Streets moved to approve regular minutes dated January 6, 2026, second by Grimes. Motion carried 3-0.

Edwards moved to approve the claims as presented, second by Streets. Motion carried 3-0.

Edwards moved to approve the purchase of four banners at \$250 each for the following veterans: Ronnie Snyder, and the three members of SSGT Howard's family members: James T Roelsgard, W Eugene Neville, and Martin Roelsgard. Discussion of the Stakeholder Report, showing increase from November to December of 13 new veterans receiving "Live Compensation" and an increase of \$80,902 new federal dollars into our community to veterans. Total monthly Federal VA December Compensation \$1,678,319.
