

March 16, 2026

A special meeting of the Alta City Council was held on March 16, 2026, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 4:32pm by Mayor Desi Suter with the following members present: Bruce McGowan, Peg Hinkeldey, Pam Henderson, and Alie Sievers. Laurie Millard arrived at 4:35pm.

Henderson moved, and Sievers seconded to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

BUDGET WORKSHOP: Much discussion took place regarding the FY2027 budget.

INSURANCE RENEWAL: Motion by McGowan, second by Hinkeldey, to approve the insurance renewal with GOES Insurance for \$138,648.00. Motion passed unanimously.

7TH AND JOHNSON REPAIR: Motion by Millard, second by Sievers, to approve paying the cost of fill materials at approximately \$4,900 to repair the street patch at 7th and Johnson. SCE will repair at no additional cost. Motion passed unanimously.

GRANT APPLICATIONS: Motion by Henderson, second by Sievers, to approve applying for grants for the pickleball/trail extension project. Motion passed unanimously.

HOMEOWNER TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM: Motion by Hinkeldey, second by Henderson, to approve the development of a Homeowner Tree Replacement Program. Motion passed unanimously.

FLOW METER STUDY: Motion by McGowan, second by Henderson, to approve the flow meter study of the North First Street sewer main at a cost of approximately \$22,000. Motion passed unanimously.

CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP: Motion by Millard, second by Sievers, to approve June 9-10, 2026, as Citywide Clean-Up. Motion passed unanimously.

FY26 BUDGET AMENDMENT: Motion by Henderson, second by Sievers, to set the Public Hearing for the FY26 Budget Amendment for April 6, 2026, during the regular council meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

The Maximum Property Tax Levy Public Hearing will be **Monday, April 6, 2026, at 4:30 pm**. Next regular meeting is **Monday, April 6, 2026 at 6:00 pm**.

Being no further business, motion by Henderson to adjourn at 6:58 pm, second by Hinkeldey, and approved with all members voting aye.
