ALSO PRESENT: City Administrator Steve Volkert, Deputy City Clerk Jessica Randall, City Planner Jacob Maas, and Park and Rec Director Randy Wojtasiak.

Call to Order – Chairperson Rusniak called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of Hartford City Hall, 109 North Main Street.

Public Comment Period – None.

Special Finance and Personnel Meeting will be held on Tuesday March 24, 2026, prior to the Public Works Committee Meeting.

Discussion and consideration of approving the increase of Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center fees for the 2026 season. –Park and Rec Director Randy Wojtasiak stated that the Aquatic Center fees would raise the daily passes \$1.00 for City residents and \$2.00 for non-residents. The seasonal pass would be raised \$10.00 for residents and \$20.00 for non-residents. This increase in fees is comparable with other similar aquatic facilities and will help keep pace with operational cost increases.

MOTION by Alderperson Pechacek, seconded by Alderperson Savage to approve the increase of Veterans Memorial Aquatic Center fees for the 2026 season.

Discussion and consideration of appointing City Staff as Deputy Property Maintenance Code Officials under Section 29.02 of the City of Hartford Municipal Code. – City Planner Jacob Maas informed the Committee that in May 2025 the Property Maintenance Code was recreated. These appointments will allow city staff to take enforcement action against Property Maintenance Code Violations.
