- #12. Withdraw said annexation of 65.2559 acres of land from Amherst Township to the City of Elyria an Expedited 2 request from Agent Jon Clark for Petitioner Lulo, LLC, by Sharon Ricardi, Member. This was due to a discrepancy in the legal description and there will be no decision on the May 8, 2026 agenda due to this withdrawal

Engineer:

Award & enter into a contract with Erie Blacktop Inc., Sandusky in the amount of \$251,959.80 for the North Ridge Rd Resurfacing Project, Sheffield Township. 8 bids were received this being the most responsive complying with specifications. Work consists of resurfacing North Ridge Rd to the east of Broadway from Broadway to Cooper Foster Park Rd. Issue a Notice to Proceed upon full execution of the contract and the work will be completed on or before October 31, 2026. Authorize County Administrator to notify County Auditor to release retainage at the completion of the project. Funds for this work will be provided by the OPWC in amount of \$186,450.25 and the remaining balance of \$65,509.55 will be paid by Acct#Permissive Engineer Project

- #15. Award & enter into a contract with Kokosing Construction, Elyria in the amount of \$2,590,934.75 for the Pyle South Amherst Rd Resurfacing Project, New Russia Township. 2 bids were received this being the most responsive complying with specifications. Work consists of resurfacing and widening Pyle South Amherst Rd from SR 511 to the Village of South Amherst Corporation. Issue Notice to Proceed upon full execution of the contract and the work will be completed on or before October 15, 2026. Funds for this work will be provided by the NOACA through ODOT in amount of \$1,778,415.00 and OPWC in the amount of \$485,024.00. Remaining balance of \$327,495.75 will be paid by Acct# Permissive Engineer Project

Approve & enter into a Consulting Services Agreement with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., Garfield Heights, Ohio in the amount of \$134,907.00 Construction Administration, Inspection and Testing for the Pyle South Amherst Road Resurfacing Project in New Russia Township. 80% of the funding or \$107,925.60 will be paid from Acct#Engineer's Permissive Project with the balance of \$26,981.40 from OPWC
