1. **Call to order by Mary Beth Schneider** – All Present
2. **Treasurers Report / Budget Discussion**

Proposed Budget for 2022 - \$86,450. Based on what we have in the bank, and having a budget of \$86k for 2021....if we had a budget for 2022 in addition to 2021 exceed the amount in the bank, they would consider that a shortfall, which is what happened, showing a shortfall of \$50kish. Jarnell learned that all towns in Indy can apply for Covid local fiscal relieve. Wynnedale has 248 residents, qualifying for 55,991.55. This was approved on 9/8/21! We received \$27,995.79. This is half of what we will be receiving and we will receive another \$27,995 next fall.

2 lights installation cost \$3,783.28 (total) plus, repairing a pole already on Knollton road. Fortunately we previously allocated \$4,500 for Elite Security (not going to be used in 2022).

Snow Removal / Mowing. Josh still has interest in mowing. Josh Smith is asking his contact to put a bid in for snow plow.

3. **Old Business**

Dedication of Little Library. Perhaps have some individually wrapped cookies. Set 5:30 on Tuesday, 9/28. Mary Beth will get some cookies and Jarnell will bring some lemonade. Judy Hall (retired school teacher) will speak and dedicate the library to the teachers of Wynnedale.
