MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIENCE

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Lieutenant Engle introduced our new officer, Dominic Taylor.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL PARK: Council Member Povey announced disclosure. Wade Povey stated that he was against the annexation because of higher property tax and the storm water flooding. He is concerned about the city not taking care of the roads.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 668 ANNEXATION ON THE INDUSTRIAL PARK: The first reading of Ordinance 668, the annexation of the industrial park was read by Mayor Sorensen.

LAWN MOWER PURCHASES FOR THE GOLF COURSE: Cody Moldenhauer discussed the purchase of robotic lawn mowers for the Golf Course. **MOTION** by Council Member Povey and seconded by Council Member Hammond to approve the purchase of two lawn mowers for the Golf Course. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

PURCHASE OF CAMERAS FOR THE CITY OF AMERICAN FALLS: The Mayor and City Council discussed the purchase of cameras through the city. The purchase of these cameras are \$73,276.39. There is a need for cameras due to a lot of vandalism. **MOTION** by Council Member Povey and seconded by Council Member Hofmeister to allow Mayor Sorensen to sign the agreement with Sollus and to approve the use of the Public Improvement Fund to pay for the purchase and have any donations replace those funds. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.

RESOLUTION 651, THE DISPOSAL OF TEMPORARY AND SEMI-PERMANENT RECORDS:

MOTION by Council Member Hofmeister and seconded by Council Member Hammond to approve Resolution 651 the disposal of Temporary and semi-permanent records. Roll call vote. Motion carried by unanimous vote of those members present.
