

Minutes of Wynnedale Town Council August 10,2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm in the Bird Sanctuary.

Present were council members, Mary Beth Schneider, Andy Hawickhorst, Ann Hildner, Sue Rice and Clerk-Treasurer Jarnell Burks-Craig.

The Treasurer's report: From January 2021 to June 30 2021 the amount of \$9,690.23 was added to the General Fund with a total of \$79,118.72. In the Motor Vehicle Highway account an amount of \$3,221.69 has been added for the January- June 30, 2021 with a total of \$35,944.70. The account of Local Road Street added \$1991.25 with a total of \$34,578.39.

The Town of Wynnedale will be receiving grant money in the amount of \$56,000 from the American Recovery Plan passed by Congress. This amount is determined by population. It is to be paid in two installments.

The Budget meeting will be at our next regular meeting time on September 14, 2021. The council members will work on the budget total before then.

The Little Library is under construction with instillation in late August. A site was selected in the Bird Sanctuary for the location.

Jarnell Craig is continuing to work on obtaining streetlights for new Wynnedale.

Craig Rice fixed the pot hole by Sleepy Hollow and the city repaired another on Knollton Road just south of 44th Street.

Andy Hawickhorst mentioned the tape found on some light poles from the Indianapolis 500 decorations. Craig Rice is slowly removing it and repainting the spots.
