GUIDELINES FOR “CITIZEN COMMENTS” AT KENOSHA COUNTY BOARD AND COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Please follow the guidelines for participating in Citizen Comments:

- Any person who wishes to address the county board during the “Citizen Comments” portion of the county board meeting must verbally state their name and residential address for the record.
- Citizens that speak during “Citizen Comments” must list their name and residential address on the sign-in sheet on the podium.
- Citizen Comments portion of the meeting will be for 1 hour, which may be adjusted by the County Board Chair at their discretion, if necessary.
- Each speaker is provided one opportunity to speak up to five (5) minutes in length or as announced by the County Board Chair at the beginning of the meeting. Stay within the time limits provided.
- Citizen comments should pertain to county operations.
- Comments should be made to the Board as a whole, and not to address individual Supervisors.
- Do not ask questions of the Board as a whole, or to individual supervisors, this is a time for public comments, not discussion or debate.
- Citizens must be courteous in their language and deportment and must avoid personalized remarks. Refraining from comments that are rude, obscene, or profane, personally attacking, or which demonstrate a lack of respect for others.
- The County Board Chair will not tolerate abusive language or disruptive behavior. The County Board Chair, for abusiveness or disruptive behavior, may terminate an individual’s public comments. The County Board Chair has the authority to rule speakers out of order for noncompliance with these guidelines and may call a short recess in disorderly situations.
- Citizens in the audience are not to audibly respond to comments being made or to make demonstrations either in support of or in opposition to a speaker or idea. Refraining from derogatory comments, inappropriate gesturing, or applause.






AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MCKC CHAPTER 2.02 (3)

THE KENOSHA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN that Municipal Code of Kenosha County Chapter 2.02(3), the County Board Rules of Procedure is hereby amended as follows:

(3) Regular Meetings. In addition to the organizational and annual meetings, the County Board shall meet at ~~7:30~~ 6:30 p.m. on the first and third Tuesday of each month for the purpose of transacting business. The Chair, in his or her discretion, may cancel a regular meeting for any reason, including, but not limited to: a lack of agenda items, inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. The Board Chair shall provide reasonably adequate notice to the supervisors and the public in advance of any such meeting cancellation.

**A RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE PROPOSED FCC RULE-MAKING
RELATING TO WIRELESS DEPLOYMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has recently released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking seeking comments on "reforms that would streamline the deployment of towers and other wireless infrastructure;" and

WHEREAS, the Kenosha County Board recognizes the importance of reliable wireless communications infrastructure to public safety, economic development, education, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, while the need for and benefits of new infrastructure related to the expansion and improvement of the nation's wireless capabilities may be a legitimate and laudable goal, there are serious concerns with the approach being contemplated by the FCC; and

WHEREAS, Congress, through Section 6409(a) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (Spectrum Act), intended to streamline the collocation, removal, and replacement of wireless facilities while preserving an appropriate role for state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has proposed a rule change entitled “Build America: Eliminating Barriers to Wireless Deployments”, which would significantly expand federal preemption over state and local authority; and

WHEREAS, State and local governments are best positioned to balance the need for wireless infrastructure with community planning goals, public safety considerations, environmental impacts, historic preservation, and neighborhood character; and

WHEREAS, this rule change appears to be based on the premise that local regulations unduly hinder such deployment; and

WHEREAS, it seems to fail to acknowledge the real interest that state and local governments have in regulating land use; and

WHEREAS, zoning authority, including such determinations as to the best and most appropriate land use, has historically rested with state governments under the framework established by the United States Supreme Court Case *Euclid v. Ambler*, (272 U.S. 365 (1926) and then typically delegated to local jurisdictions, as being the authorities most appropriately situated to determine what is best for their communities, rather than having uniform standards imposed by the federal government; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rules seem to contemplate overriding such local determinations to a significant degree.

WHEREAS, Kenosha County supports cooperative efforts to expand broadband and wireless access, but believes such efforts should respect long-standing principles of local control:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board urges United States Representative Bryan Steil and United States Senators Ron Johnson and Tammy Baldwin to oppose the proposed FCC rule change titled “Build America: Eliminating Barriers to Wireless Deployments”; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board respectfully requests that Wisconsin’s federal delegation advocate for policies that promote wireless deployment without eliminating the authority of state and local governments to regulate land use and zoning in the public interest; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Representative Bryan Steil, Senator Ron Johnson, Senator Tammy Baldwin, the Federal Communications Commission, and other appropriate parties.

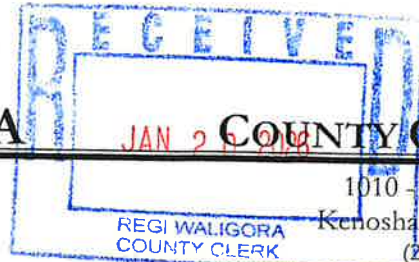

I discovered this claim in my mailbox on 01/15/2026.

I called the released inmate, Kirksey, the same afternoon to discuss the claim.

He wanted to pursue the claim, acknowledging he understands the jail's intake procedure.

When Kirksey came into custody on 12/19/25, all his property was logged, as was the \$227.62 he brought in.

All inmate money is deposited into the inmate's trust account at the time of Booking.

Inmate Kirksey's trust account had a debt of \$247.50 at the time of booking. The trust account system automatically collects debt based on rules set up for each debt category. A total of \$180.65 was collected, leaving the trust account with a balance of \$46.97.

While inmate Kirksey was incarcerated, he also used his funds to purchase GTL phone time. When Kirksey was released on 12/22/25, any remaining balance was applied to the outstanding balance, which is collected at 100%. Kirksey's account now shows a \$85.36 debt.

On our phone call, he explained that \$150.00 of the \$227.62 was to be paid to DOC for fees. Because DOC put him in custody when he shouldn't have been, he's now unable to pay the DOC fees because his money was deposited, and money was applied to Jail debt. He's trying to show that he's done everything he can to obtain that money so he can present it to DOC.

Come now I, Christopher Lee Wiley, a Private Christian American and one of the People of the Union of States of the United States of America, bring this claim in my personal and private capacity, having suffered direct harm to my liberty, reputation, and rights. My standing is secured under the Constitution, which guarantees the right of the People to petition their government for redress of grievances (U.S. Const. amend. I).

I. NOTICE OF CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CLAIM

This Notice of Claim is submitted pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 893.80 and 893.82 to provide formal notice of tortious and unconstitutional conduct arising from actions taken by the above-mentioned state and county actors, acting individually and under color of law, in the above-referenced matters.

The complained-of conduct includes, but is not limited to:

1. **False Claims and Fraudulent Warrant Activity.** The initiation, support, or continuation of criminal allegations and/or warrant activity absent probable cause, based on false, misleading, legally defective assertions and conclusionary claims, constituting abuse of process and fraud upon the court.
2. **Deprivation of Due Process and Civil Rights.** Actions taken in violation of the Fourth, Fifth, and Fourteenth Amendments, including deprivation of liberty without due process of law, false arrest, and continued restraint without lawful authority.
3. **Res Judicata / Claim Preclusion Violations.** The pursuit of claims, enforcement actions, or collateral consequences in contravention of final adjudications, dismissals, or legally preclusive determinations, rendering the actions void and ultra vires. This violation is in direct dismissal of the exemption stated in the statute
4. **Deprivation of Rights Under Color of Law.** Conduct actionable under 42 U.S.C. § 1983, including the knowing enforcement of unlawful process, denial of fundamental rights, and participation in unconstitutional proceedings.
5. **Ancillary Constitutional Injuries.** Including defamation of character, reputational harm, and denial of the right to travel, specifically interference with passport issuance and international travel as a direct and proximate result of the unlawful actions described herein.
6. **Unlawful Suspension and Obstruction of Habeas Corpus.** The above-named officials, acting under color of law, unlawfully suspended, obstructed, or otherwise interfered with the Claimant's right to petition for and obtain review through the writ of habeas corpus, absent any lawful or constitutional cause. Claimant demands that the State of Wisconsin and Kenosha County:


