## A PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY 2026 AS PRESERVATION MONTH IN THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE

**WHEREAS**, May has been celebrated as National Historic Preservation Month throughout the United States of America since 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village's historic homes, buildings, and landscapes serve as tangible connections to our shared history, fostering a sense of place and continuity; and

**WHEREAS**, thoughtful preservation of these resources supports cultural vitality, environmental sustainability, and economic stability by retaining the unique character that defines Glencoe; and

**WHEREAS**, the Preservation Commission plays a vital role in safeguarding this legacy by promoting stewardship, education, and appreciation of the Village's historic assets; and

**WHEREAS**, Historic Preservation Month provides an opportunity to reflect on the enduring value of our built environment and to recognize the collective efforts of residents and volunteers dedicated to preserving Glencoe's architectural and cultural heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Glencoe's Preservation ordinance was ratified and the original Historic Preservation Commission was established in 1990 and continues its mission to promote, protect, and enhance the Village's historic and architectural resources;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED**, that the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glencoe do hereby resolve that Preservation Month be observed in the Glencoe community during the month of May 2026.
