

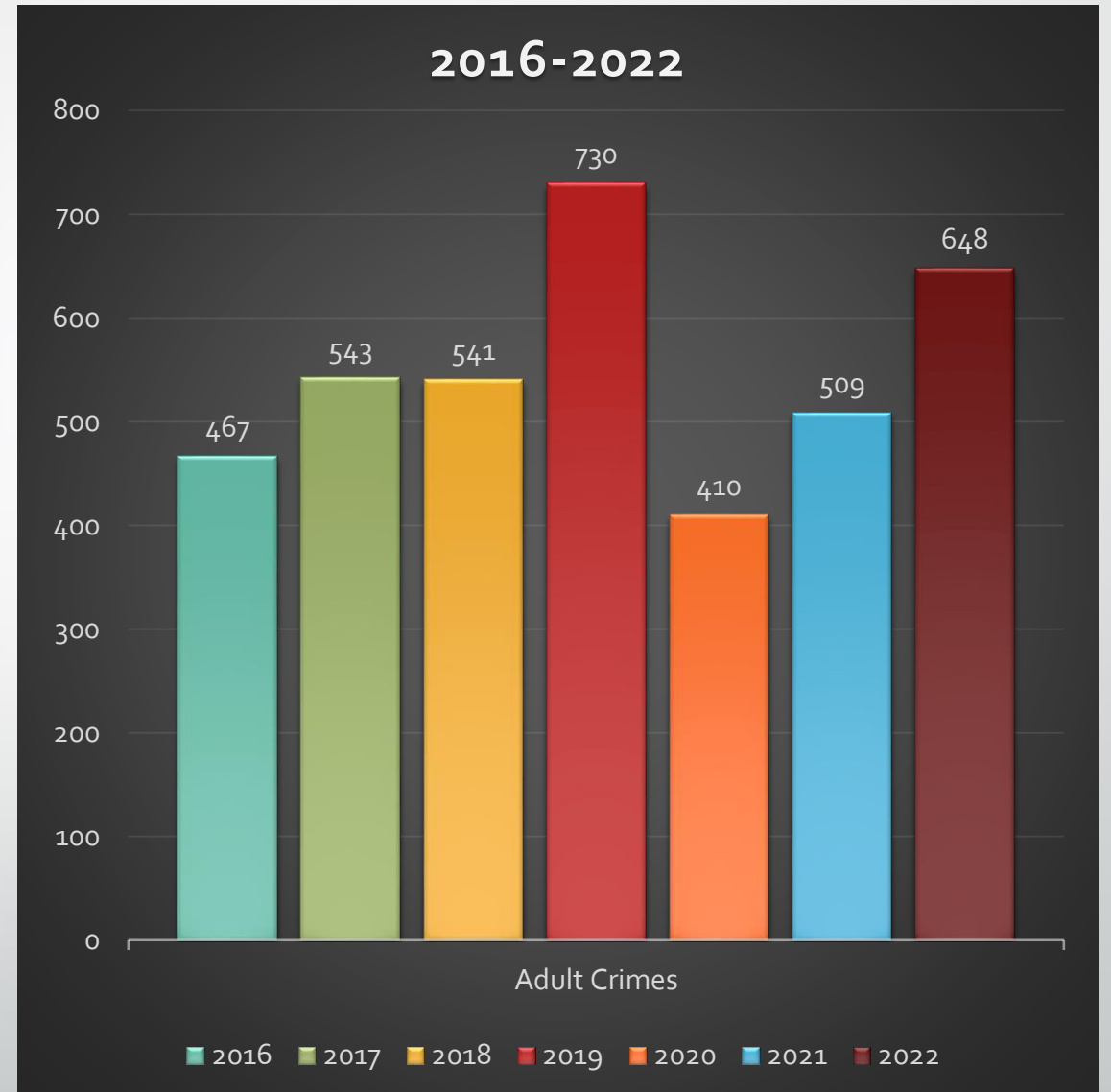

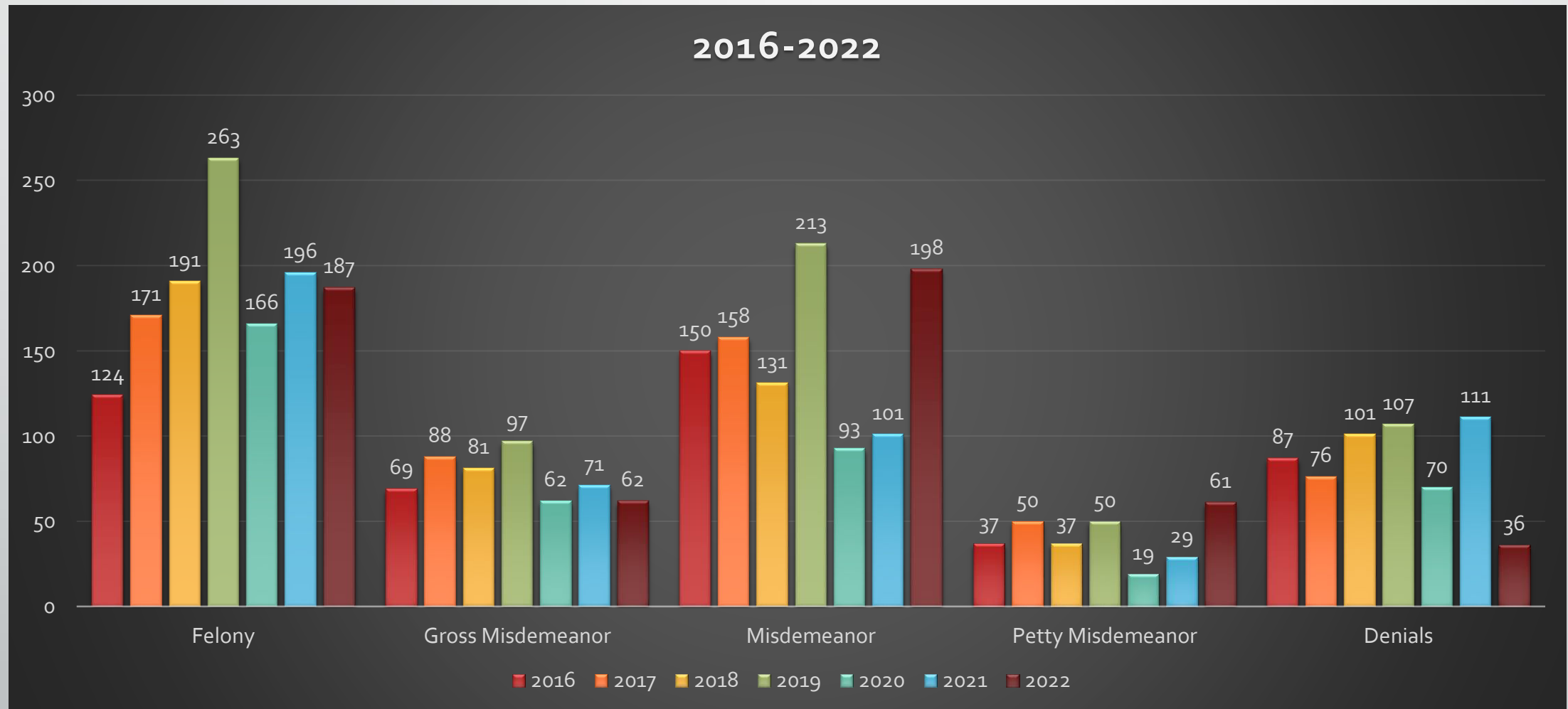


Adult Criminal Files

 - 2016 = 467

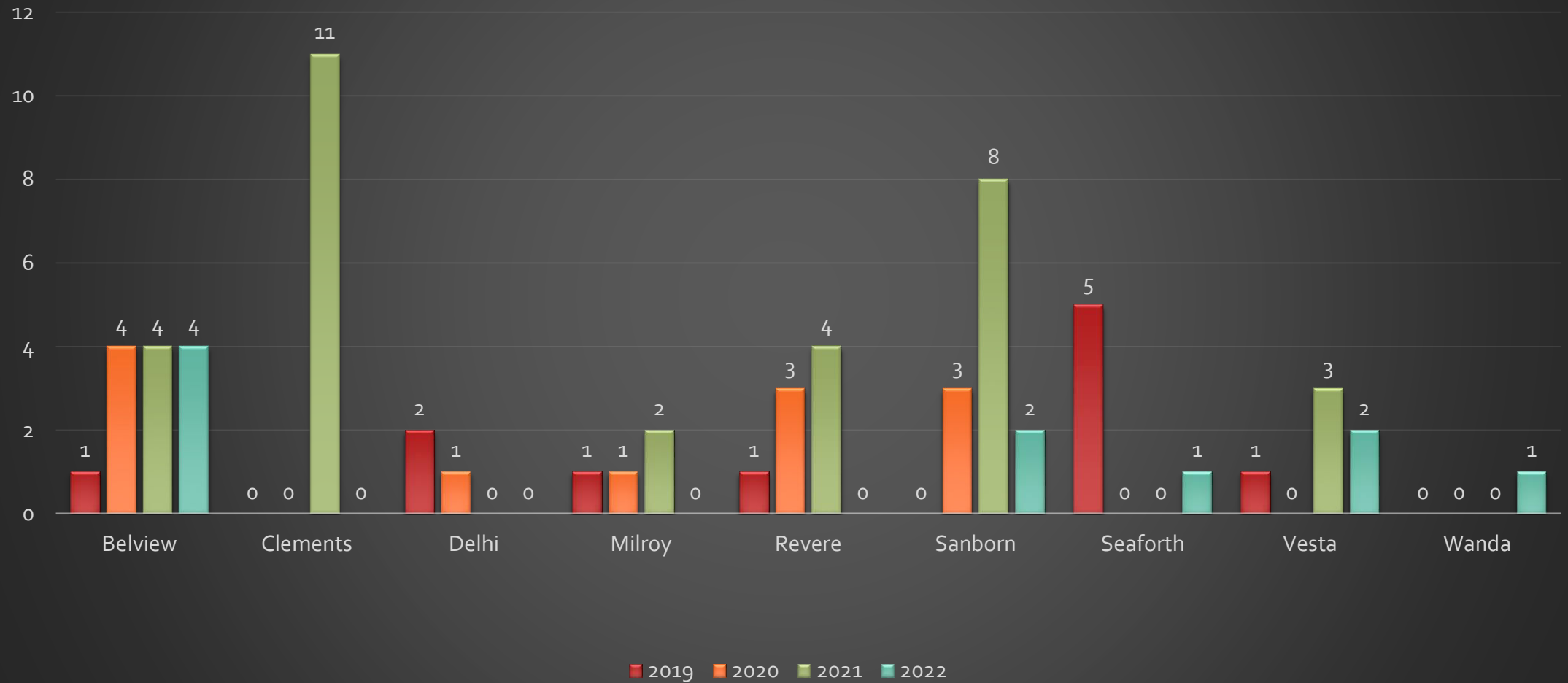

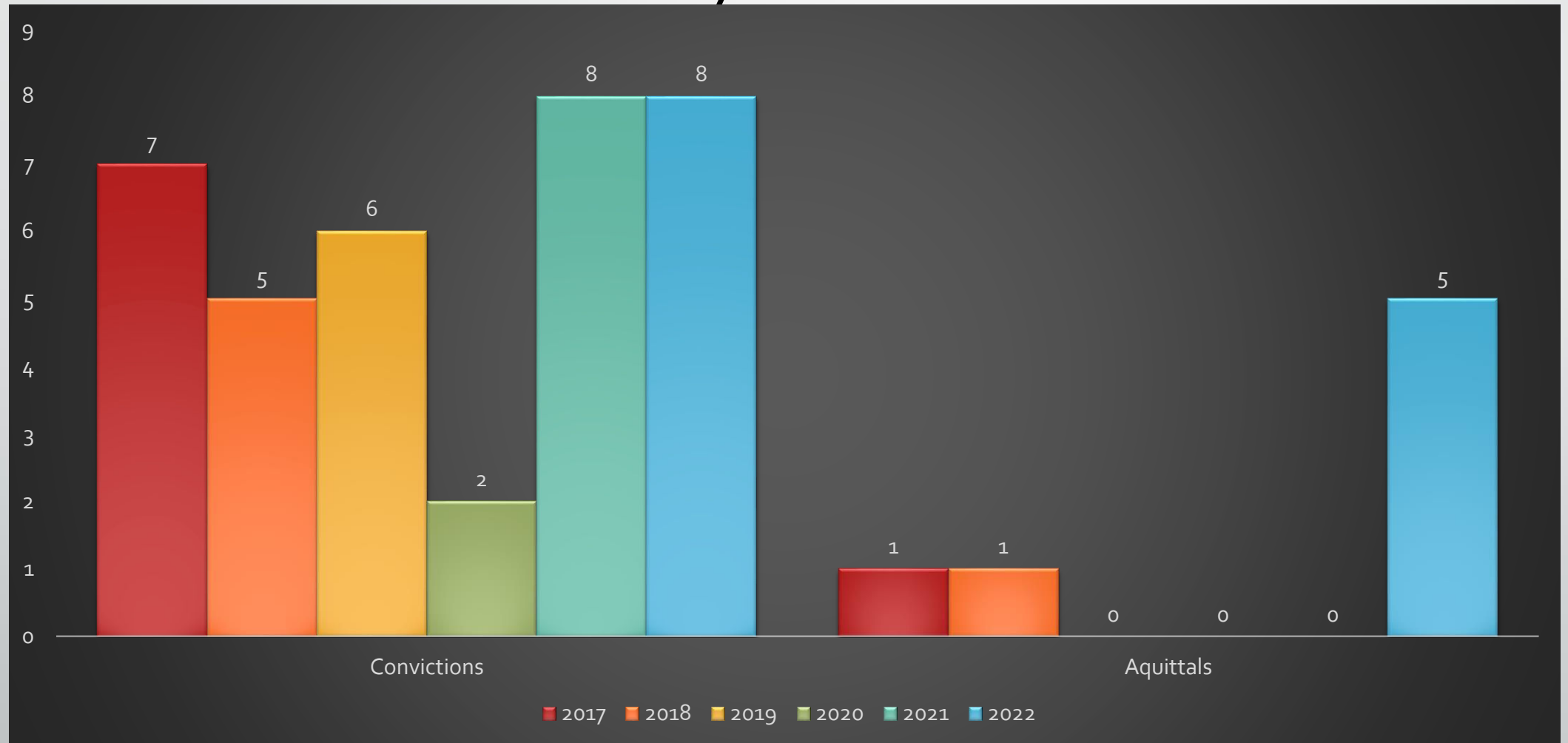


City Prosecution

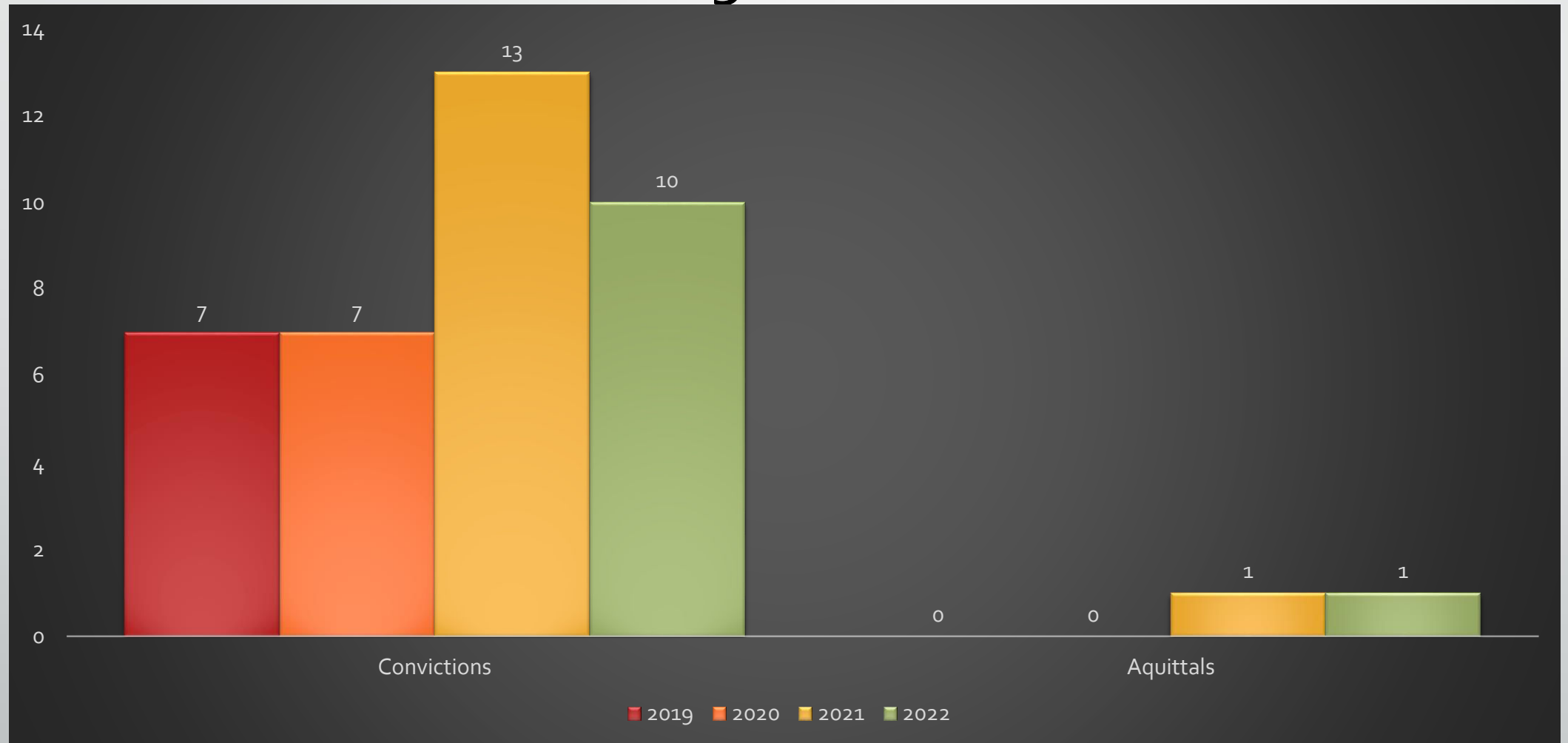

Jury Trials 2017-2022

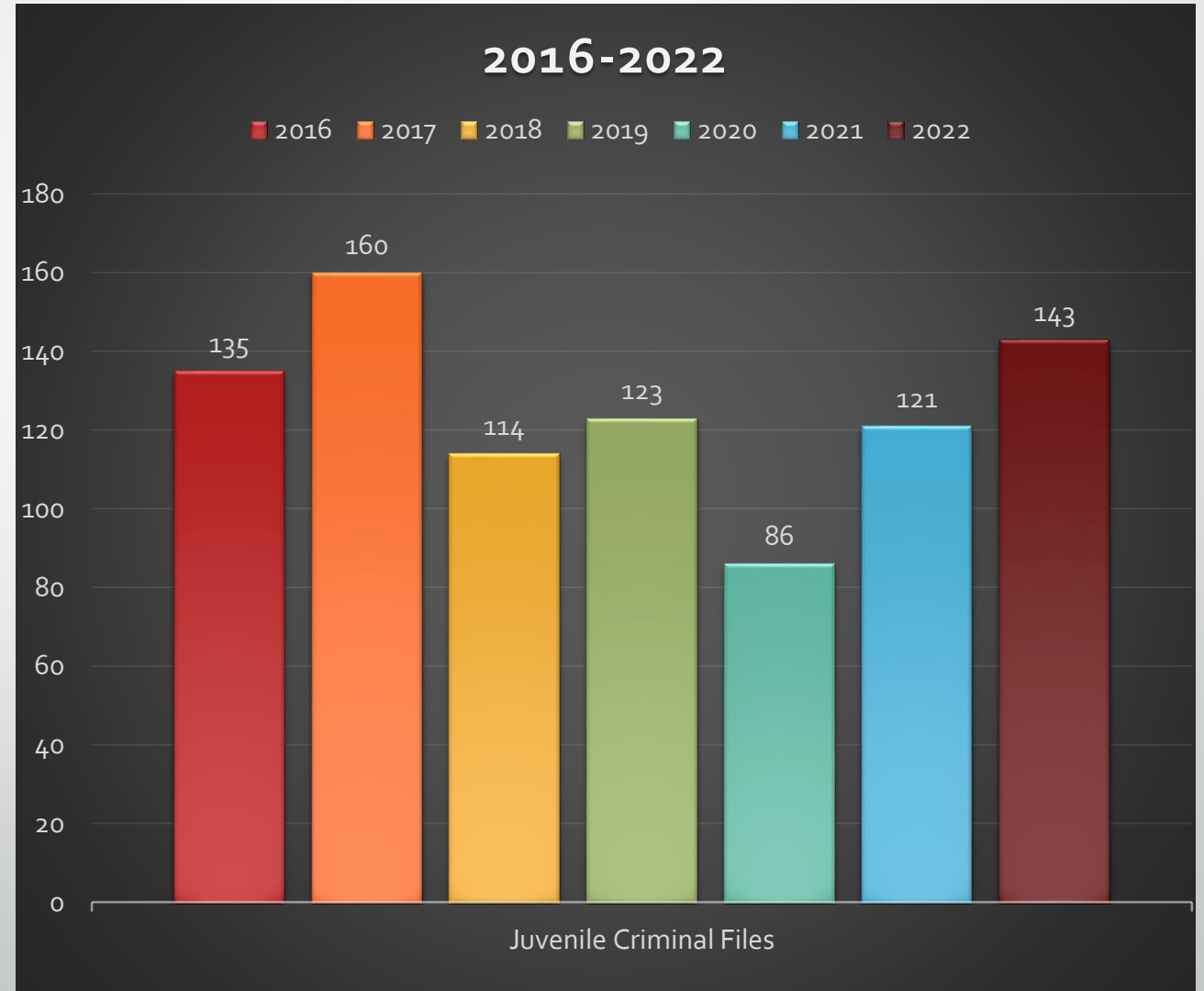


Court Trials 2019-2022

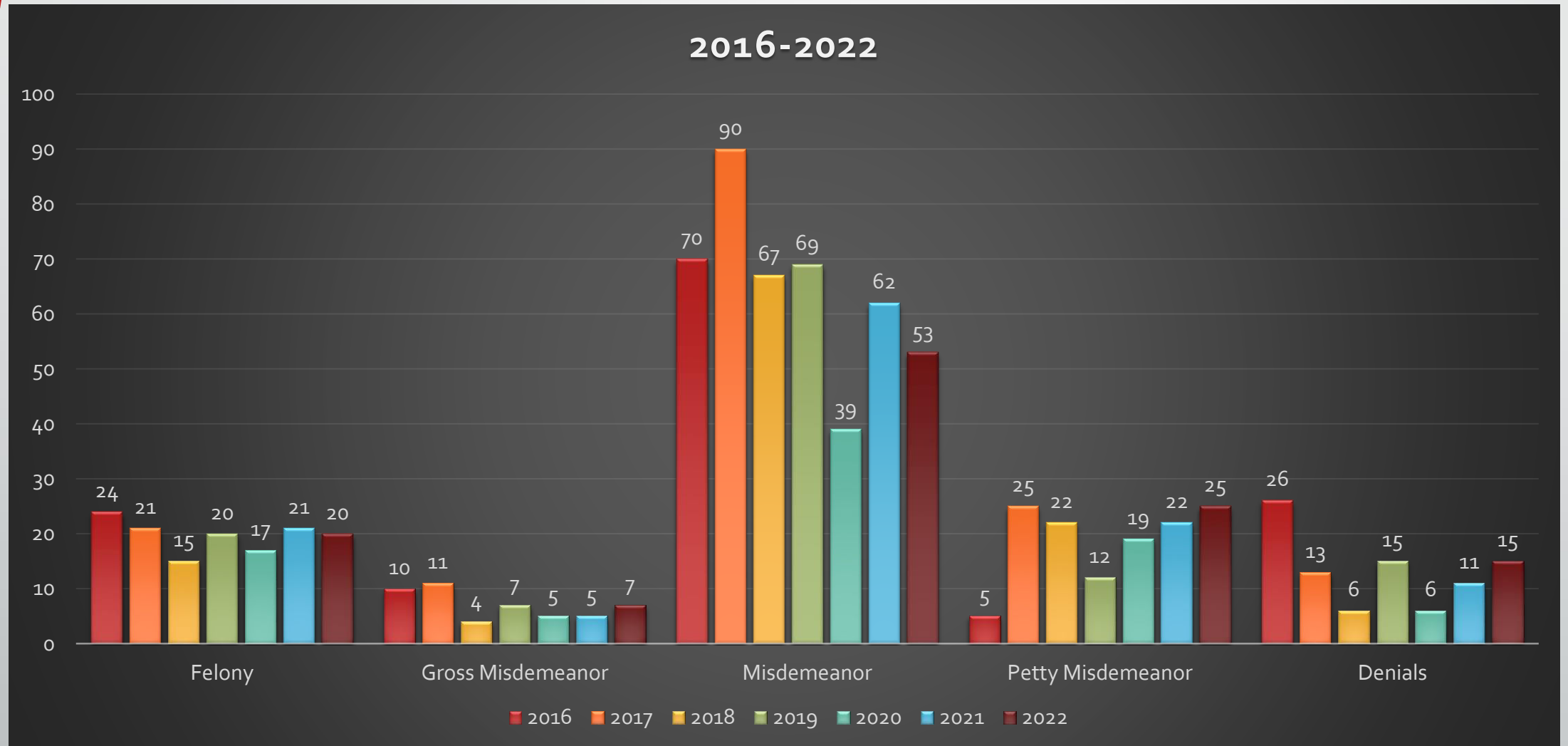

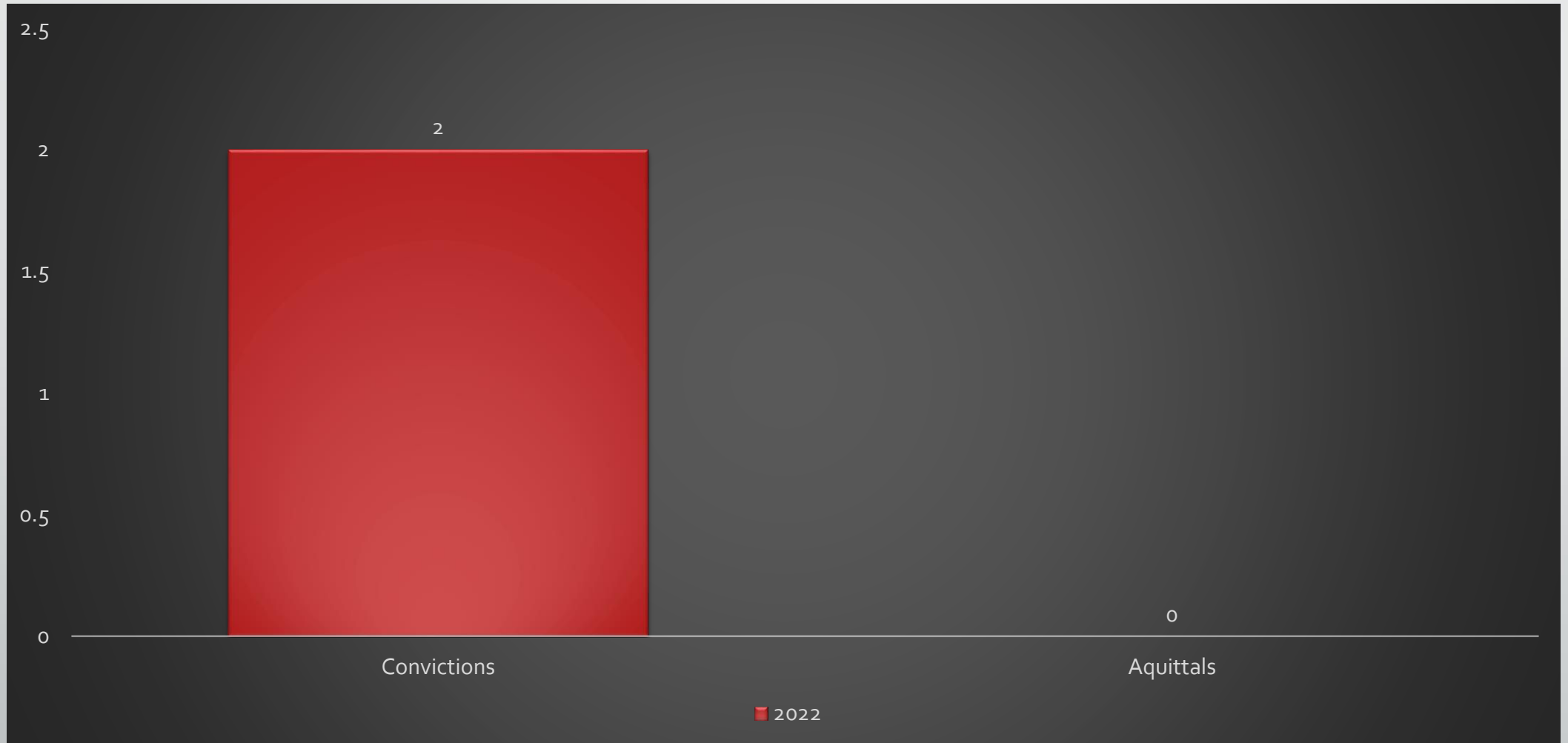

 - 2016 = 135



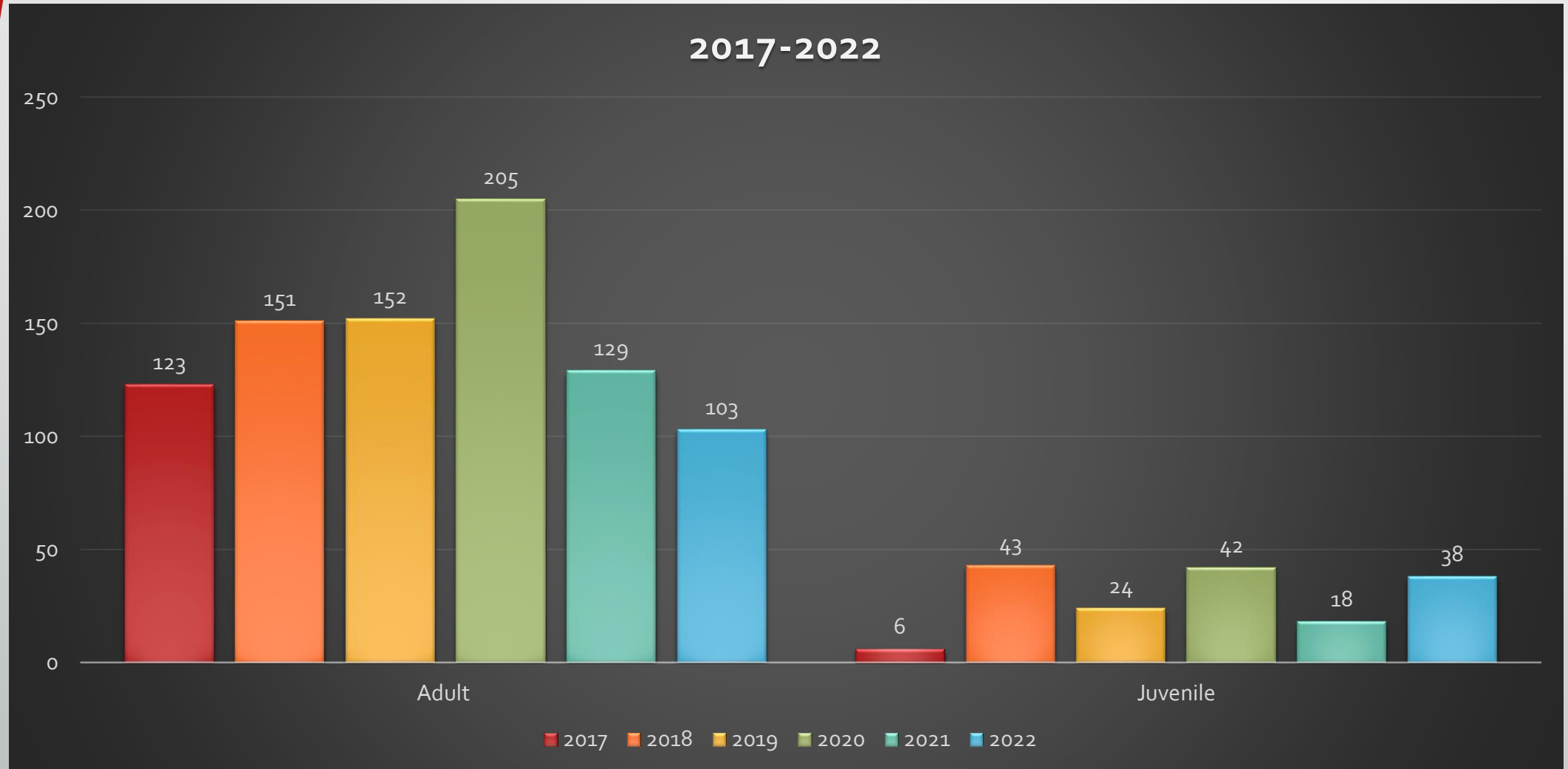

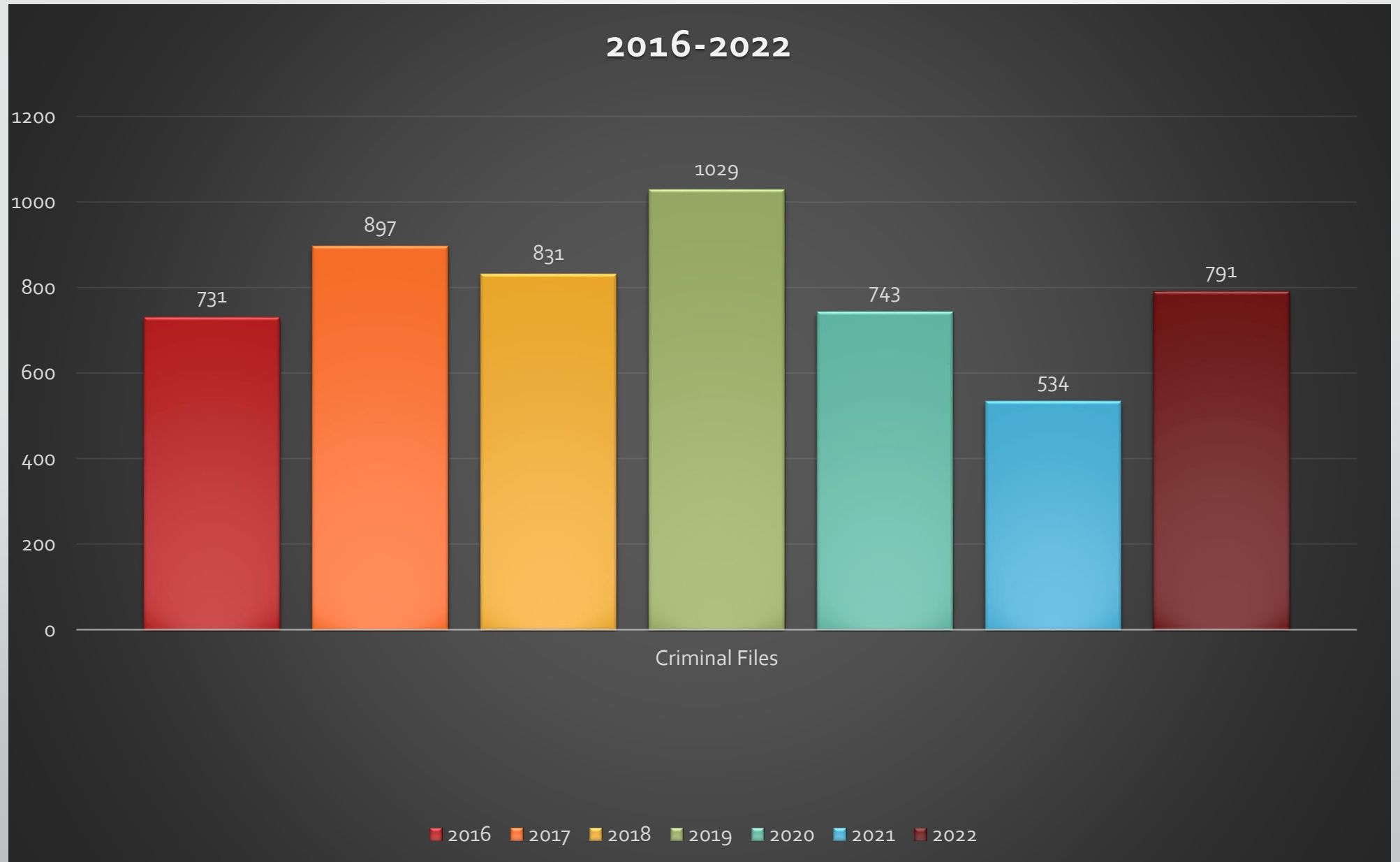

Probation Violations

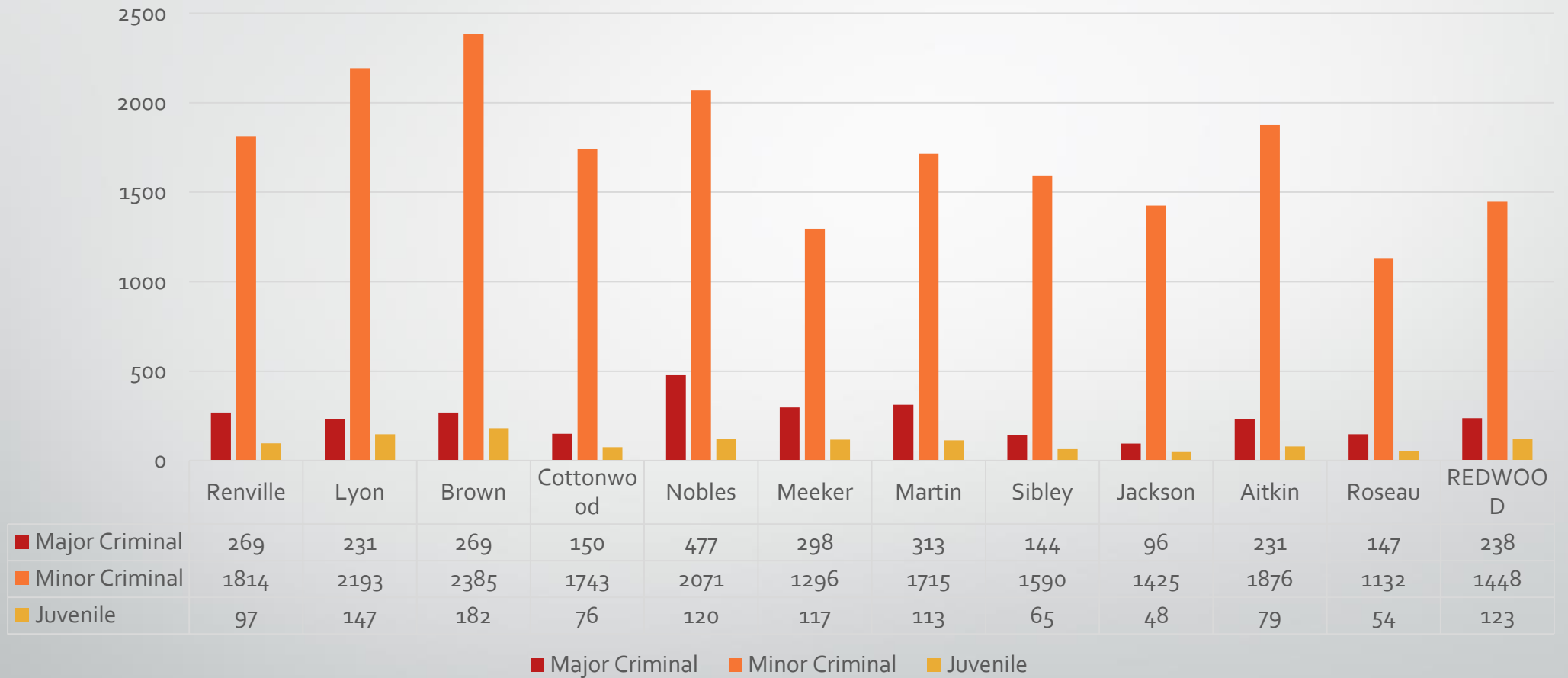


Criminal Totals

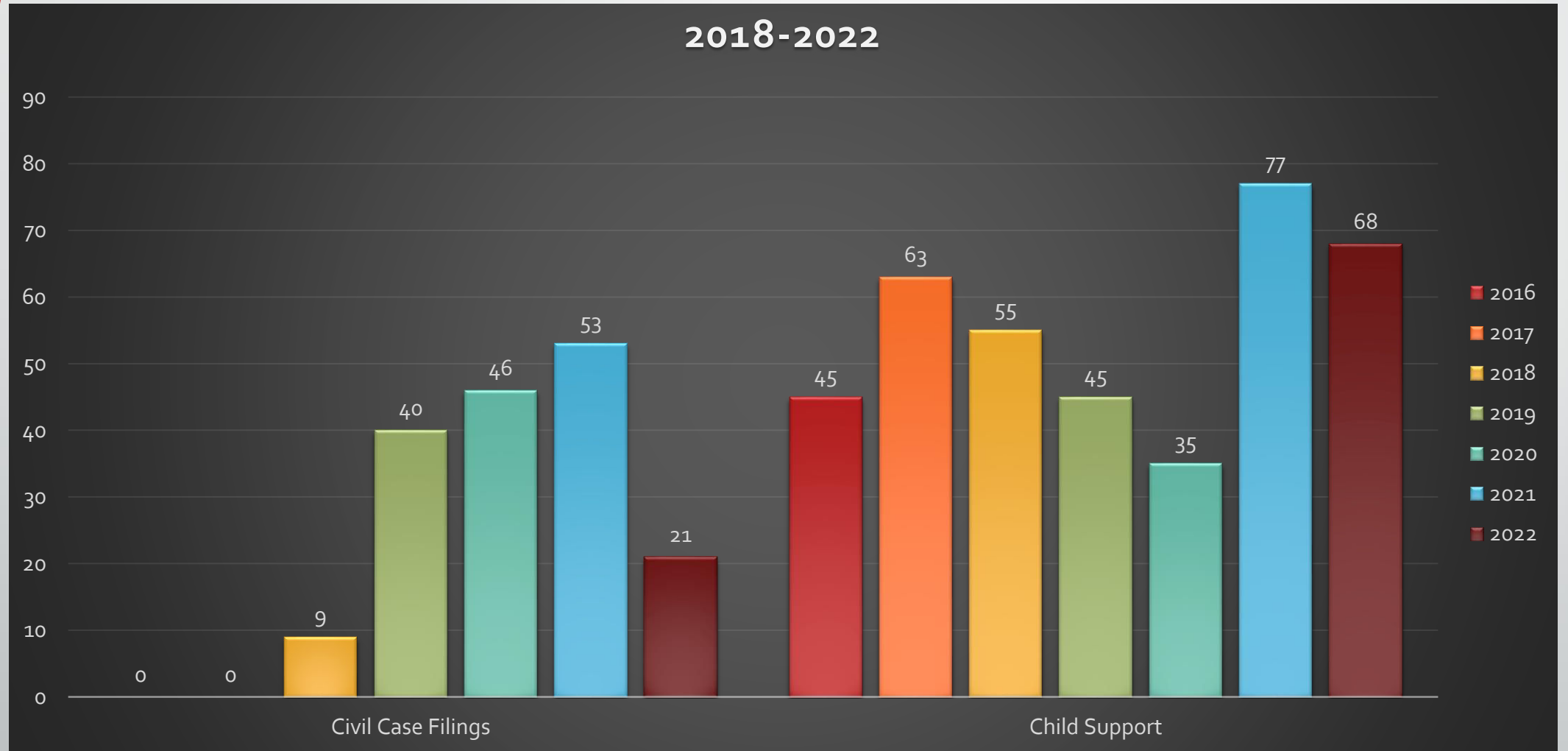


Criminal Case Filings

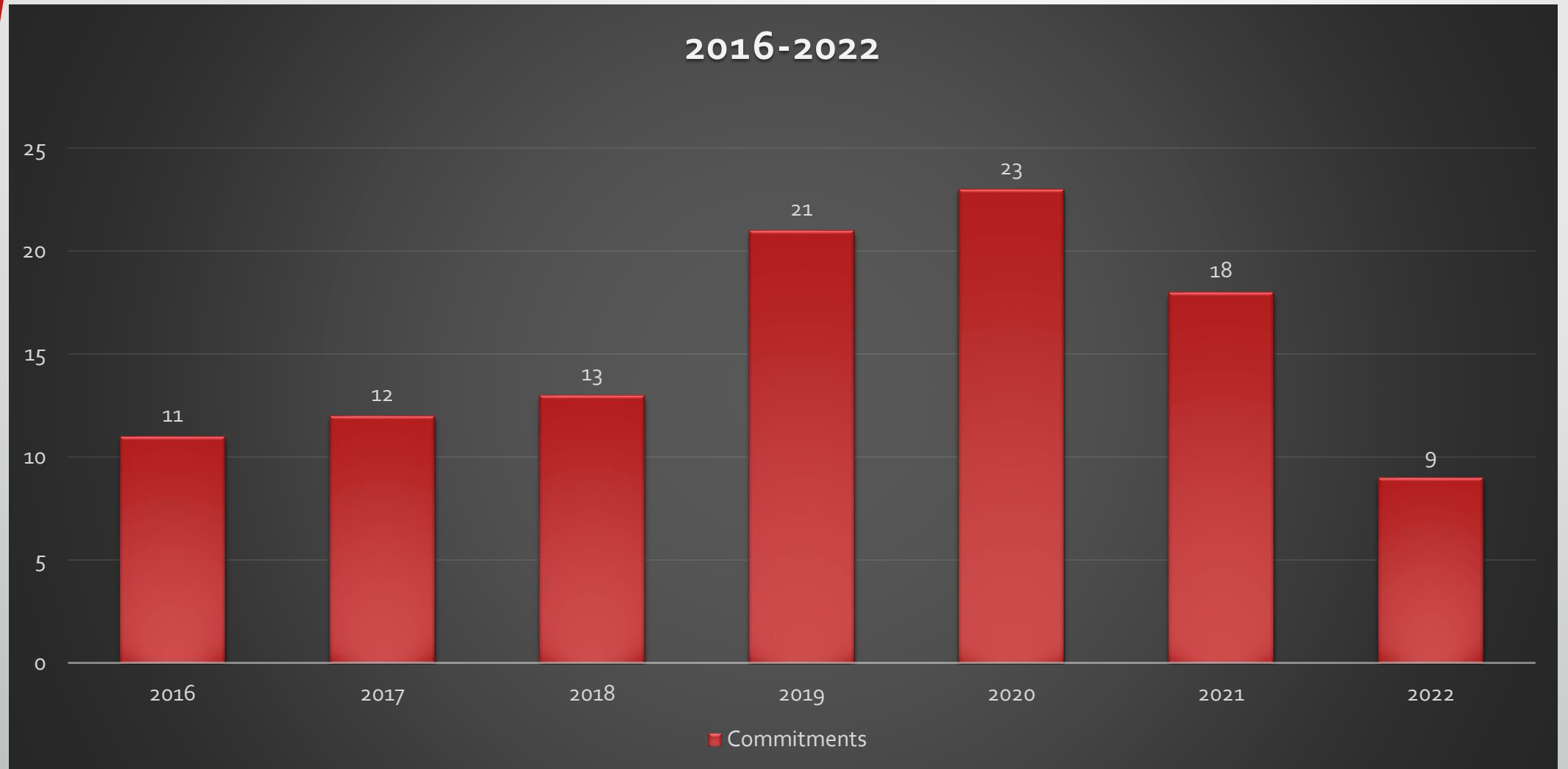

Civil Case Filings

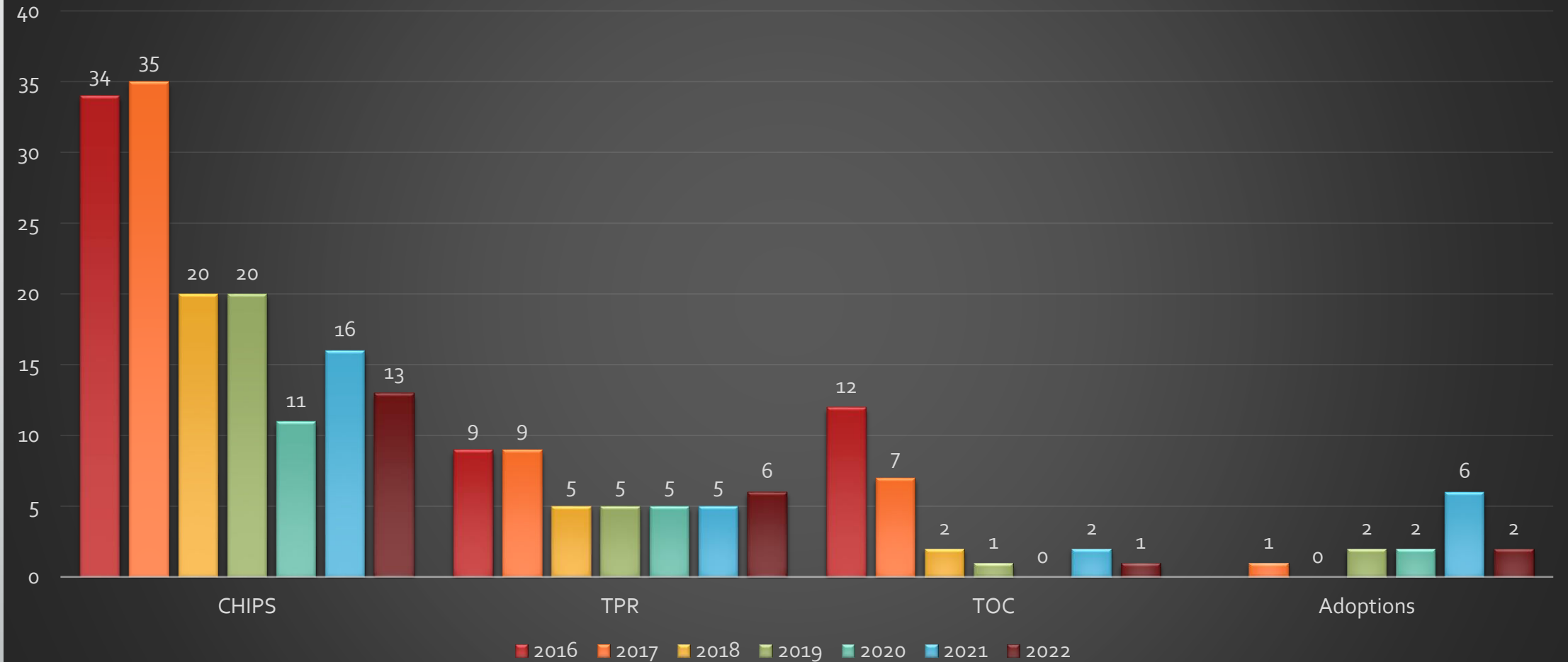

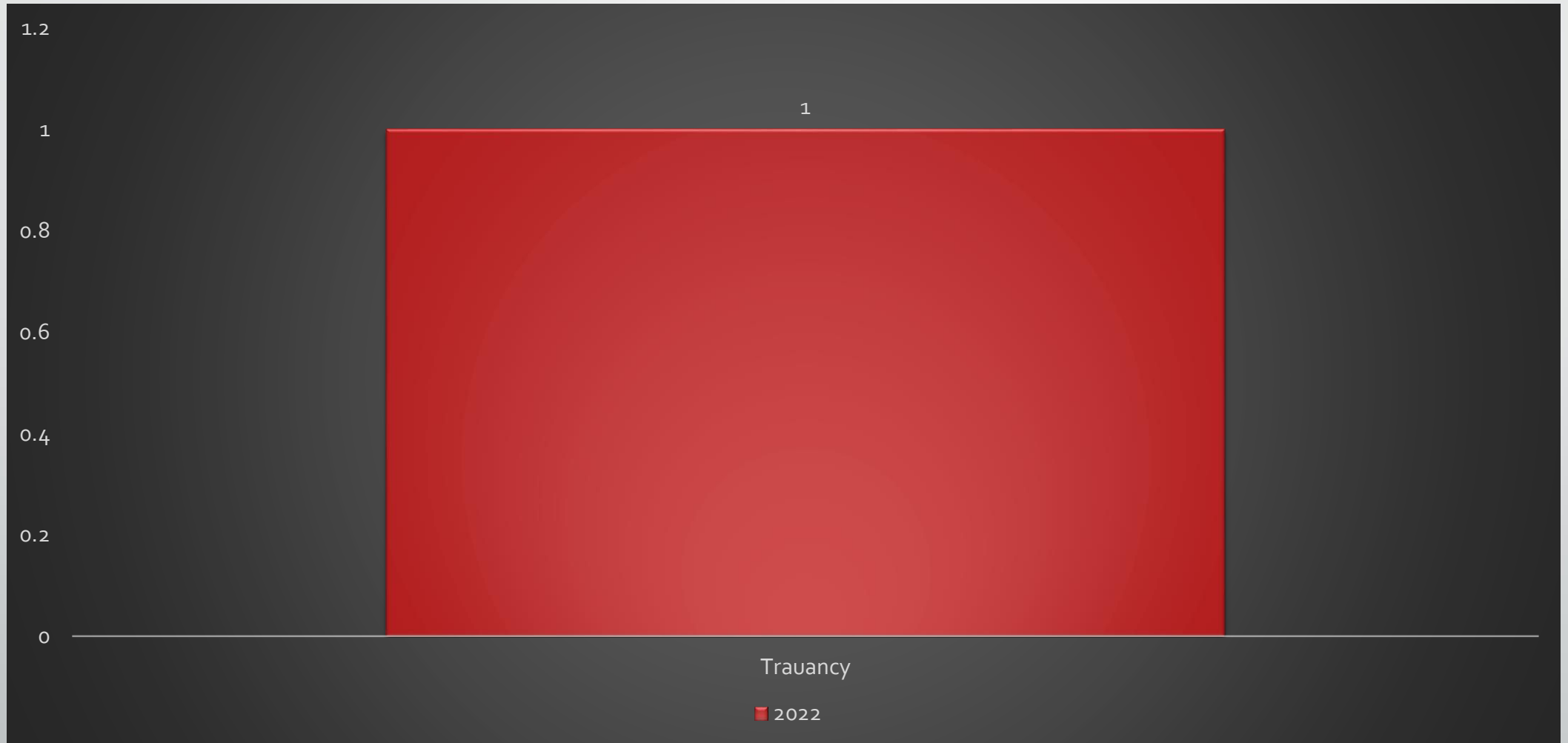


Child Protection Cases

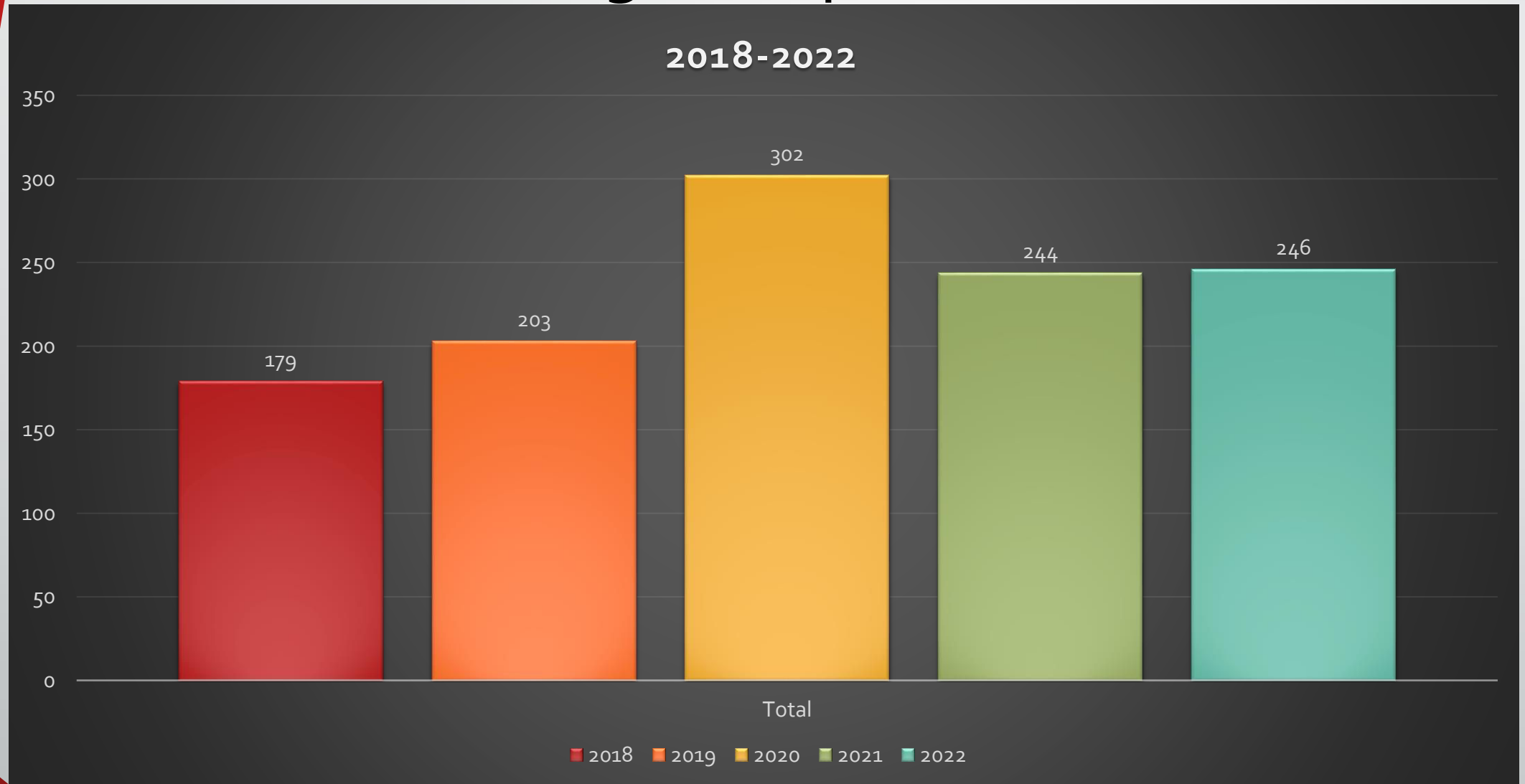

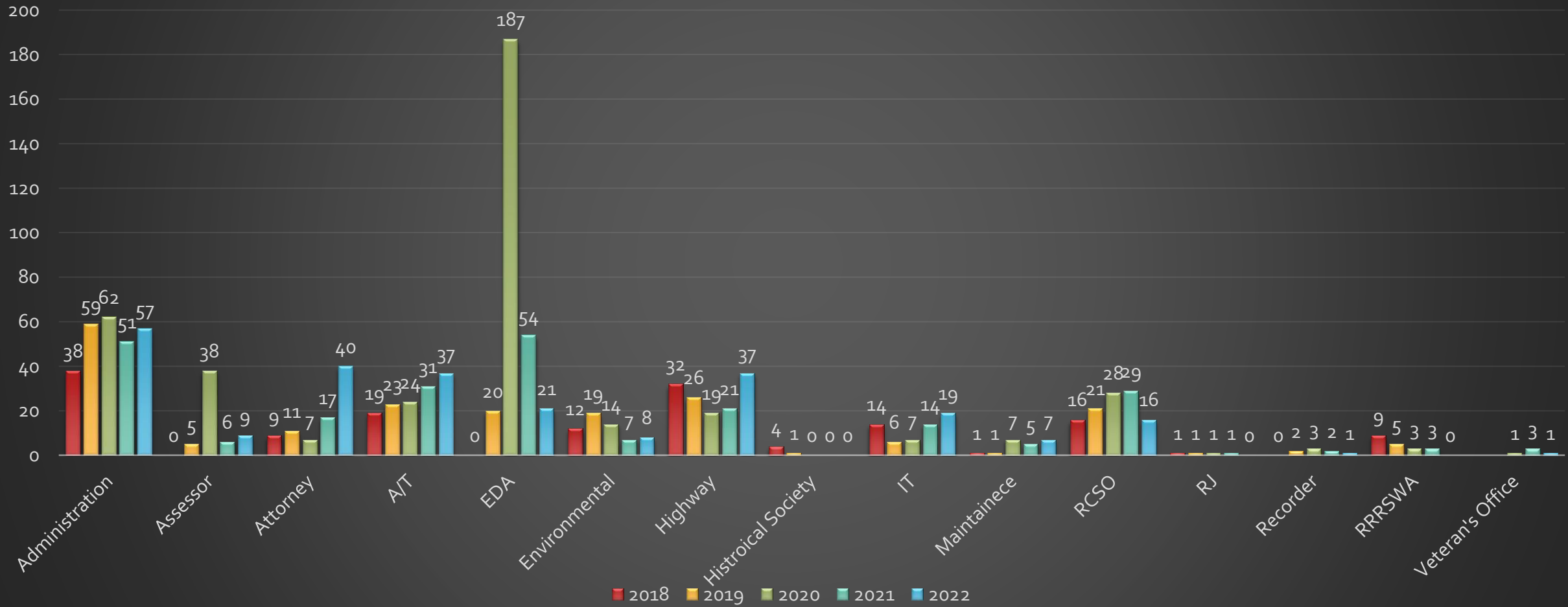


Legal Requests

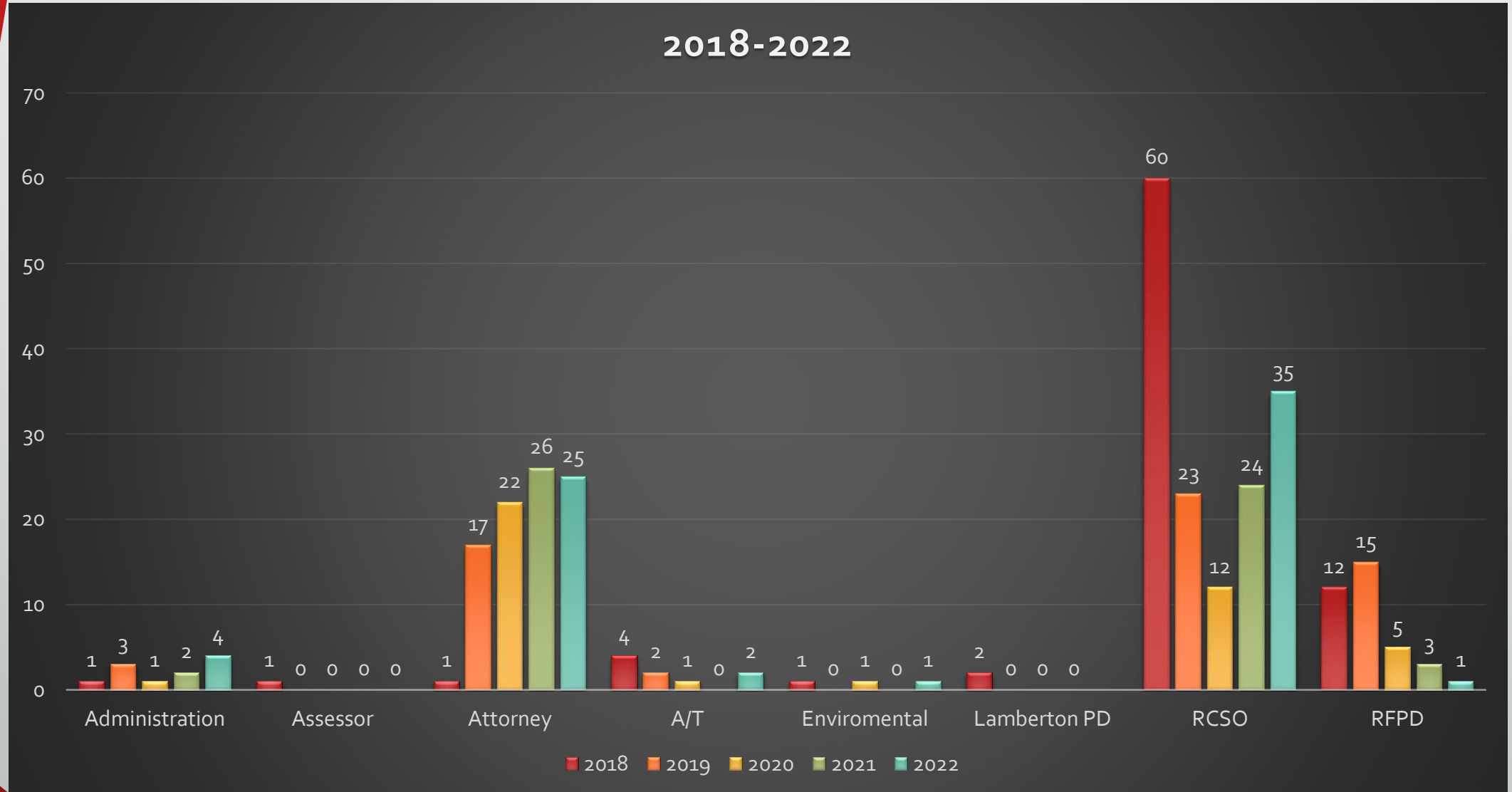


Legal Requests by Department

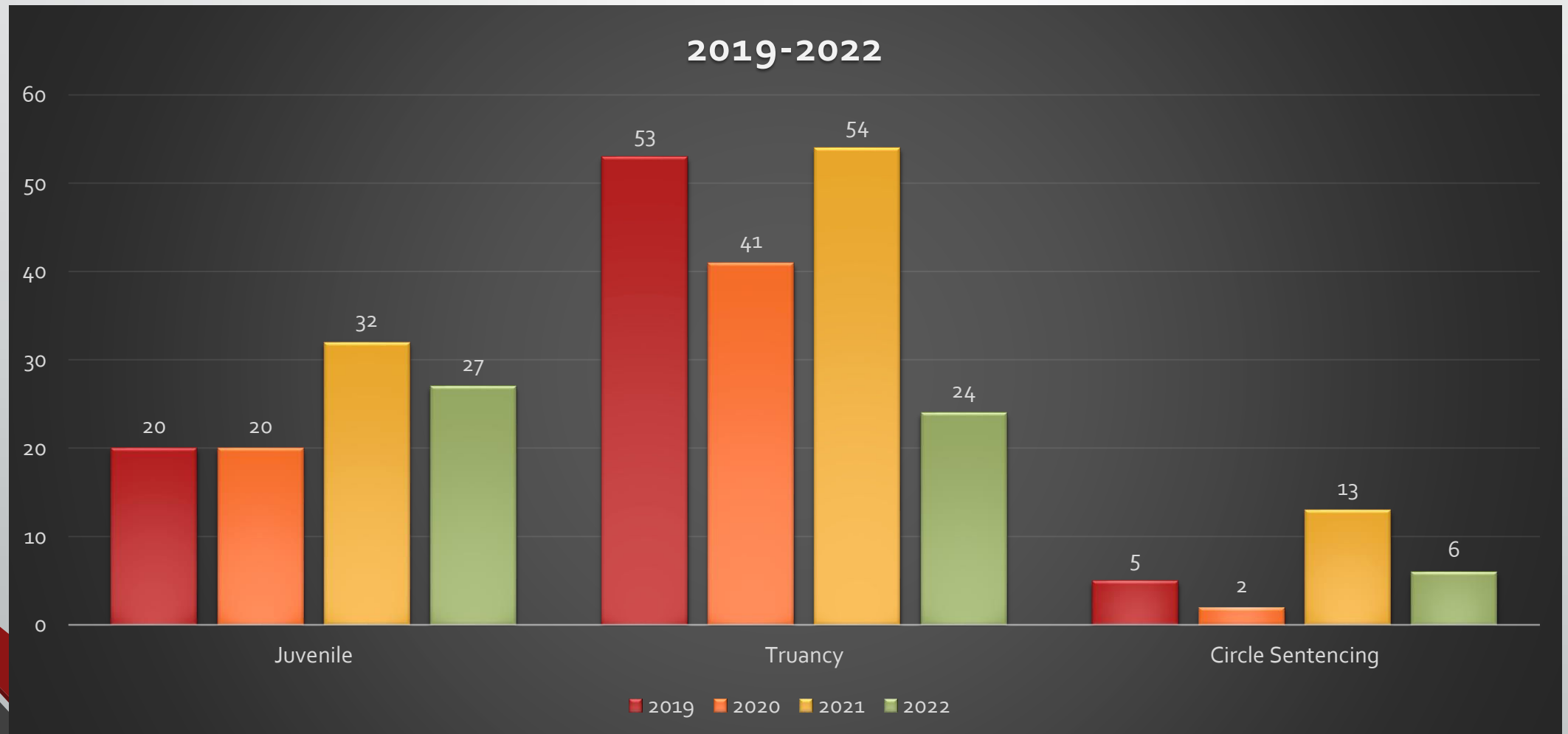

Other

- CAC/Child's Place Forensic Interviews:
 - 2019 = 33
 - 2020 = 35
 - 2021 = 32
 - 2022 = 42
- Administrative subpoenas:
 - 2018 = 22
 - 2019 = 10
 - 2020 = 20
 - 2021 = 27
 - 2022 = 15

2022 oddities

- COVID postage (March 1 – December 31, 2020) = \$455.05
 - 2021 - \$2,576.75
 - 2022 - \$1,686.57
- Subpoena service:
 - 2019 = \$4,076.26
 - 2020 = \$3,804
 - 2021 = \$5,158.52
 - 2022 = \$7,936.88
- Have 61 trials currently scheduled (only 43 weeks left this year!)
- Have been appearing for most hearings via Zoom since December 2020; pushing to go back in person on criminal files
- DHS Appeal – 2 of these in 2022
- Budget – did all of this using only 88.5% of our budget.
