**In the matter of the accusation against AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, located at 1913-H South Kihei Road, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii. They hold a Dispenser General, Category C(ii), Lic. No. 331, liquor license.**

**MINOR #1:**

Count 1: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, sold, served, or furnished liquor to a minor, as defined in the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-5, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(1)(A).

Count 2: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, through its employee(s), failed to properly check the identification of a minor, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-61(c).

Count 3: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, sold, served, or furnished liquor to a minor, as defined in the Hawaii Revised Statutes § 281-1, contrary to the Hawaii Revised Statutes § 281-78(b)(1)(A).

**MINOR #2:**

Count 4: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, sold, served, or furnished liquor to a minor, as defined in the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-5, contrary to the Rules

Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(1)(A).

Count 5: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, through its employee(s), failed to properly check the identification of a minor, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-61(c).

Count 6: On FEBRUARY 17, 2024, AMBROSIA LLC dba VIBE BAR NIGHTCLUB, sold, served, or furnished liquor to a minor, as defined in the Hawaii Revised Statutes § 281-1, contrary to the Hawaii Revised Statutes § 281-78(b)(1)(A).

*PLEA: The licensee submitted a plea of NOT GUILTY. At the December 4, 2025, hearing, the licensee requested a continuance of the disposition of the Complaint and Accusation, which the Board granted.*
