

RESOLUTION NO. 86-20

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 86-2 WHICH CREATED A RECREATION, PARK DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM ADVISORY BOARD FOR THE CITY OF ATHENS, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 86-2, the City Council approved the formation of "The Athens Recreation, Park Development and Tourism Advisory Board"; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Board is to advise and inform the Director as he administers the City parks and recreation system in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Athens, Tennessee, meeting in regular session this 15th day of July, 1986, that Resolution No. 86-2 be amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 2 is amended by deleting the word and number "5" and inserting in lieu thereof the word and number "seven (7)";
2. Section 1, entitled "Creation of Recreation, Park Development & Tourism Advisory Board," is amended by deleting the word and number "5" and inserting in lieu thereof the word and number "seven (7)";
3. Section 2, entitled "Terms and Qualifications," is amended by deleting Paragraph 2 in its entirety and inserting as follows: "The foregoing provision shall become effective on July 1, 1986. Effective July 1, 1986, the appointments made to the Board shall expire as follows: One (1) member on June 30, 1987; Two (2) members on June 30, 1988, Two (2) members on June 30, 1989; and Two (2) members on June 30, 1990. All appointments thereafter shall be for terms of four (4) years."
