REQUEST

Approve a resolution authorizing the execution of an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Commerce City ("City") and the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") for Fiscal Year 2024 ("FY 2024") Congressionally Directed Spending funds for the Chambers Road Widening project.

BACKGROUND

The City applied for FY 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending funds for the Chambers Road Widening Project ("project"). In 2024, the City was awarded \$4,116,00 for the project. Congressionally Directed Spending is federal funding passed-through CDOT. The City is providing \$1,029,000 in match funding from the Chambers Road Widening Fund.
