

## **Wynnedale Town Council Meeting Minutes**

**Nov. 13, 2019**

Present: Clerk-treasurer Jarnell Craig; Council members John Kincaid, Vimal Mehta, Janet Gibson, Judy Hall and Mary Beth Schneider

Meeting convened at 7:05 pm

This is the first meeting since the election. Leaving the council as they did not run for re-election are Kincaid, Gibson and Hall. Mehta lost in the election. The new council members for 2020 will be Mary Beth Schneider, Sue Rice, Joshua Smith, Ann Hildner and Andy Hawickhorst, with Craig continuing as clerk-treasurer.

Craig presented treasurer's report. \$5,000 had to be withdrawn from the town's Money Market account due to cash flow, and will be replaced in 2020. Total deposits and balance of town funds: \$81,789.56.

Unfinished business discussed included Steve Koers shutting off the water supply to the sprinklers on the esplanade.

Snow removal was discussed. Joshua Darring — who now has contract for mowing of esplanade and Sleepy Hollow — had bid that was \$100 more than in the past. Craig informed the council that we needed to receive more bids before a contract is awarded. In the meantime, Darring will do the snow plow if necessary until we obtain additional bids.

Council meetings in the future will be moved out of Craig's basement room and to the public space at the Fitness Farm at 2525 West 44th Street. A decision also was made to move council meetings in 2020 from the second Wednesday of each month to the first Tuesday of the month. First council meeting of 2020 would be Jan. 7.
