4. **Public Comment:**

The community of Milton Road Carneros would like to thank station 10 for their efforts during the high tides for sandbagging the levies and remaining staged in the Reclamation District when there was a fear from the residents of the levies flooding.

5. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

a. Equipment Subcommittee (Brian Ham)

- On January 17th the two Type 1 pumpers were delivered to Napa County Fire. Engine 12 will be outfitted and put into service, however Engine 26 is going back to Golden State for warranty repairs
- The two Type 6 engines we ordered are getting a new pump unit and we are expecting delivery in the spring of this year

Public comment:

- When do we expect Engine 26 will come back from service? Pierce uses proprietary parts, so we are expecting a quick turn around from Golden State for these repairs

b. Training Subcommittee (Brad Caldwell)

- Last Wednesday we had the orientation of the volunteer fire academy. This started with Hazmat training for the new recruits
- The bridge program for the 2025 recruits is officially in the final stage of completion. We have decided to hold off on a bridge program for the current academy for right now, but we will reevaluate this in July
- We would like to announce a be Fire Captain Steve Wilburn to the training team in February specializing in EMS.
- The State doctor is looking to shift EMS requirements from PSFA and toward EMR by January of 2027

c. Health & Wellness Subcommittee (Ryan Bennie)

- We have completed the Cordico app platform, and it appears to be working well with 17 new volunteers signing up
