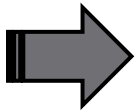

PAY YOUR TAXES *DURING DECEMBER OR JANUARY* IN ONE OF THREE WAYS:



1. **PAY IN PERSON:** Port Washington State Bank, 545 Main Street, Belgium
Please pay your taxes in the bank lobby; not the drive-thru. PWSB will issue receipts and can issue immediate refunds if the escrow check from your mortgage holder exceeds the total taxes due.
2. **PAY BY MAIL:** Town of Belgium Treasurer, 6267 Homestead Dr, Belgium WI 53004
Please include an email address or a self-addressed, stamped envelope for receipt.
3. **PAY ONLINE:** <https://client.pointandpay.net/web/TownofBelgiumWI> (Link on town website available during December and January) Point & Pay convenience charges will be applied.

RECYCLE CENTER 1215 JAY RD:

Open to **TOWN OF BELGIUM RESIDENTS ONLY** for disposal of household trash only.

Year Round: 8 am until 1:30 pm on Saturday

May 1st through September 30th: Saturday 8 am – 1:30 pm & Wednesday 5 pm - 7 pm

All recyclable material is co-mingled and deposited in the designated compactor. Be prepared to pay a fee for oversized items (\$20), LP and fuel tanks. Complete fee schedule is posted on the Town website. Freon-related items, tires, and electronics are not accepted. Tree stumps are not accepted. Tree limbs and brush cannot exceed 4 feet in length.

New residents must provide proof of residency to obtain permission to use the Recycle Center. Questions should be directed to the Site Supervisor, Dave Winnemuller, or Town Board Supervisor, Tom Bichler.

The Town of Belgium has a **FIREARMS ORDINANCE** in effect since 1988 regulating the discharge of firearms in designated areas. The areas regulated are east of Sauk Trail Rd between Pebble Beach and Cty Rd D, east of Sunny Ridge between Cedar Beach and Sandy Beach Rds., and east of Lake Church Rd between Sandy Beach and Cty Rd P. Find the ordinance and map on the Town website under the 'Other Information' tab or by contacting the Clerk.

DOG LICENSES:

Licenses are required by **March 31st** annually for all dogs 5 months of age or over per WI State Statute. *Please do **not** include dog license fee in your tax payment.*

Fees: Neutered/spayed = \$3.00
NOT neutered/spayed = \$8.00

Certificate will be returned to you in the mail, along with dog license tag.

\$5.00 late fee charged after March 31st.

ZONING PERMITS:

Zoning permits are issued by the Town of Belgium Zoning Administrator.

Fees are required for construction of

New home (\$500)

Addition (\$150)

Remodeling involving structural alteration (\$100)


Accessory structure: large (\$150) small (\$75)

Temporary Storage (\$50)

Fences (\$50)

Agricultural structures (\$75)

Signs (\$50 or .25/sq. ft.)



If in doubt, please contact the Zoning Administrator. Fees double if a required permit is not acquired.

ELECTIONS IN 2026:

February 17 – Spring Primary (if needed)

April 7 – Spring Election & Presidential Preference

August 11 – Partisan Primary

November 3 – General Election
