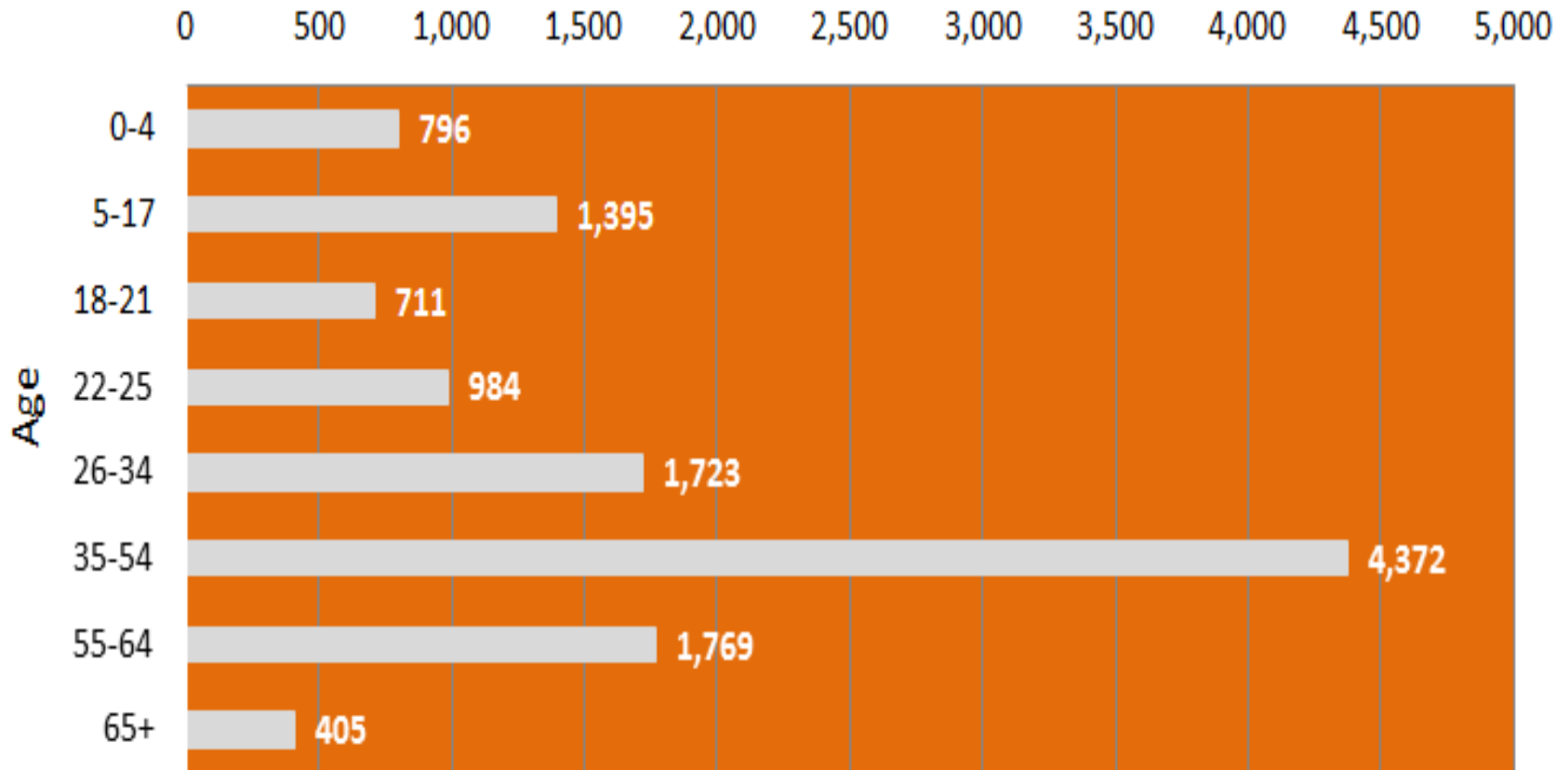

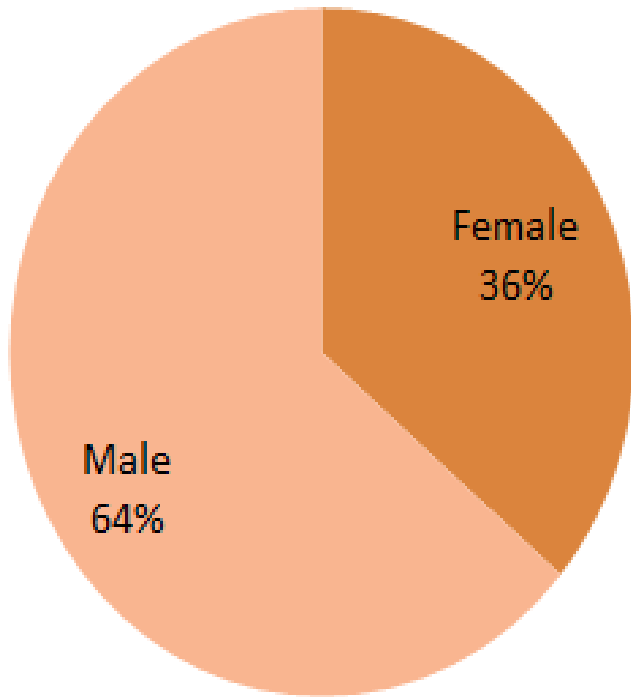
Countywide Age Data

Ages - All Program Participants

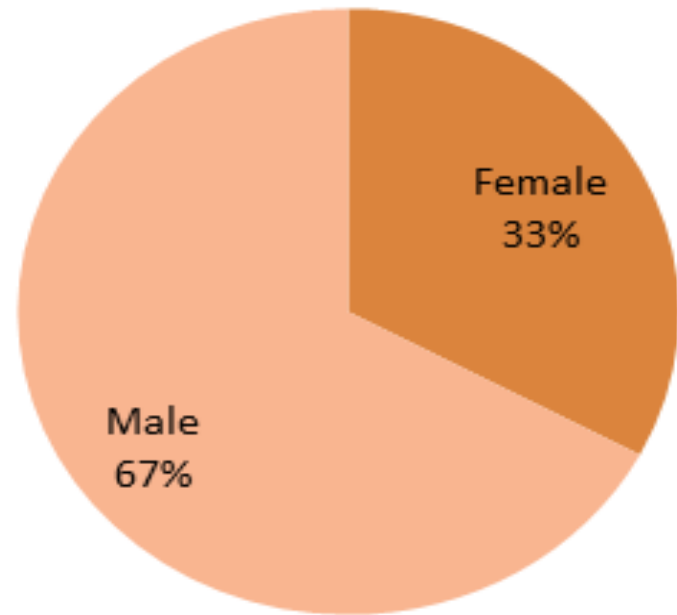


Countywide Gender Data

Gender Head of Household

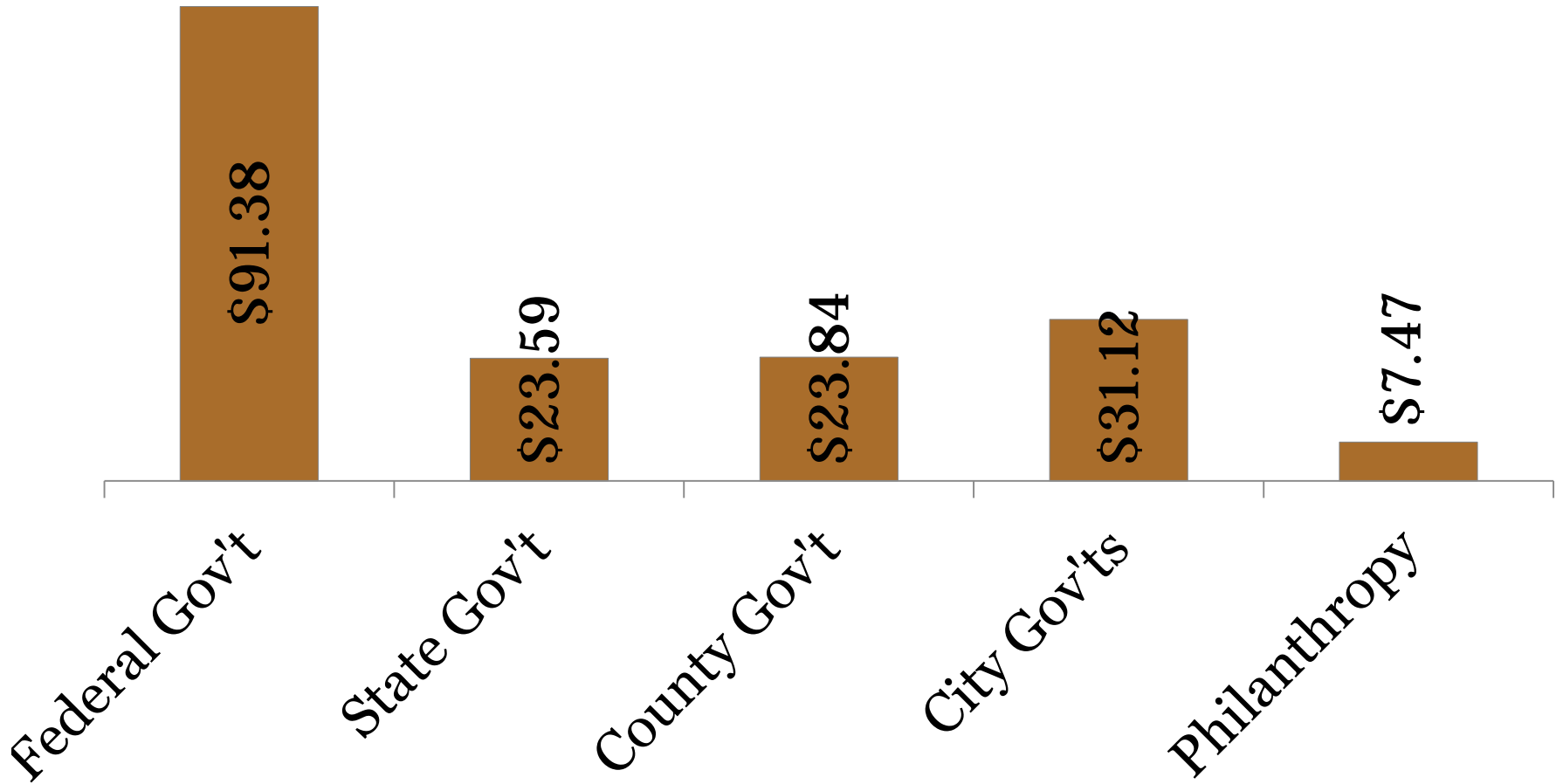

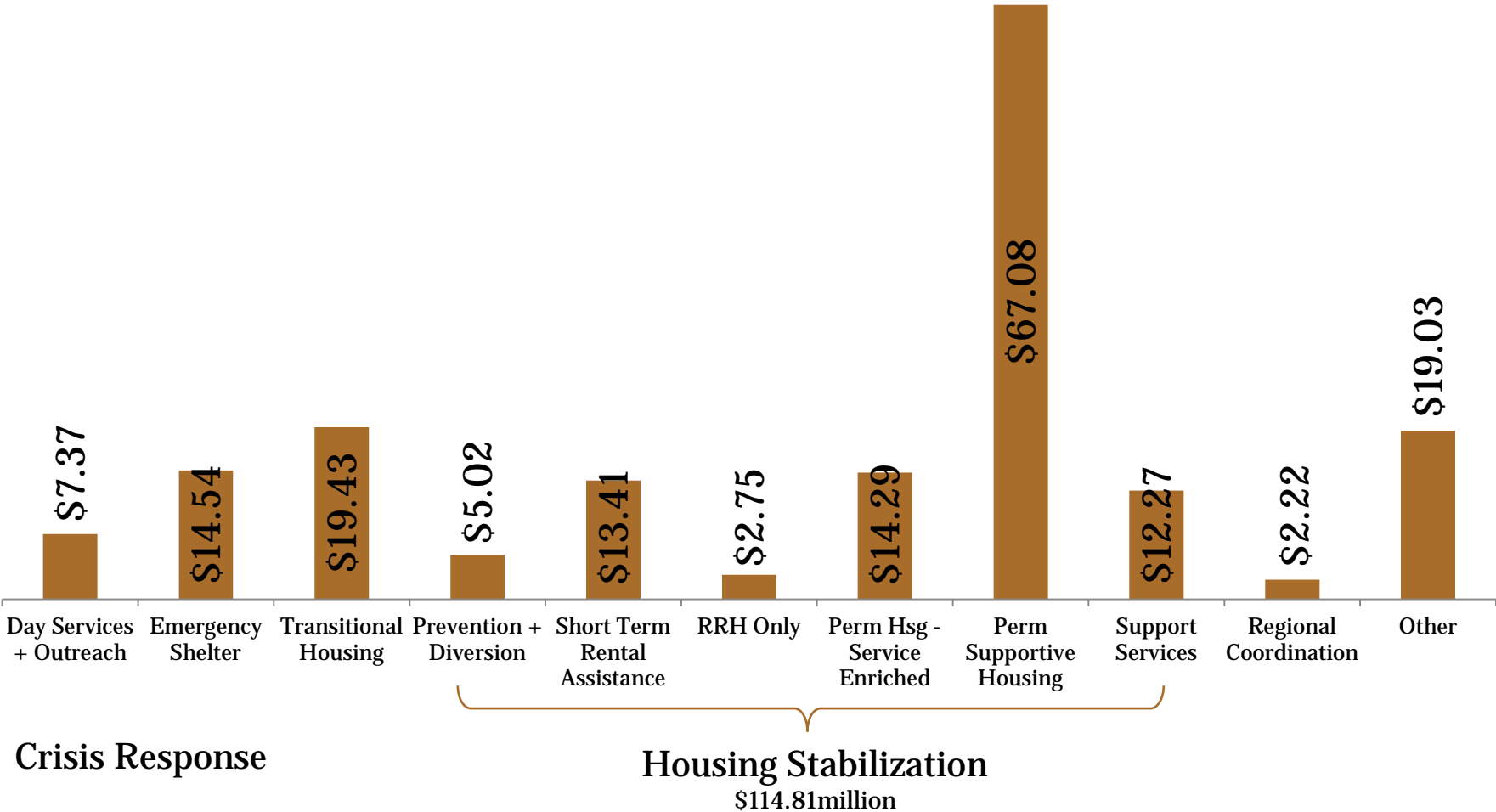

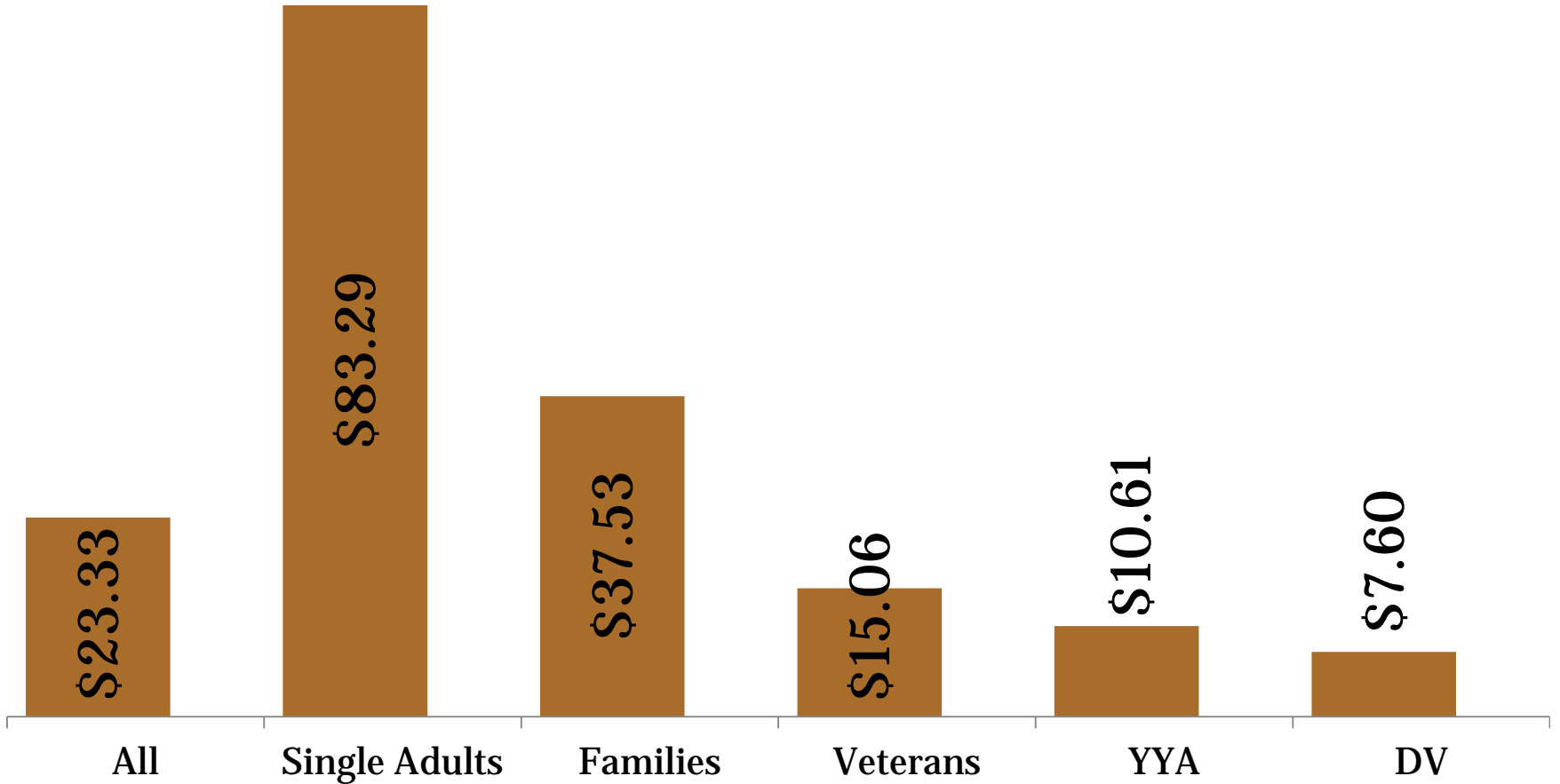

Population

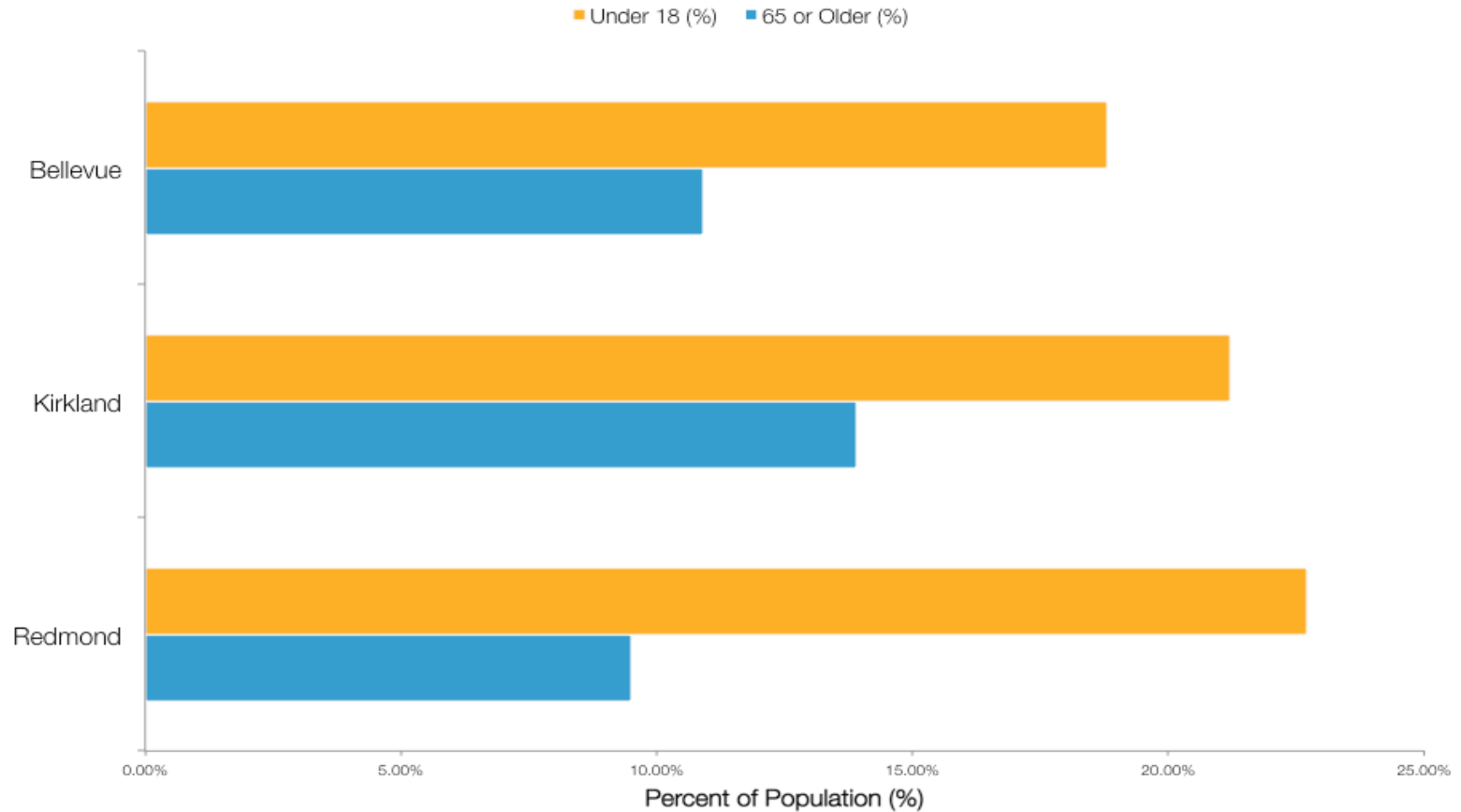


- **54,144 (2010 census); 55,840 (2013)**
- **3% of King County's population; 15% of East King County's population**
- **Only 40% of people who work in Redmond also live here**

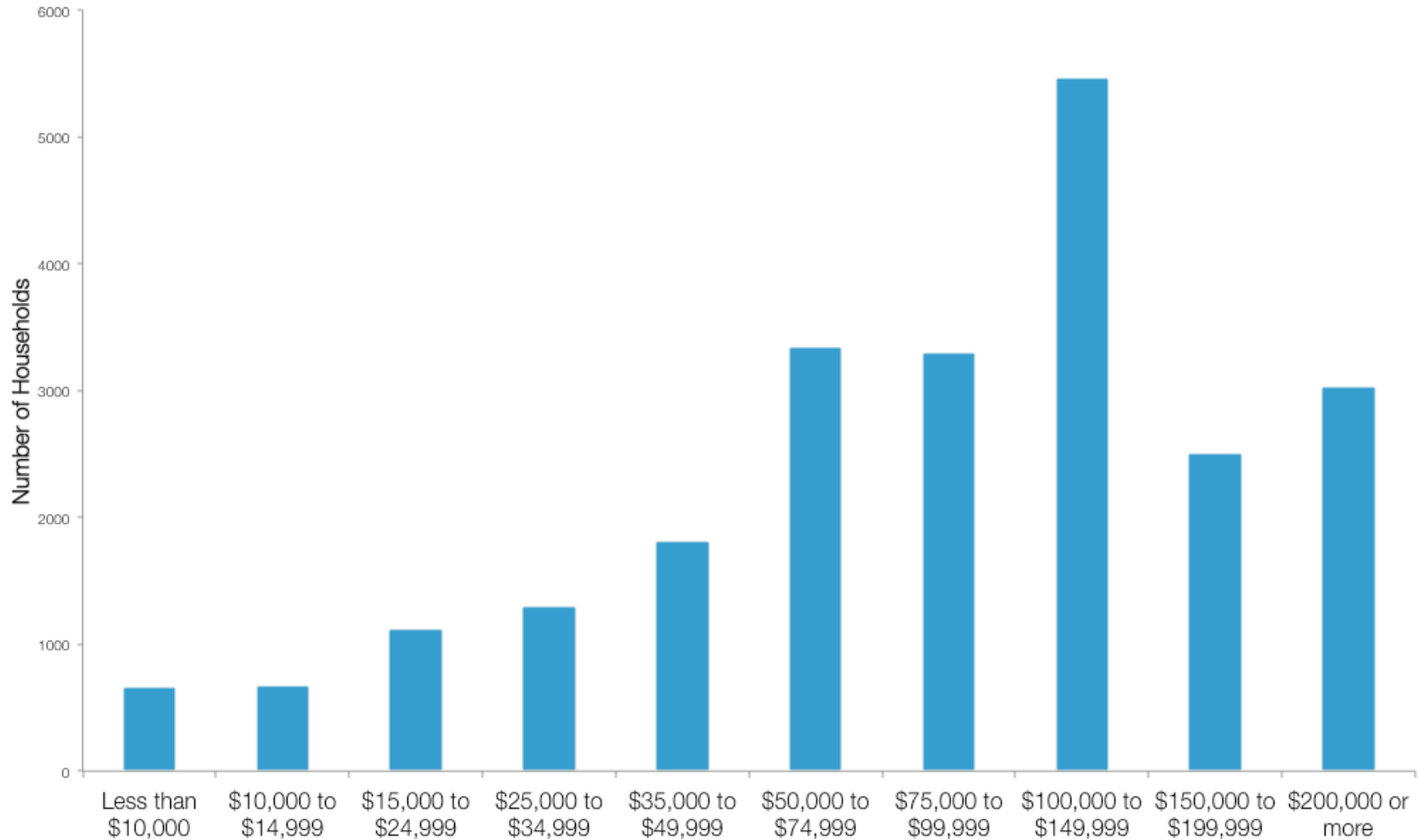


- Median age 34.1 years

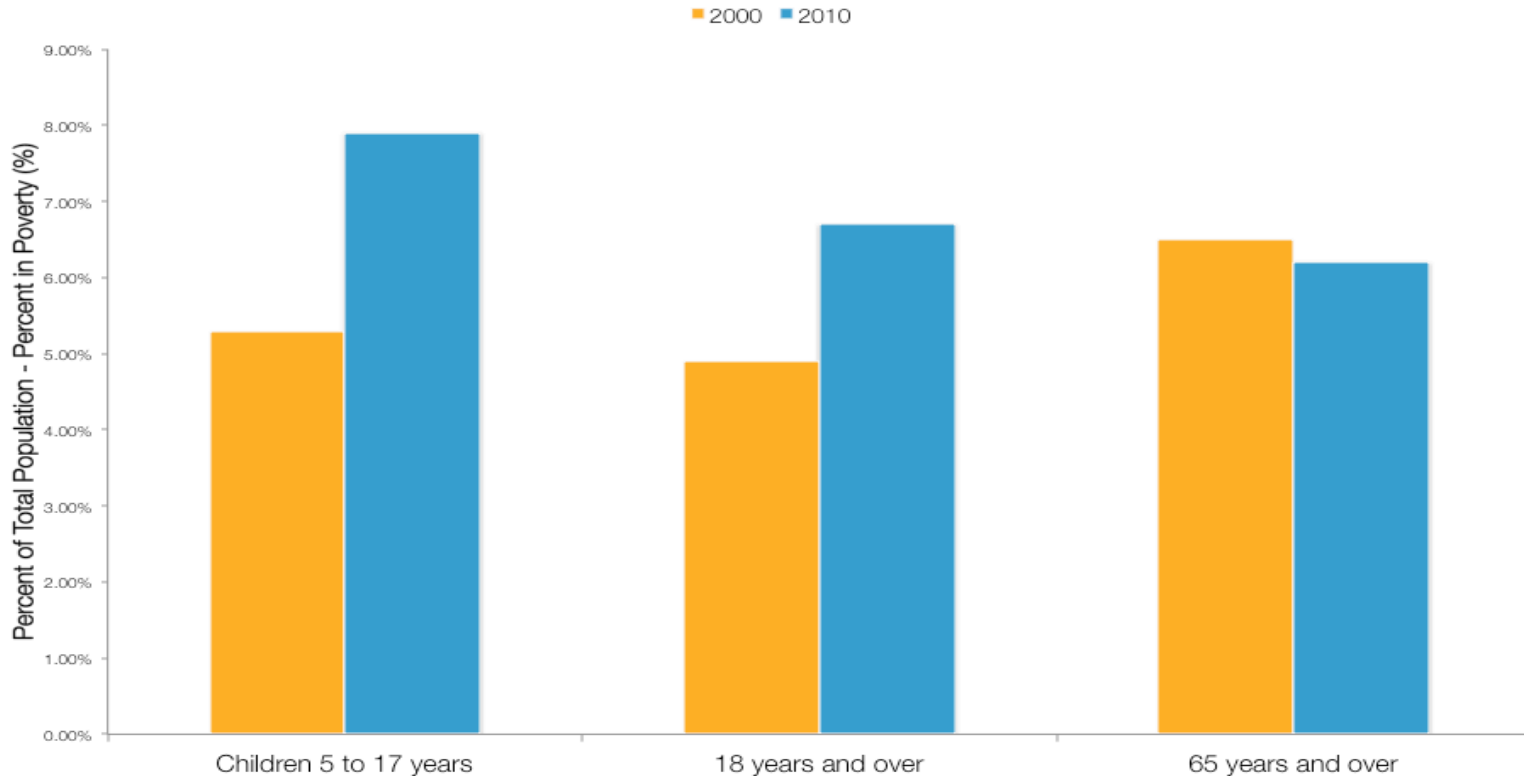


- **2012 median household income: \$93,215**

Housing Affordability

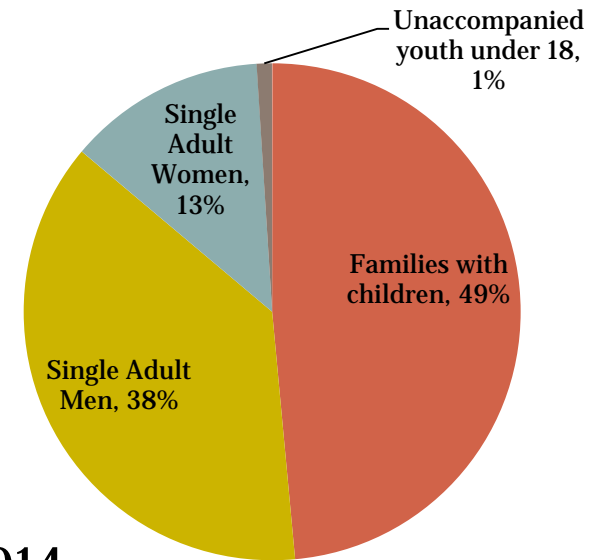
Calculation of Housing Affordability in Redmond	2012
Median Rent in Redmond per Month	\$1,388
Median Annual Household Income in Redmond	\$93,215
EXAMPLE: Calculations of Housing Affordability for a family with 30% of the Median Income	
Annual Household Income	\$27,964.5
Affordable Rent per Month (30% of Monthly Income)	\$699.11
RENT DIFFERENCE between Median Rent and Affordable Rent	\$688.89

- Median gross rent in 2012: \$1,388
- 27.7% of Redmond residents pay a rent that is 35.0 percent or more of their household income

Total Households Served in KC

- In 2014, King County reported
 - 4162 homeless households as sheltered
 - 2736 households as unsheltered

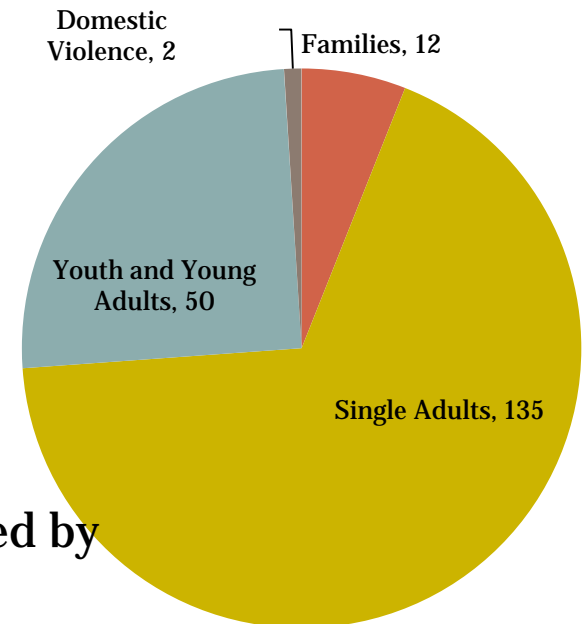

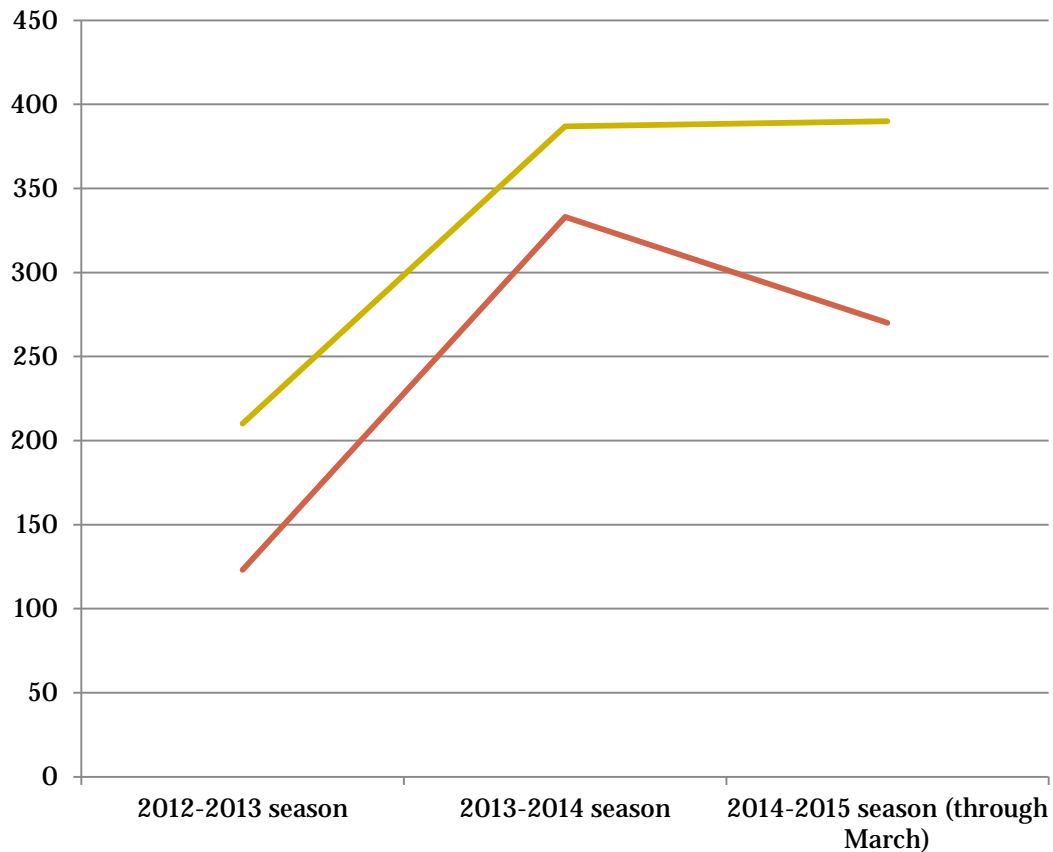

School District and 211 Calls

- LWSD has 271 homeless students (4/24/15). Attending schools in Redmond total 114.
- Housing related calls to 2-1-1 account for 57,896 calls in 2014 – nearly 50% of their entire call volume.

Housing Service Gap



- **Family Housing Connection**
 - Since 2012, 4839 households assessed
 - 81 Redmond families, with 33% placed
- **King County Housing Authority (KCHA)**
 - 21,994 applications for Section 8 vouchers
 - 1377 from Eastside residents

Community Meeting—Concerns Noted

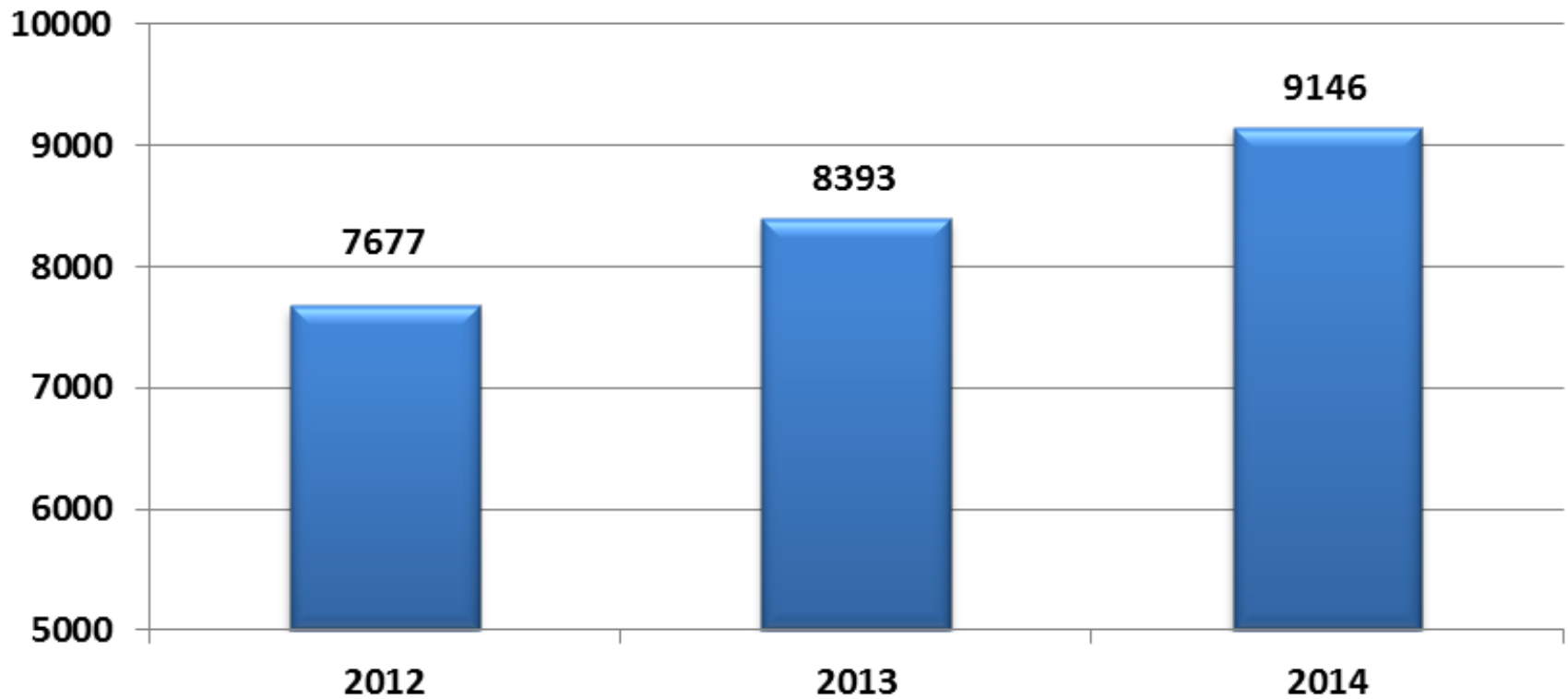


- **Safety/Crime (60 Comments)**

- **Not enough shelter space (7 comments)**

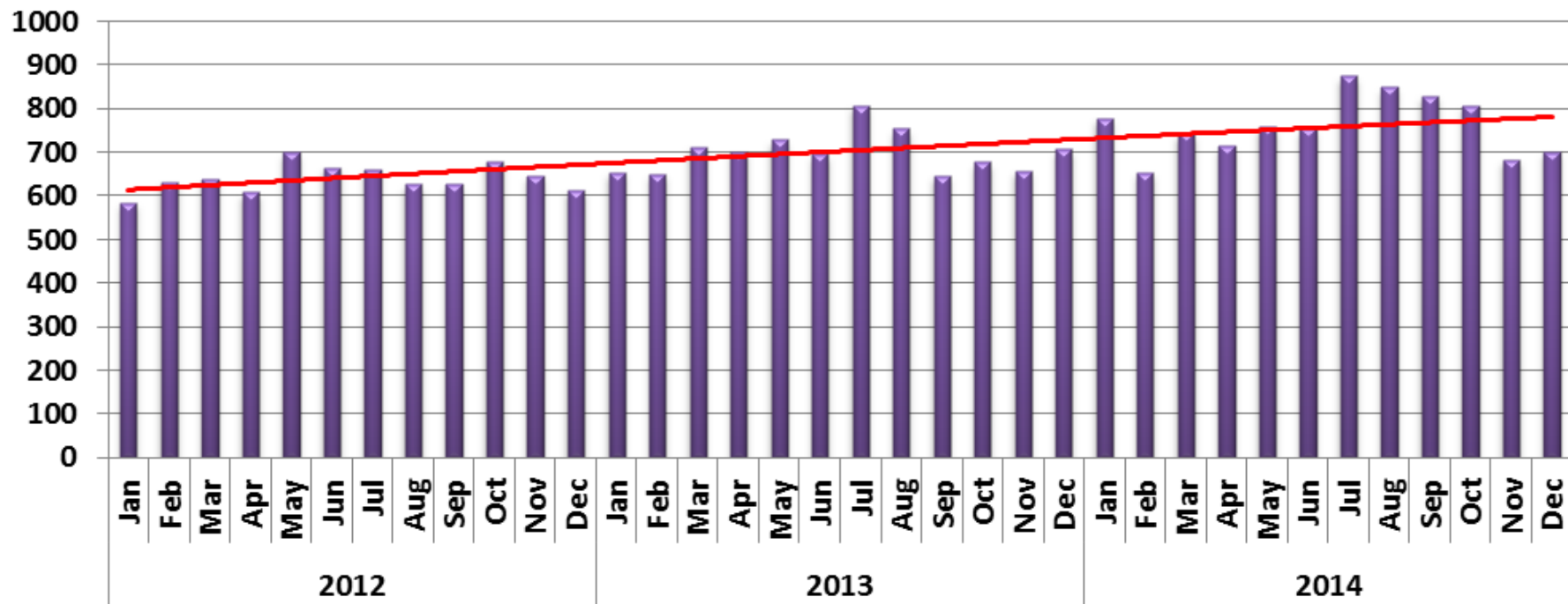

January 2012 - December 2014



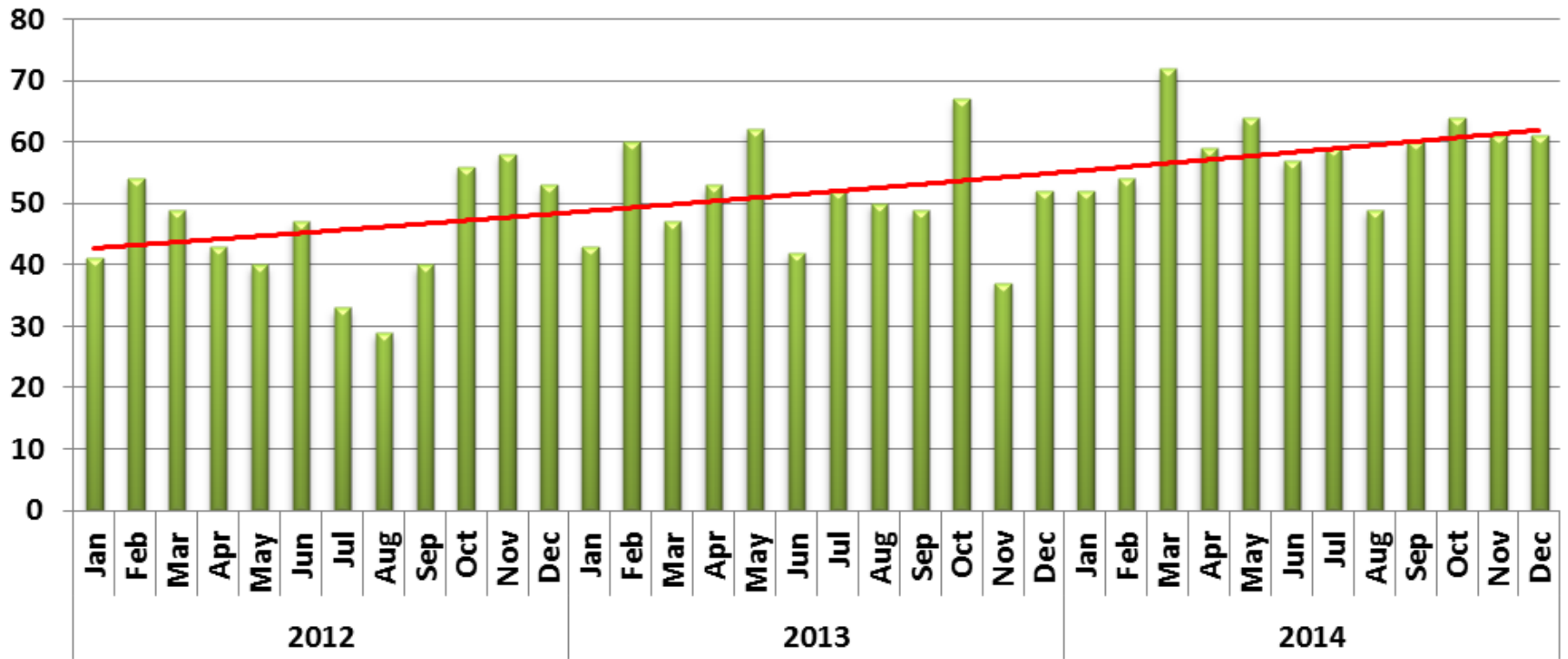
Calls for Service by Year - Downtown Area 2012 - 2014



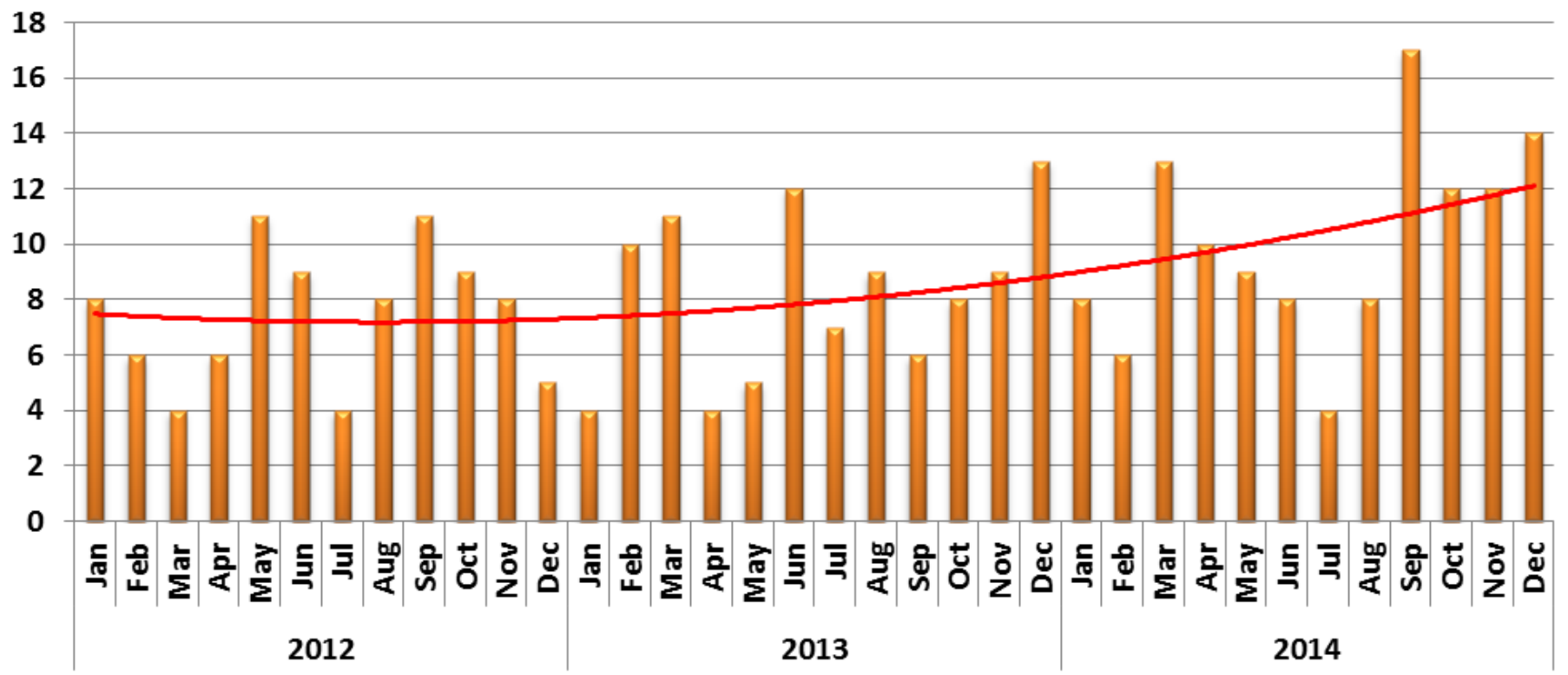
Calls for Service by Month - Downtown Area 2012 - 2014
