Water/Sewer Bills go out on *January*, April, July, & October 1st.

Your January Water/Sewer Bill will be due on January 31st without penalty.

A 2% penalty will be added monthly if not paid. **Postmarks will be accepted prior to February 1st.**

The \$75.00 past due penalty only applies if your OCTOBER bill went unpaid.

Please call our office with any questions regarding your bill.

A \$75.00 Turn-on fee will be collected to have water service restored.

ALL LANDLORDS & HOMEOWNERS WITH RENTALS

are required to submit a Rental Property Registration application annually (\$50) & a Tenancy Certificate of Occupancy (\$20 per unit). These forms and fees must be submitted to the Village Office.

Snow and Ice Removal

§ 127-7. **Duty to keep sidewalks clear.** The owner of every lot or premises within the Village of Philmont shall keep the sidewalks adjoining said lot or premises free and clear of all ice and snow for the entire length and width of said sidewalk.

§ 127-8. **Time limit for removal.** Snow and ice shall be removed and cleared away from the sidewalks in the manner specified in §127-7 hereof within 24 hours after each snow or ice shall have fallen or formed on said sidewalks.

§ 127-9. **Placing ice or snow on plowed street prohibited.**

No person shall throw or place, by any means, any snow or ice on any portion of any Village street or thoroughfare which has been plowed or shoveled out for the purpose of allowing the passage of traffic. On any lot or premises where there is no room to dispose of snow or ice, snow and ice may be piled at the edge of the sidewalk again, leaving sufficient space for pedestrian traffic as outlined in § 127-7
MOTION to charge violators of the snow shoveling law (Sec. 127-7 & 127-8) a rate of \$2.00 per lineal foot of sidewalk, to be relieved on property owners' taxes upon nonpayment was made January 13, 2020.
(March 24, 2021 rate changed per motion)

Are you a homeowner with a fire hydrant on your property?

Per Village Law, it is your responsibility to clear the hydrant of snow so that our Fire Department may access it, a circumference of at least 24 inches,

NO ON-STREET PARKING

§ 144-1. **Parking regulations.**

A. Between the first day of December and the first day of April in each year no person shall park any motor vehicle in any street of the Village of Philmont between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. In addition to the other penalties provided by § 144-4 hereof, any car so parked in violation of this subsection shall be subject to removal from such street at the expense of the owner.

SUMP PUMP CONNECTIONS

It is illegal to have your sump pumps connected to the sewer discharge in your home!!!

If there is a question regarding proper installation, you may call the sewer plant to request an inspection at no charge.
