

Town of Wynnedale Town Council Meeting Minutes May 12th 2020

Meeting Called to order at 7:02p.m. in the Butterfly Garden- All Council members present

Treasurer's Report- Given by Jarnell and distributed to all council members

Old Business

-Appointment of Mary Beth as Council President was voted on and was unanimously approved.

New Business

-Trimming of a tree in a common area was discussed but ultimately decided not to move forward with any action at this time.

-Surface Drains needing attention in several areas of town was discussed. There will be an article regarding the drains and their maintenance in the upcoming newsletter. Jarnell is reaching out to Citizens to see if this is something they can address for us instead of using town funds.

-Stump grinding of several stumps around town was discussed. Sue has received 3 bids. We are tabling for now.

-A neighbor emailed Sue about having a town yard sale. She is going to put something in the upcoming email about possibilities for that.

-Dumpster rental for the town was discussed and decided we would likely secure one in the fall. -A neighbor has planted a tree too close to the road and possibly over a sewer line. Tabling for now.

-We are reaching out to Josh to give him a clearer picture of how we'd like certain areas kept up for mowing and trimming of shrubs. Andy and Ann to reach out.

-Sue called about the 5G poles and they will be removed once installation is complete.

-A neighborhood meeting regarding security and other town matters was discussed and tabled for now. There are some security concerns that were addressed and we discussed how and when to reach out to Elite Security versus calling 911. Jarnell is going to reach out to Elite Security to get a clearer picture of that and will share that information with the council and the members of the town.

-Maintenance of Fire Hydrants around town was discussed. Jarnell is going to reach out to Citizens to see if that falls under their umbrella.

-Contractors not respecting the roads and property of residents has been an issue. Mel is drafting a proposal for the upcoming newsletter.
