<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <a href="#">Redmond 2050 code changes</a> - proposed green building and EV ready/EV capable requirements being recommended to Council.</li><li>• The ESAP Refresh RFP closed on 1.16.2025, and are currently being evaluated by an internal review team. The contract is expected to be presented to Council for approval on March 4.</li><li>• The new Sustainability Program Administrator position closed and interviews are underway.</li><li>• The City completed a grant funded Solar + Energy Storage Feasibility Study, evaluating five city facilities. The City integrated funding to continue that work into 2025/2026. Staff will provide a high level overview of the findings from that study.</li></ul>
