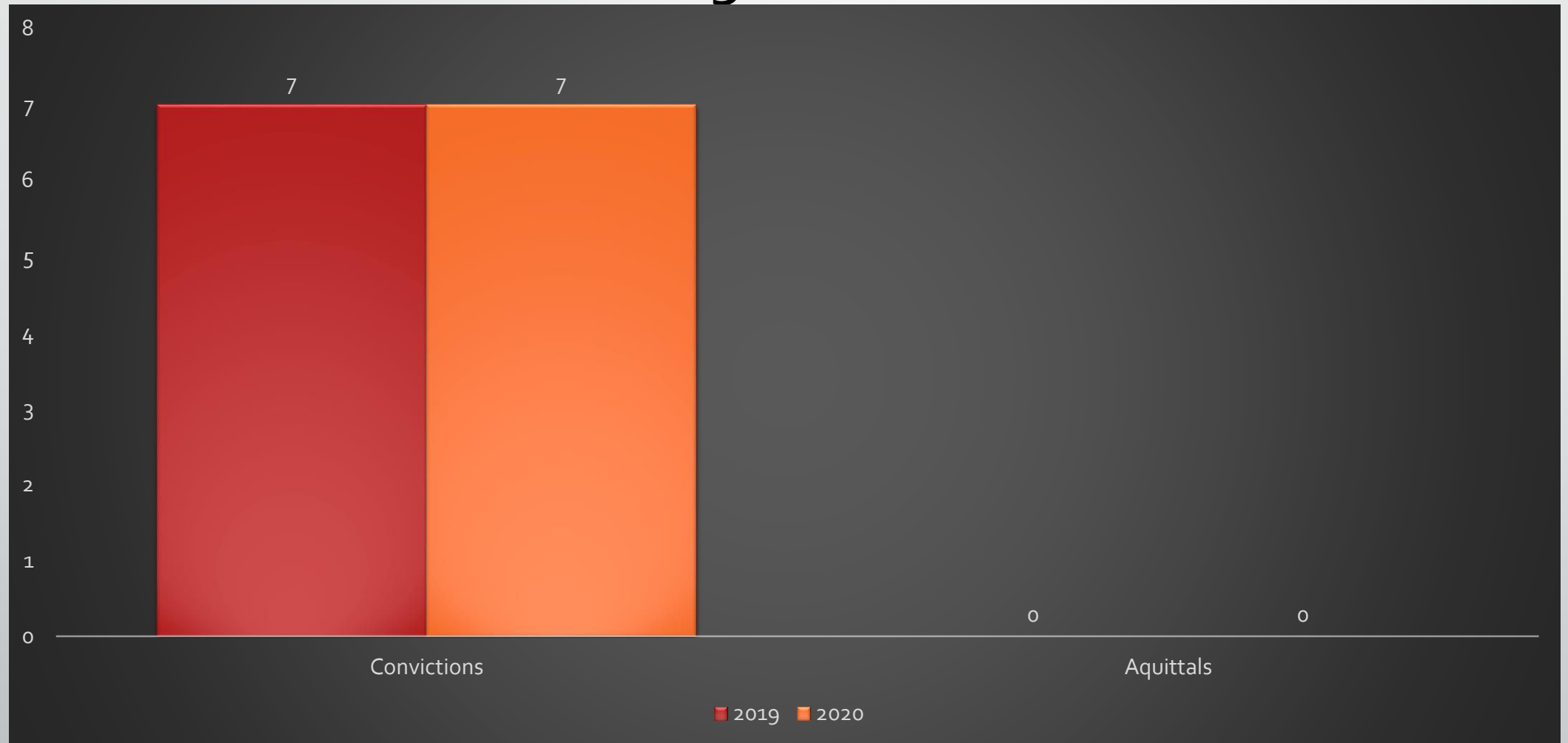
Prosecution by City



Jury Trials 2017-2020

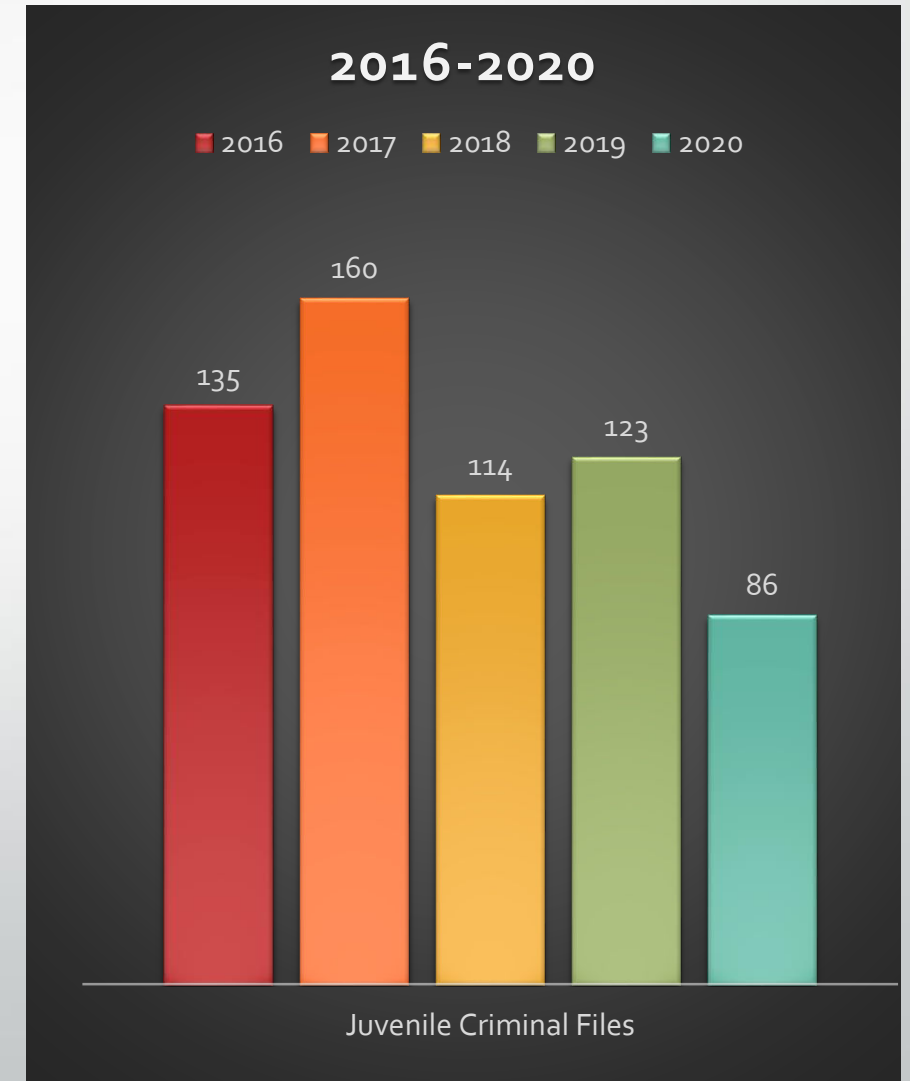


Court Trials 2019-2020

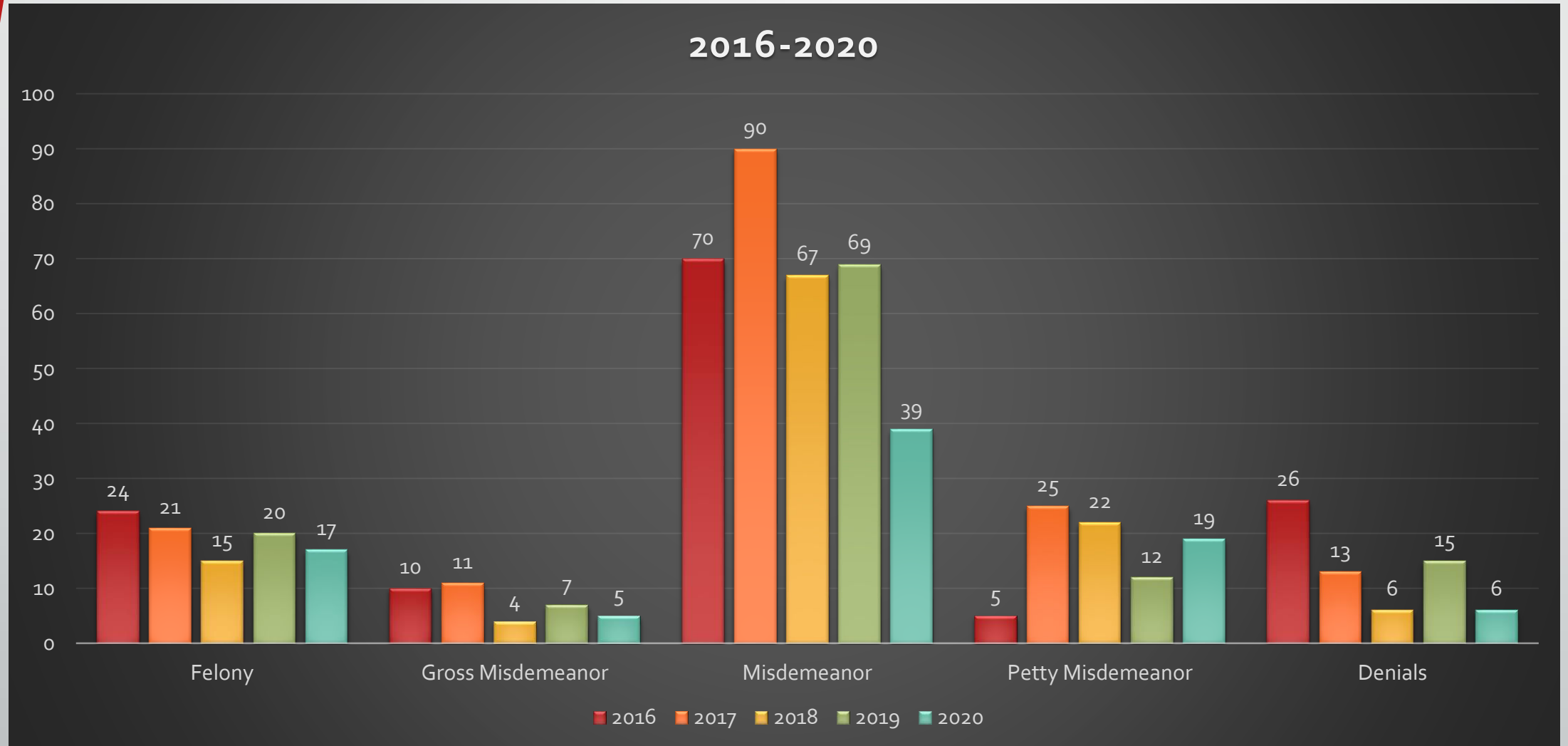

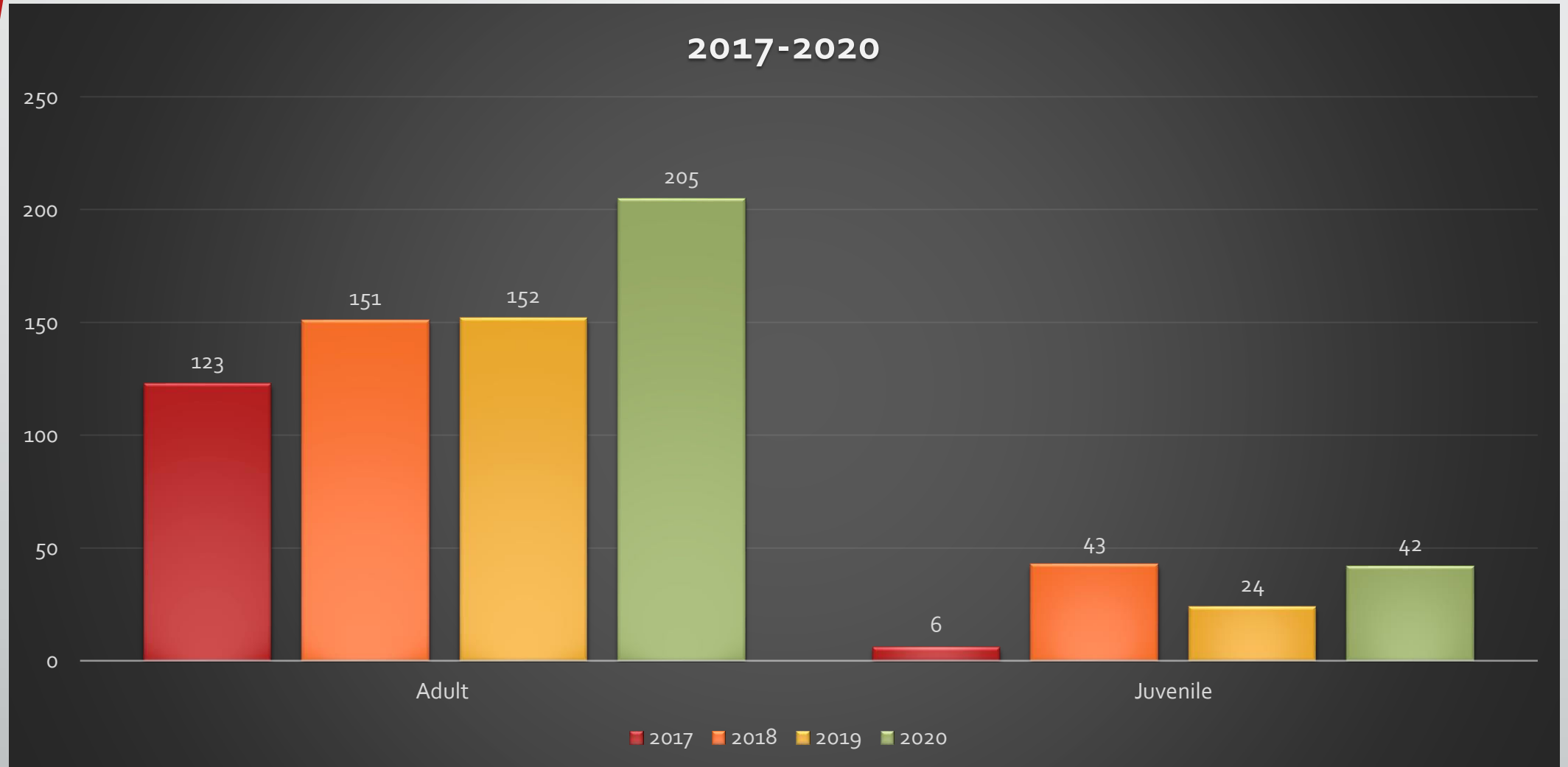
- 86 total cases reviewed

 - 2016 = 135



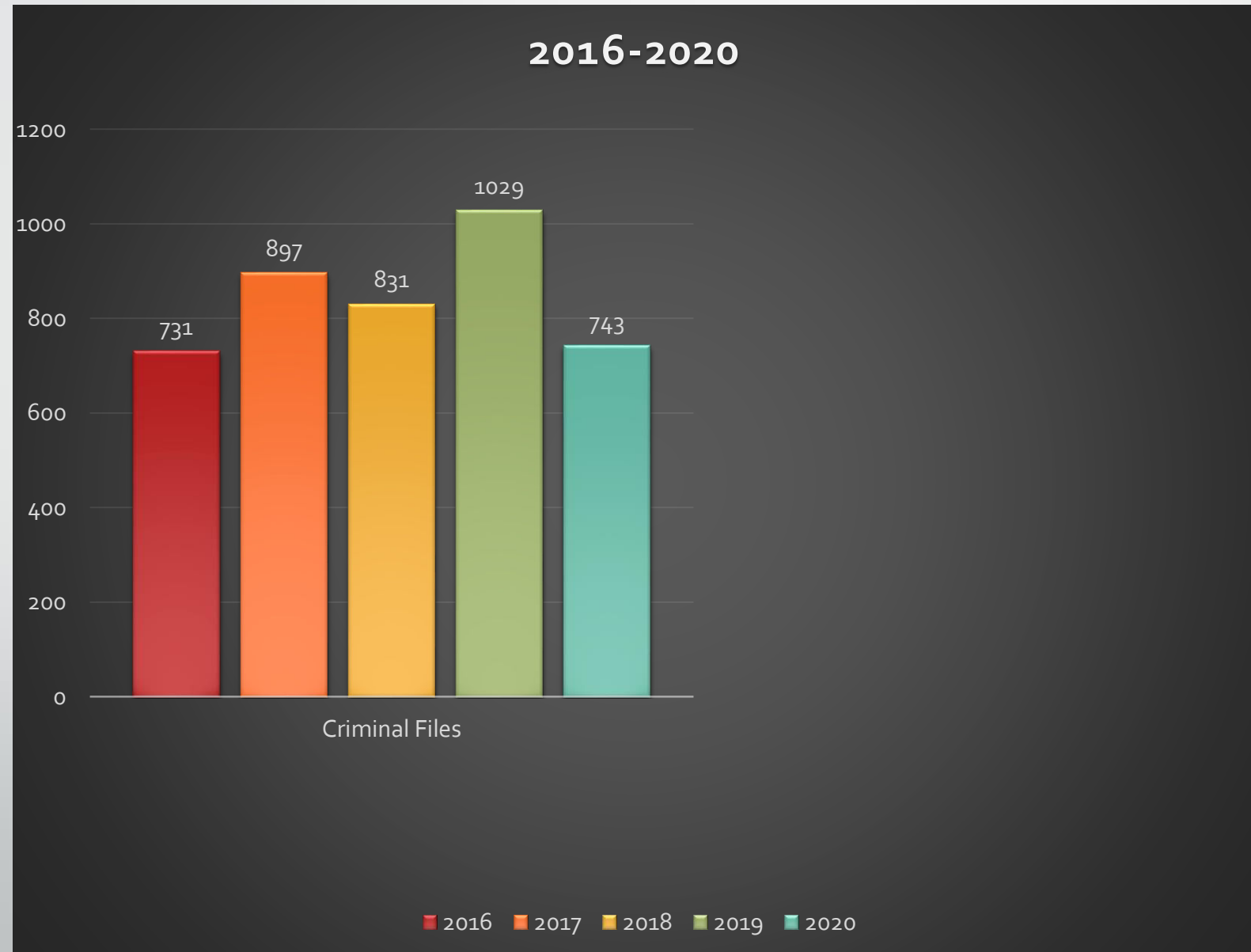

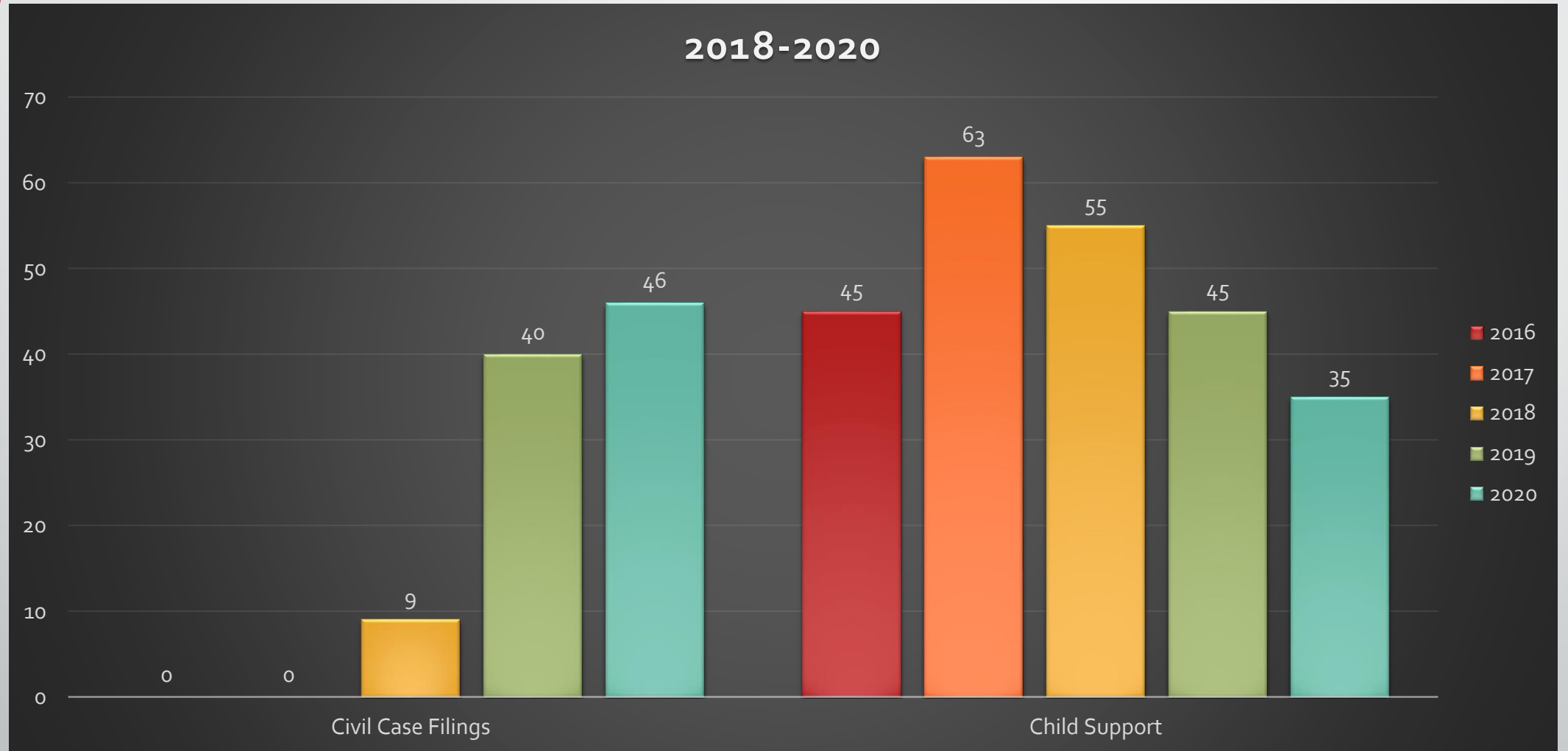
Probation Violations



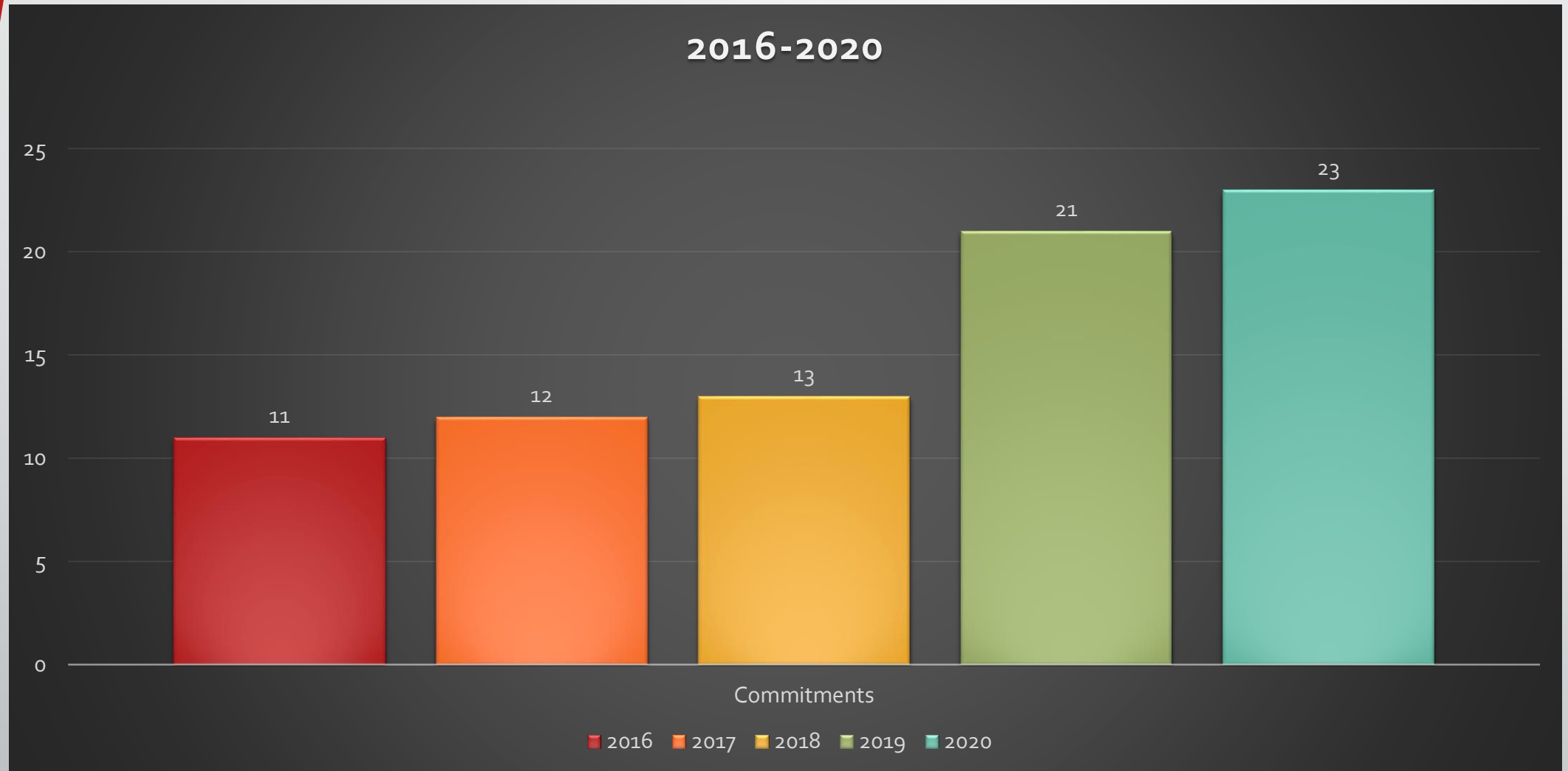
Criminal Totals

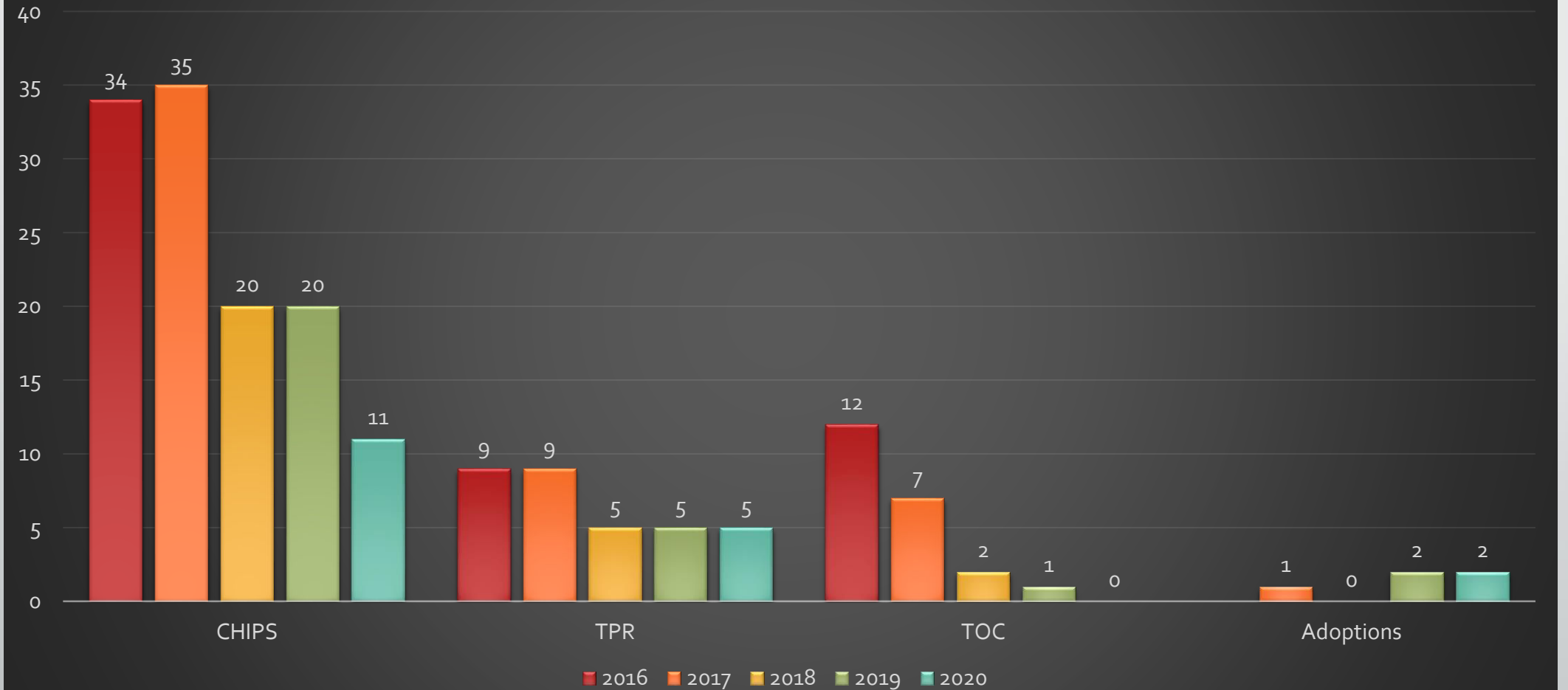

Looking forward to 2019:

- Launched Redwood County Truancy Diversion Program January 1st
 - 2019 = 53 students
 - 2020 = 41
- Revision to Juvenile Diversion program
 - 2019 = 20
 - 2020 = 20

Diversion Programs

- Circle Sentencing = 3 new referrals

Other

- CAC/Child's Place Forensic Interviews:
 - 2019 = 33
 - 2020 = 35
- Administrative subpoenas:
 - 2018 = 22
 - 2019 = 10
 - 2020 = 20

2020 oddities

- COVID postage (March 1 – December 31) = \$455.05
- Subpoena service:
 - 2019 = \$4,076.26
 - 2020 = \$3,804
- Have 34 trials currently scheduled in remaining months of 2021
 - 20 still waiting a date
- Have been appearing for ALL hearings via Zoom since December
