February 17, 2025

The Abercrombie City Council meeting was held on February 17, 2025 at the Community Hall. The meeting was called to order by David Hammond at 7:00pm. The members present were Kris Hasbargen, Brian Heinz, David Hammond, and Alexander Paczkowski. Mayor Shawn Paczkowski was absent.

Councilman Heinz made a motion to approve the January 2025 meeting minutes and was seconded by Councilman Hasbargen and passed.

Public Input:

OTPC with Richland County Conservation District to discuss a 2:1 tree replacement program due to solar panels. Discussion was had. The City will reach out to property owners on the north and west sides of town to discuss the possibility of having trees/shrubs planted to help with blowing snow.

Old Business

Did not get approved for NDOT grant for walking path.

Discussion had on water operator/and billing position interest.

The junk/abandon vehicles 707 Abercrombie Street have been towed from the property.

Update on dog attack: The dog is still at the pound due to Court proceedings.

New Business

Councilman A. Paczkowski offered 1st reading of the new Flood Plain Ordinance (Ordinance 2026-2) and was seconded by Councilman Hasbargen and passed.

- 2 City Council member positions (4 year term) are up for re-election
- 3 Park Board member positions (4 year term) are up for re-election

Candidates are required to file a Petition/Certificate of Nomination, and a Statement of Interest.

Any qualified elector who has been a resident of the City of Abercrombie for at least nine (9) months is eligible to be a member of the City Council or Park Board.

CD's are up for renewal and will be renewed.

Tax equalization meeting will be on April 21st at 6:00pm.

Aber Park Museum is requesting sponsorship for frisbee golf course. Councilman Heinz made a motion to donate \$2,500 and was seconded by Councilman Hasbargen and passed.

Councilman A. Paczkowski made a motion to pay bills was seconded by Councilman Heinz and passed.

Councilman Heinz made a motion to adjourn and was seconded by Councilman Hasbargen and passed. Meeting ended at 8:12p.m.
