Oral testifiers are afforded two (2) minutes to testify per agenda item, with one (1) minute to conclude at the discretion of the Chair if necessary. Please note that anyone wishing

to provide oral testimony pertaining to an agenda item that is a "contested case" pursuant to HRS, Chapter 91 will be asked to testify under oath or affirmation and may be subject to limited cross-examination in accordance with HRS § 91-10(3).

III. PUBLIC TESTIMONY: Pursuant to HRS § 92-6, the Board will not receive testimony from the public for a quasi-judicial hearing. Only the parties named and witnesses will testify at this hearing. However, testimony for all other agenda items will be accepted from the public.

IV. HEARING(S) BEFORE THE BOARD:

A. COMPLAINT & ACCUSATION NO. 2025-09

In the matter of the accusation against LIFE'S A BEACH INC. dba HAU'I'S LIFE'S A BEACH, located at 1913 South Kihei Road, Space E, Kihei, Maui, Hawaii. They hold a Dispenser General, Category C(ii), Lic. No. 362, liquor license.

Count 1: On NOVEMBER 1, 2024, LIFE'S A BEACH INC. dba HAU'I'S LIFE'S A BEACH, sold, served, or furnished liquor to, or allowed the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, drugs, or any combination thereof, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(1)(B).

Count 2: On NOVEMBER 1, 2024, LIFE'S A BEACH INC. dba HAU'I'S LIFE'S A BEACH, knowingly permitted a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, drugs or any combination thereof, or a disorderly person to be or remain in or on the licensed premises, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(5).

Count 3: On NOVEMBER 1, 2024, LIFE'S A BEACH INC. dba HAU'I'S LIFE'S A BEACH, failed to exercise due care in determining whether a patron was under the influence of liquor, drugs, or any combination thereof, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(11).

Plea: The licensee submitted a plea of NO CONTEST.

Clarifying Note: The incident occurred on October 31, 2024, and continued into November 1, 2024.

B. COMPLAINT & ACCUSATION NO. 2025-10

In the matter of the accusation against PRC LLC dba FUEGO ARGENTINEAN STEAKHOUSE, located at 1333 Maui Lani Parkway, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii. They hold a Restaurant General, Category B(ii), Lic. No. 135, liquor license.

- Count 1: On OCTOBER 27, 2024, PRC LLC dba FUEGO ARGENTINEAN STEAKHOUSE, sold, served, or furnished liquor to, or allowed the consumption of liquor by a patron, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, drugs, or any combination thereof, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(1)(B).
- Count 2: On OCTOBER 27, 2024, PRC LLC dba FUEGO ARGENTINEAN STEAKHOUSE, failed to exercise due care in determining whether a patron was under the influence of liquor, drugs, or any combination thereof, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-60(b)(11).
- Count 3: On OCTOBER 27, 2024, PRC LLC dba FUEGO ARGENTINEAN STEAKHOUSE, failed to have available on the licensed premises a time sheet showing in English the legal first name and surname of all employees, including and not limited to managers, assistant managers, and employees approved by the Director, when such employee is on duty, contrary to the Rules Governing the Manufacture and Sale of Intoxicating Liquor of the County of Maui § 08-101-70(f).

Plea: The licensee submitted a plea of NO CONTEST.

V. ADMINSTRATIVE AFFAIR(S):

- A. Continued discussion and action on proposing an amendment to liquor administrative rule § 08-102-92(2) (Procedures; adjudication hearings) of the Rules Governing Administrative Practices and Procedures of the Liquor Commission and the Liquor Control Adjudication Board of the County of Maui.
