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**Recommendation**

Staff respectfully requests the opportunity to present an overview of the benefits of the cooperative fire agreement between the City of Gridley and CAL FIRE. This item is for presentation and discussion only. No action is requested at this time.

**Background**

The City of Gridley has maintained a cooperative agreement with CAL FIRE for fire protection services since 1991. The long-standing partnership has benefited the City with regionally integrated fire protection and access to Butte County fire resources at no additional cost.

Historically, this agreement has been renewed annually and is set to expire on June 30, 2026. The City currently funds one Fire Captain and four Fire Apparatus Engineers. To move closer to meeting NFPA 2500 staffing standards, it is recommended that the City consider funding an additional position in the upcoming fiscal year.

Before the City Council is asked to vote on the proposed agreement for the 2026–2027 fiscal year, the Fire Chief will provide a presentation outlining the operational and fiscal benefits for Council consideration.
