

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE CORPORATION OF LIBERTY, INDIANA
June 16, 2025**

The Town Council of the Town of Liberty, Indiana had regular meeting on June 16, 2025 at the Town Administration building located at 101 Brownsville Avenue.

Mr. Jenkins made a motion for Mr. Keasling to serve as acting President of the Council since Mr. Bias and Mr. Tipton were not present for the meeting. Mr. Kahl supported the motion. Upon a vote viva voce, motion passed.

Mr. Keasling called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Jenkins made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of June 2, 2025. Mr. Kahl supported the motion. Upon a vote viva voce, motion passed.

Mr. Kahl made a motion to approve the Intermediate Package with the YouTube Publishing addition as stated in the Dragonbyte Solutions agreement. Mr. Jenkins supported the motion. Upon a vote viva voce, motion passed.

Tom Poole with the Poole Group appeared before the Council requesting to close Market Street from Seminary to Vine due to the narrow working space affiliated with the construction of the addition to the public library. After discussion regarding emergency vehicles, getting to the east side of the church in the event of fire and the safety of the walking public, it was decided to close Market Street and the sidewalk on the east side of the church. The Poole Group will take care of running a fence up to the church to thwart pedestrian use of the sidewalk. Mr. Jenkins made a motion to close Market Street and the sidewalk to the east of the church through the end of August with Mr. Poole returning to the August 18th meeting in the event an extension needs to occur. Mr. Kahl supported the motion. Upon a vote viva voce, motion passed.

Mr. Keasling opened the floor to the attending public for discussion regarding the closing of the fill station. Discussion occurred regarding why the Town is closing the Fill Station. The public in attendance were given packets that had the Town Attorney's opinion on the Town's responsibility regarding the fill station as well as the financials to support the closing of the fill station. Ms. Shepler and Mr. Keasling both reiterated to the attending public that Mr. Reuss is currently working with Randy Fields of the Union County Co-op for them to expand their fill station for the public.

There being no further business, on a motion made by Mr. Kahl and supported by Mr. Jenkins, the meeting was adjourned.
