

Minutes
Woodbury City Council Workshop
Wednesday, February 25, 2026

Pursuant to the due call and notice thereof, a workshop meeting was held at Woodbury City Hall, 8301 Valley Creek Road, on the 25^h day of February 2026.

Present: Mayor Anne Burt, Councilmembers: Kim Wilson, Jennifer Santini, Steve Morris, and Donna Stafford.

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Workshop Discussion Items

1A. Review and Discuss Proposed Ordinance Amendments Regarding; E-Transportation Modes

Presentation provided by staff with Council questions, comments, and discussion throughout.

Council provided direction to staff to proceed with finalizing the ordinance with recommendations from PNRD as presented; except for the new provision on helmets. Council provided direction that no further public engagement processes are required, beyond normal ordinance consideration processes, before Council final consideration of the ordinance. Council requested additional language in the ordinance providing examples of what is prohibited on public trails, i.e. golf carts, additionally, listing helmet requirements as already required by Statute as applicable specific to motorized foot scooters. Staff was directed to further review language regarding rental type operations in the City and restrictions of such. Staff to also further review current regulatory allowances for staff to restrict devices at large tournaments and special events, to be addressed if not currently allowed by City Code.

1B. Update and Review of Master Plans for Bailey Nurseries West and Cottage Grove Drive Area

Presentation provided by staff with Council questions, comments, and discussion throughout.

Council provided direction to staff to proceed with master planning as presented for Bailey Nurseries West with additional direction provided regarding creation of site plan and master plan restrictions on types of vehicles access to address concerns related to truck traffic conflicts adjacent to residential areas along future Century Avenue.

Council provided direction to staff to further discuss the Cottage Grove Drive area master plan at a future workshop. Concept/product examples for the proposed 45' lots were requested to be included for Council with the next review.
