As required by the Government Code, no action or discussion will be undertaken on any item raised during the Public Comment period and shall be placed on a future agenda if required. Time limitation shall be three minutes per speaker. Any member of the audience desiring to address the Board on a matter on the agenda may do so after receiving recognition from the chairperson at the time the item is considered. Give your name, organization (if any), and your comments or questions. In order that all interested parties have an opportunity to speak, please be brief and limit your comments to the specific subject under discussion. Time limitations shall be three minutes per speaker.
