GET INVOLVED

City Council meetings play a vital role in local government by promoting transparency, accountability, and community engagement. These meetings give residents the opportunity to stay informed, voice their opinions, and participate in decisions that directly impact daily life in our city.

Under state law, the City Council is only authorized to formally discuss and take action on posted agenda items during a properly called City Council meeting. This means council meetings are the official and only time residents can hear the full discussion, deliberation, and decisions of the City Council.

Council meetings commonly include discussion on:

- Property development
- Zoning changes and land use regulations
- Capital Improvement Plans (CIP)
- City budgets and financial planning
- Infrastructure and public works projects
- Public safety and community services

Residents can learn about upcoming projects, proposed ordinances, and long-term planning efforts that shape the future of the community. Whether attending in person or following along with the minutes and updates, staying engaged with City Council meetings is one of the most direct ways to be involved in the future of your city.
